NOT RECOGNISED | Orchid Int'l School resumes classes despite closure notice; edu inspector says police will now take action

Illegal Chunabhathi school reopens as learning centre

More than 400 students of Orchid International School in Chunabhathi resumed physical classes on July 1 despite a closure notice issued by the education department for operating without mandatory recognition.

The institution is now functioning under the name 'The Institute of Learning and Education'. The words 'Orchid International School' on its original signboard have been blacked out.

Students from Nursery to Class 10 were seen leaving the premises on Wednesday afternoon, several in casual clothes and some wearing last year's uniforms.

The school administration, however, said operations had resumed by accommodating students at other branches, including Kurla and Mulund.

The file seeking formal recognition had been forwarded to the state government and was likely to be approved soon, the representative said.

Parents said they were instructed to send children in casual clothes and change the branch listed on the school's mobile application from Chembur to Mulund.

Others said securing admission elsewhere had proved difficult because schools either demanded high admission fees or refused to accept Orchid students.

Parents also alleged that the school collected fees for June despite remaining closed and charged for extracurricular activities that were not conducted.

Transport Bhavan stalled again, cost drops to ₹90cr

The state transport department's long-awaited Transport Bhavan project at Worli has faced another delay, with construction yet to begin 15 months after its foundation stone was laid.

Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis laid the foundation stone for the new headquarters in March 2025, with the government announcing a completion deadline of the end of 2027.

The original proposal envisaged a 17-storey building, but the Indian Navy did not grant the required height clearance. The design was subsequently revised to a ground-plus-four-storey structure with underground parking.

AI-generated fake judgments ring warning bells for lawyers

Courts in India and abroad are beginning to confront a troubling pattern: lawyers submitting case law that turns out to be entirely fictitious and generated by artificial intelligence tools such as ChatGPT.

The Supreme Court of India has already dealt with this problem directly. In Gummadi Usha Rani v. Sure Mallikarjuna Rao (2025), the Court discovered that the trial court had relied on four "judgments" that did not exist in any official law report.

"We take cognisance of the Trial Court deploying AI generated non-existing, fake or synthetic alleged judgments and seek to examine its consequences and accountability as it has a direct bearing on integrity of adjudicatory process.

The warning was repeated months later when another Bench, while hearing a matter involving fabricated citations, observed that the spread of AI-generated case law had become a "menace" and that courts were routinely encountering submissions containing judgments that no digital or physical law library could trace.

High Courts have faced similar situations. The Bombay High Court, in Mr. Deepak s/o Shivkumar Bahry Versus Heart & Soul Entertainment Ltd., recently flagged a written

submission citing a case titled Jyoti w/o Dinesh Tulsiani v. Elegant Associates. The Court's registry confirmed that no such judgment had ever been delivered.

The court observed: "If an AI tool is used in aid of research, it is welcome; however, there is great responsibility upon the party, even an advocate using such tools, to cross verify the references and make sure that the material generated by the

AI tools may help research, but advocates must ensure the provided material is genuine and relevant

machine/computer is really relevant, genuine and in existence."

In another recent case, the Bombay High Court imposed costs of ₹50,000 on a litigant for submitting a "non-existing" judgment generated through artificial intelligence, which neither the Court nor its clerks could locate.

These cases signal a turning point for the legal profession. Courts are making it clear that while AI may accelerate legal research, it cannot replace the discipline, caution and ethical responsibility that define advocacy.

Warning for forced school purchases

The state government has announced strict action against private schools, including those affiliated with the CBSE and ICSE boards, that force students to purchase textbooks, uniforms and other educational materials only from designated shops.

Education Dr Pankaj Bhojar made the announcement in the Legislative Council while replying to a question raised by MLC Sudhakar Adbale. Several members said the practice imposed an unnecessary financial burden on parents and restricted their freedom to buy educational materials from vendors of their choice.

Dr Bhojar said the government strongly opposed such

coercive practices and had taken action against some schools earlier for violating the norms. He said monitoring would now be strengthened to ensure compliance with government guidelines. Under the proposed enforcement mechanism, nodal officers will be appointed under the supervision of assistant directors in every divisional deputy director's office.

BMC pushes AI use in hospitals

BMC Additional Municipal Commissioner (City) Prajakta Verma-Lavangare has directed suburban hospitals to accelerate the hospital management information system rollout and adopt AI-based solutions to improve patient care, administration and performance monitoring.

During a surprise inspection of K B Bhabha Municipal General Hospital, Bandra West, she reviewed patient care, medicines, treatment protocols, infrastructure, sanitation, wards, the neonatal unit and redevelopment work.

She said AI could streamline staff attendance, patient registration, healthcare services, medicine inventory and performance evaluation, and called for citizen-friendly digital initiatives.

Verma-Lavangare also reviewed redevelopment and healthcare services at Siddharth Municipal General Hospital, Bharat Ratna Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Municipal General Hospital and Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya Municipal Centenary Hospital, Govandi. Officials were directed to resolve redevelopment challenges, monitor manpower deployment and complete projects within schedule.
