Free Hand to Forces

"I want to tell terrorist organisations and their guardians that they have committed a grave mistake. Those behind the attack will be punished for their actions."

The Prime Minister also urged the international community to unite to wipe out the scourge of terrorism and isolate those responsible for the menace.

Arun Jaitley, who is back from New York, assumed charge of the finance minister on Friday and attended a meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Security (CCS) chaired by the PM.

Thereafter followed a key announcement — That India has withdrawn the "Most Favoured Nation" status bestowed on Pakistan.

Jaitley also said: "The Ministry of External Affairs will initiate all possible diplomatic steps to ensure the complete isolation of Pakistan from the international community. There is incontrovertible evidence of it having a direct hand in this gruesome attack."

The CCS meeting was also attended by the ministers of home, defence and external affairs; later Home Minister Rajnath Singh flew to Srinagar to take stock of the situation.

India has already demanded that the United Nations ban JeM and pass strictures against its chief Masood Azhar who roams freely in Pakistan. In a statement, the MEA said all UN members should back a proposal to proscribe Azhar as an international terrorist. China, which condemned the killings, is however, not ready to play along on Masood Azhar, the brain behind JeM.

WHY NOT AIRLIFT?

Questions are being asked why the troops were not airlifted. Large-scale movement of troops is fraught with risk and enhances its susceptibility to an attack, more so since the convoy has to pass through stretches which are terror infested. Sources said the convoy was big because the highway had been shut on account of bad weather for two days. Most of the soldiers were resuming duty after leave and were to report in Srinagar for deployment.

CIVILIAN CURBS

Home Minister Rajnath Singh, who held a review meeting with top officers of the CRPF, Army and the state police, said that civilian movement will henceforth not be allowed on state roads when big military convoys are passing through.

Muslims step out to condemn

"We have announced Rs 50 lakh for the kin of the martyred jawans and the Maharashtra government will take responsibility of their rehabilitation. 125 crore Indians are their family members," Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis said condemning the attack. Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) units in Mumbai led by Raj Purohit, Ram Kadam and other leaders organised demonstrations in the city and suburbs.

Maharashtra Congress President Ashok Chavan and Mumbai Congress President Sanjay Nirupam organised a special condolence meeting at the party headquarters.

Both Chavan and Nirupam said the government must ensure that the sacrifices of the troopers do not go in vain and added that as per Congress President Rahul Gandhi's statement, the party would fully support all endeavours of the government in this regard.

The Shiv Sena and Maharashtra Navnirman Sena activists burnt Pakistan flags and Uddhav Thackeray demanded immediate retaliation and said the government should "hit back with full force". "Alliances, elections -- all this can continue, but don't spare Pakistan. Now a surgical strike is needed inside Pakistan.

The entire country is united to give a befitting answer to the Jaish-e-Mohammed and teach a lesson to Pakistan it will never forget," Thackeray said. The Sena has also demanded convening a special Parliament session to discuss the Pulwama crisis and the future course of action. Many private and government offices arranged a two-minute silence to mourn the victims, and protests were held at major suburban railway stations with lakhs of home-bound commuters raising slogans in solidarity with the CRPF troopers.

Police said, the girl hanged from the ceiling fan in her living room, on Thursday, around 5 pm. When her father returned home at night, he found his daughter hanging from the ceiling fan and alerted the police. The girl was rushed to the civic-run Rajawadi Hospital at 8.45 pm, where she was declared brought dead. Vilas Jadhav, a senior police inspector of Parksite police station said an Accidental Death Report (ADR) was registered in the matter and further investigation was underway. "No suicide note was found on the teenager, but prima facie it does seem she was depressed over being alone on Valentine's Day," said Jadhav. The police are now awaiting the post-mortem report.

Metro 1 body not allowing CAG audit...

Since then MMRDA and MMOPL have been in a legal wrangle over the fare hike and the actual construction cost of Metro 1. The HC had observed in its December 2017 judgment: In the arbitration proceedings, if ultimately it is held that MMRDA was not responsible for the delay and consequent cost overruns, then, the prejudice to public interest, will be irreversible. At the very least, MMOPL will be unjustly enriched at the cost of commuters. Even if MMOPL succeeds in arbitration proceedings and is awarded the claimed amount of Rs 1,939 crores, even then, the issue of unjust enrichment at the cost of commuters and taxpayers will arise. This is because MMOPL, by then, will have recovered substantial amounts by way of the enhanced fares, and will further have to be paid compensation amount.

