Syrma SGS Elemaster Inaugurates State-of-the-Art High-Reliability Electronics Manufacturing Facility in Bengaluru

New facility strengthens India's high-reliability electronics manufacturing capabilities and deepens strategic partnership between Syрма SGS and Italy-based Elemaster
