INDIA-SINGAPORE TIES | Modi, Wong discuss ways to further strengthen the bilateral ties

Fighting terrorism is the duty of all, says PM

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday said that India and Singapore share common concerns regarding terrorism and believe that fighting it together is the duty of all nations.

He also expressed gratitude to Singapore for condemning the Pahalgam terror attack and supporting India's fight against terrorism.

Addressing a joint press conference with Singapore Prime Minister Lawrence Wong, PM Modi said, "We share common concerns regarding terrorism and believe that fighting terrorism together is the duty of all humanitarian nations."

"After the Pahalgam terror attack, I thank PM Wong and the Singapore government for their empathy towards the people of India and their support in our

fight against terrorism," he added.

These remarks came as PM Modi and Singaporean PM Wong met at the Hyderabad House in New Delhi to discuss ways to further strengthen the bilateral ties.

Tobgay, who is already in India and currently on a tour of Bihar, will land at Maharishi Vaidik International Airport in Ayodhya on September 5 around 9:30 am.

Country's infant mortality rate touches record low of 25

Infant mortality rate (IMR) in the country has touched a record low of 25, a sharp dip of 37.5 per cent from 40 in 2013, according to the Sample Registration System report for 2023 issued by the Registrar General of India.

IMR is a key public health indicator defined as number of deaths of children per 1,000 live births under one year — the lower the number the better the health accessibility.

According to the SRS 2023 report, which took into account the data for 2023, IMR has registered a dramatic 80 per cent decline from 129 in 1971. It shows that Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, and Bihar have recorded the highest levels of IMR in the country at 37. The lowest was Manipur at 3.

ED grills Dhawan over endorsement of 'illegal' betting app

Former India cricketer Shikhar Dhawan faced ED questioning on Thursday in connection with alleged money laundering tied to an "unauthorised" gaming app endorsed by him in advertisements, an official said.

The former Team India opener was summoned by the probe agency to get clarity on his advertising contract with app named 1xBet, the official said. Dhawan reportedly faced hours of grilling after he appeared before the Enforcement Directorate (ED) officials at around 11 a.m. here. Apart from Dhawan, former cricketer Surish Raina was also recently questioned by the ED in the context case. Dhawan, who owns the South Delhi Superstarz team in the Delhi Premier League, retired from all forms of cricket in August last year after a career spanning over a decade.

Two security personnel killed in gunfight with Maoists in J'khand

Two security personnel were killed and another was injured in a gunfight with members of the banned TSPC, a splinter group of CPI (Maoist), in Jharkhand's Palamu district on Thursday, police said.

The encounter between security forces and members of the proscribed Triyana Samanjan Prastuti Committee (TSPC) outfit broke out around 12:30 am in Kedali village in Manatu police station area, a senior officer said. "Two security personnel were killed, and another was injured in the gunfight. The injured was admitted to Medinjal Medical College and Hospital," Palamu DIG Naushad Alam told PTI.