At the recent meeting with the new FFC, MMRDA made the submission that on August 1, 2015, the Government of Maharashtra (GoM) had issued a show-cause notice to MMOPL to allow audits of their accounts by CAG. On August 3, 2015, CM Devendra Fadnis had requested the union ministry of urban development and CAG to expeditiously take up an audit of the accounts. On August 21, 2015, MMOPL consented to the CAG audit. Even after this, as audits of the entire account did not commence on September 8, 2015, MMRDA wrote to the state government to send a reminder to CAG for undertaking the full audit. However, on November 3, 2015, MMOPL withdrew its consent to the CAG audit. Ever since, it continues to remain non-cooperative, MMRDA claimed.

An MMOPL spokesperson said, "We are unaware of FFC's deliberations with MMRDA on this matter. However, we have clearly indicated to MMRDA that statutory audits are being carried out as per the Concession Agreement and the Companies Act and by one of the big four audit firms approved by MMRDA. We, therefore, reiterate that no public interest will be served by the CAG audit."

Even before some understanding is reached to put the pre-poll alliance on firm footing, leaders have started flexing muscles on who would be its leader. If the Congress emerges as the largest party in the opposition camp, it will want anointment of Rahul Gandhi, but others are also active.

Hina, IAF's first woman flight engineer

BENGALURU: The IAF inducted Flight Lieutenant Hina Jaiswal from the 112th helicopter unit at the Yelahanka air base in the city's northern suburb as its first woman flight engineer. Hina, who hails from Chandigarh, graduated in engineering from the Panjab University. In 2018, the flight engineer branch, which was the domain of male air warriors, was opened to women officers. Commissioned as a warrior on January 5, 2015, in the engineering branch of the Air Force, Hina served as chief of firing team and battery commander in a frontline surface-to-air missile squadron before her selection to the flight engineers' course.

Bharat Ratna statement misinterpreted: Hazarika's son

NEW DELHI: Tej Hazarika, son of noted Assamese singer-composer Bhupen Hazarika clarified that his earlier statement was misinterpreted. In a letter to the Government of India, he wrote: "It is unfortunate that (some) people would misinterpret my statement of 11th February 2019 regarding the Bharat Ratna by misrepresenting my view of it. It will be my dreamlike privilege to receive it for my father." On February 11, Tej had reportedly stated that he is against accepting the coveted award to protest against the Citizenship Bill, which seeks to give citizenship to non-Muslim immigrants in Assam.

Land acquisition plea tagged with main Ayodhya case

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court tagged with the main matter -- challenge to 2010 Allahabad High Court verdict on title suit -- a plea challenging the 1993 central law for the acquisition of Ayodhya land, including the disputed site. Tagging the plea with the main matter, a bench of Chief Justice Ranjan Gogoi and Justice Sanjiv Khanna said the plea would be heard along with the main matter on the next date of hearing. A group of Lucknow residents, including two lawyers describing themselves as devotees of Lord Rama, have moved the top court challenging the acquisition of the land at Ayodhya. The Centre had moved the top court for the modification of its March 31, 2003 order, directing the observance of status quo on the acquired 67 acres of undisputed land.

Rafale: Apex Court displeasure on defective review plea

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Friday expressed unhappiness over some lawyers filing defective petitions and seeking wide publicity in the media, while referring to review pleas challenging its verdict in the Rafale case. The apex court had rejected the pleas seeking lodging of an FIR and a court-monitored probe in alleged irregularities in the Rs 58,000-crore deal, in which both the countries have entered into an inter-governmental agreement (IGA). The Rafale fighter is a twin-engine Medium Multi Role Combat Aircraft (MMRCA) manufactured by French company Dassault Aviation.

Vadra grilling: ED to submit report to HC on February 18

Railway Minister Piyush Goyal and members of the Railway Board were present

on the occasion and will be on board the train on its inaugural journey. "I am grateful to designers and engineers behind Vande Bharat Express which will take its first trip from Delhi to Varanasi today. With our sincerity and hardwork in the last 4.5 years we have tried to improve railways," the PM said.

USE OF 'MARTYR' WORD: HC DECLINES URGENT HEARING

The Delhi High Court on Friday declined to give an urgent hearing to a plea seeking directions to the media to refer to the deaths of armed forces personnel as martyr or 'shaheed' instead of terming it as a killing. The petition was mentioned in

the afternoon before a bench of Chief Justice Rajendra Menon and Justice C Hari Shankar by a lawyer, who is also the petitioner, seeking that it be heard on Friday itself. The bench declined to list it for hearing during the day and chastised the lawyer, Abhishek Choudhary, for insisting that the

matter be listed on Friday, saying "it is already 2.30 pm and you want us to burden a judge to hear it when there is no urgency in the matter." "This is not a plea seeking bail. Someone's liberty is not at stake. Not today. It will be listed on Monday in normal course," the court said.
