Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, and in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 ("IBC"), we hereby inform you that in the matter of *Bhavesh Gandhi vs. Amluckie Investment Company Ltd.*, Company Appeal (AT) (Ins.) No. 244 of 2024, before the Hon'ble National Company Law Appellate Tribunal ("NCLAT"), Principal Bench, New Delhi, the Hon'ble NCLAT, vide its order dated October 15, 2025, has allowed the withdrawal of the appeal filed by Mr. Bhavesh Gandhi against the order dated February 1, 2024, passed by the Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal, Mumbai Bench, admitting the application under Section 7 of the IBC against the Company.

Consequent to the withdrawal, the Hon'ble NCLAT has withdrawn the interim stay on the constitution of the Committee of Creditors (CoC), which had been granted vide order dated February 12, 2024. The Hon'ble Tribunal has also directed release of the amount of ₹60 lakhs deposited by the appellant before the Registrar, NCLAT, in pursuance of the said interim order.

Accordingly, the stay on the CoC constitution in the matter of *Skil Infrastructure Limited (Undergoing CIRP)* stands vacated as per the Hon'ble NCLAT order dated October 15, 2025. A copy of the said order is enclosed herewith for your reference.

We request you to take the same on record.

15.10.2025: This appeal has been filed by the appellant challenging the order passed by the Adjudicating Authority dated 01.02.2024 admitting Section 7 application when the appeal came for consideration following interim order was passed on 12.02.2024:-

“O R D E R
(Hybrid Mode)

12.02.2024: *Learned Counsel for the appellant submits that he is ready to deposit the balance amount of the principal, within three days. Let him deposit the said amount before the Registrar, NCLAT in a fixed deposit receipt.*

List this appeal on 21.02.2024.

In the meantime, Committee of Creditors shall not be constituted subject to the deposit.”

The court was also informed that on 08.11.2024 that parties intend to move Section 12A application. Ld. Counsel for the appellant submits that 12A

application has been rejected by the Adjudicating Authority. The appellant prays that in view of the above the appellant be permitted to withdraw the appeal. An IA No. 6186 of 2025 has been filed by the appellant praying for direction to release the amount of Rs. 60 lakhs which was deposited before the Registrar, NCLAT in pursuance of the order dated 12.02.2024. We are of the view that prayer of the appellant for withdrawing the appeal needs to be allowed. Appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. Appeal having been dismissed as withdrawn the amount deposited by the appellant under order dated 12.02.2024 be released in favour of the appellant. Interim order also stands vacated.
