UPDATE (RAILWAYS)

Indian Railways Sanctions Rs263.86 Crore Chalisgaon Rail over Rail Flyover in Maharashtra
Indian Railways has sanctioned the Chalisgaon Rail over Rail (RoR) flyover project spanning 10.75 km under the Central Railway in Maharashtra at an estimated cost of around Rs263.86 crore, marking a significant step towards enhancing capacity and streamlining operations in a critical section of the network. The project will address long-standing operational challenges in the Chalisgaon area of Jalgaon district, Maharashtra. Currently, train movements in this section face congestion due to multiple crossings over three lines, particularly for trains coming from the Dhule side, which intersect busy main lines. With additional 4th lines also being developed, these crossings were expected to further increase delays and operational complexity. The sanctioned flyover will eliminate such conflicts by separating train movements, ensuring smoother and more efficient operations.

MMRDA Secures 216 Acres for Mumbai 3.0; Strong Public Response Accelerates New City Development in Raigad Pen Growth Centre
In a decisive step towards operationalising the vision of Mumbai 3.0, the Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) has successfully secured 216 Acres of land for the development of a new growth centre in Raigad district—marking a major milestone driven by an overwhelming response to its participatory land acquisition policy. The achievement underscores strong on-ground participation from landowners, across the Raigad Pen growth corridor, where the proposed New Town Development Area (Mumbai 3.0) is being planned. The development assumes further significance as a Shareholders' Agreement for the project was formally executed on April 18, 2026, in the presence of Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri. Devendra Fadnis, and under the Chairmanship of Deputy Chief Minister Shri. Eknath Shinde and in the leadership of Dr. Sanjay Mukherjee, IAS, Metropolitan Commissioner, MMRDA, setting the stage for on-ground implementation of a world-class integrated urban township. Mumbai Port Authority Marks National Fire Service Day, Pays Tribute to Martyrs of 1944 Dock Explosion
Mumbai Port Authority today paid solemn tribute to the Martyrs of the 1944 Bombay Dock Explosion at the Fire Memorial within the port premises, marking National Fire Service Day. The ceremony was led by the Deputy Chairperson, Shri. Adesh Titamare, IAS, Mumbai Port Authority, in the presence of senior officials and representatives from Maharashtra Fire Services, Mumbai Fire Brigade, Naval Dockyard Fire Service, Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), BARC, MIDC, RCF, and Aegis Logistics, along with officers from various departments of Mumbai Port Authority. The observance commemorates the tragic explosion of SS Fort Stikine at Victoria Dock on April 14, 1944, which resulted in extensive loss of life and property. Firefighters, port personnel, and civilians were among those who lost their lives, while large sections of the port and surrounding areas were severely affected.

UPDATE (VPPL)

VPPL CMD Chairs High-Level Review on Vadhan Port Progress and Way Forward
The Chairman and Managing Director (CMD) of Vadhan Port Project Limited (VPPL), Shri Gaurav Dayal, IAS, convened a high-level review meeting to assess the ongoing developments and chart the way forward for the strategically significant Vadhan Port Project Ltd. (VPPL) - 13th major port of India. The meeting focused on key aspects, including the project's future roadmap, land acquisition for road connectivity, fisheries-related policy considerations, and updates on the Vadhan Port skilling program aimed at local workforce skill development. UPDATE (ADANI ELECTRICITY)

Adani Energy Commissions 1,000 MW Power Link to Bring More Clean Energy into Mumbai
In a significant step towards strengthening power infrastructure in Mumbai and the wider Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR), Adani Electricity Mumbai Infrastructure Limited (AEMIL), a subsidiary of Adani Energy Solutions Limited (AESL), has commissioned a 1,000 megawatt (MW) high-voltage direct current (HVDC) transmission link between Kudus and Aarey. The project, comprising a 30-kilometre (km) overhead line and a 50-km underground corridor, has been designed to operate within the constraints of a densely built urban environment. It also features the world's first compact HVDC substation. Conceived in the aftermath of the October 2020 Mumbai blackout, which exposed vulnerabilities in the city's power supply, the project reflects a broader push to strengthen grid resilience and reliability.
