# Probe agencies are harassing innocent locals: Bengal CM

35 arrested so far in connection with the case by state CID

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA Malda, April 4

WEST BENGAL CHIEF Minister Mamata Banerjee on Saturday claimed the culprits behind the violence and ghrao of judicial officers in Malda district's Mothabari have escaped, and investigators were harassing the innocent locals in the name of the NIA, the agency assigned to probe the case.

Addressing an election rally at Manikchak in Malda, she urged the gathering not to approach judicial officers scrutinising "under adjudication" cases post-SIR. Instead, submit applications before tribunals for the re-inclusion of names of those erroneously removed from the voters' list, the TMC supreme said.

Ostensibly referring to the ISF and the AIMIM, Banerjee said, "Two communal parties ghraoed the judges and escaped. Now, investigators are harassing innocent locals in the name of the NIA. They have picked up some 50

innocent people in the name of investigation." An overwhelming number of hands were raised from those attending the meeting when Banerjee asked for a show of hands of those whose names were deleted from the electoral rolls. "My priority is to extend help to these people to apply before tribunals to include the names wrongly deleted from the electoral rolls," the TMC supreme instructed the party's local leaders present on the stage.

Blaming Union Home Minister Amit Shah for the

electoral roll purge, Banerjee alleged that he was driving a wedge through the officers' fraternity in the state administration in the name of pre-election transfers. Urging women to guard EVMs and VVPAT machines once the polls are over, Banerjee directed the grassroots workers of her party to remain vigilant while alleging that "money was being smuggled into the state" in the run-up to the elections. On Wednesday, seven judicial officers were held hostage inside the local BDO office in the

Mothabari area of Malda district, and an eighth was confined inside a vehicle for about nine hours after a large crowd, protesting post-SIR deletion of names from voters' lists, turned violent by blocking roads, vandalising vehicles and attacking police personnel.

So far, 35 people have been arrested by the state CID in connection with the violence. The EC has now tasked the NIA with probing the incident following a directive from the Supreme Court, which has censured the West Bengal administration over the issue.

At a rally in Gazole in the same district, the CM addressed perceptions over the Trinamool Congress's role in handling the local resistance against the implementation of the Waqf Amendment Act.

Murshidabad witnessed large-scale violence in April 2025 in connection with the passage and implementation of the Waqf (Amendment) Act in parliament. Despite initial resistance, the Bengal government, in November 2025, agreed to implement the Act.

# PM Modi 'guarantees' removal of all obstacles

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi on Saturday said that the countdown for removal of the LDF government in Kerala has started, and a BJP-led NDA will come to power in the state.

Speaking at a BJP-led NDA rally here in Pathanamthitta district, Modi said that the saffron partyworkers in the state have signalled a strong mood to bid farewell to the Left rule.

Elections to 140 Assembly seats will be held on April 9 in the state. The PM said that if the BJP comes to power in the state, it will ensure development in Kerala as it did after coming to power in six out of the seven north-east states and Goa, which have a significant Christian population. He said that Kerala has great potential, yet continues to lag behind other states in the race for development. Basic infrastructure was poor in Kerala's rural areas as the LDF and UDF did not pay attention to that, he alleged. The PM said that the NDA government at the Centre has not spared any effort for Kerala's development despite there being no BJP administration till now.

He said that the NDA government has spent five times

more on development in Kerala than the Congress-led UPA regimes. Modi also accused the Left government in the state of delaying the Sabari rail project, claiming that is caused significant loss to the people of Thiruvalla. He said that when a BJP double-engine government comes to power in Kerala, all obstacles will be removed, "This is Modi's guarantee". Modi also referred to the migration of youth from Kerala for jobs and said that it was the state's biggest problem. He said that corruption and communalism were the two biggest obstacles in the development of Kerala, and the LDF needs to be

defeated to address them. In his speech, Modi said that claims that southern states will lose Lok Sabha seats due to population control were false. He also referred to the conflict in the West Asia region and said that the central government is trying to lend all possible help to the Indians living in Gulf nations and to ensure their safety. On the Sabarimala gold loss issue, Modi said that the LDF and UDF conspired to defame pilgrimage to the shrine and now the temple has become "a target of their loot".

He also extended his greetings to the people of Kerala for Easter and Vishu.

# Kerala CM compromised by corruption: Rahul Gandhi

CONGRESS LEADER RAHUL Gandhi on Saturday, at an election rally in Fort Kochi, alleged that the Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan, is "afraid" of Prime Minister Narendra Modi because he wants to protect his children.

He claimed that the CM was "compromised" by corruption, referencing a case allegedly involving his daughter, without naming anyone, which involves allegations of illegal financial transactions. Rahul further alleged that the LDF had aligned with "the worst political force" in the country, which he said targets people based on their faith.

Rahul said the Congress-led UDF would implement its five guarantees if voted to power — free travel for all women on Kerala state buses, ₹1,000 monthly for college girls, an increase in monthly social welfare pension to ₹3,000, health insurance of up to ₹25 lakh for families, and interest-free loans of up to ₹5 lakh for young entrepreneurs.

# Trump's ultimatum to Iran

IRANIAN FIRE BROUGHT down a two-seat US F-15E jet, officials in both countries said, while two US officials said the pilot ejected from an A-10 Warthog fighter aircraft that crashed in Kuwait after being hit by Iranian fire.

Two Black Hawk helicopters engaged in the

search for the missing pilot were hit by Iranian fire but made it out of Iranian airspace, the two US officials told Reuters. The scale of injuries to the crew was unclear.

Iran's Revolutionary Guard Corps said it was combing a southwestern area

near where the pilot's plane came down, while the regional governor promised a commendation for anyone who captured or killed "forces of the hostile enemy."

Parliament Speaker Mohammad Baqer Qalibaf said on X the war had been "downgraded from regime change" to a hunt for pilots.

Trump has been in the White House receiving updates on the rescue effort, a senior administration official told Reuters. Increasingly frustrated with the political fallout from the war, Trump is considering a broader cabinet shake-up in the wake of Attorney General Pam Bondi's removal this week, people familiar with the discussions said.

# Srinivasan quits Hirabai Trust

A KEY ELEMENT of the challenge relates to residency conditions. Mistry has contended that the trust mandates trustees to maintain permanent residence in Mumbai and to be of the Parsi Zoroastrian faith — criteria he claimed the two individuals do not satisfy.

On this basis, he has sought regulatory intervention, including a formal inquiry and sworn declarations from all trustees confirming their eligibility.

Beyond questions of qualification, Mistry has also raised concerns around governance. He has argued that the continued functioning of allegedly ineligible trustees could render their decisions invalid and has framed the issue as one

of compliance with both the trust's founding document and broader legal statutes governing public trusts. At the same time, he said his intervention is not aimed at reclaiming a position within the trust, but at ensuring adherence to its founding principles and safeguarding its intended purpose.

Earlier in February, Mistry had also objected to the position of vice-chairman across Tata Trusts boards, and sought to scrap the position since he said, the original trust deed did not have a provision for it. This latest development

comes after a series of personnel changes on the Allied Trusts boards.

Late January, Pramit Jhaveri, former Citibank chief executive of Citibank and current trustee of Sir Dorabji Tata Trust (SDTT), wrote to Tata Trusts chairman Noel Tata expressing his wish to not be considered for re-appointment when his term ended on February 11.

The second half of 2025 saw Mistry, long-time confidant of late Ratan Tata and Tata Trusts trustee step down after weeks of strife within the ranks. At the

time, battle lines seemed to be drawn between two factions with the Trusts — one under Noel Tata, and one under Mistry.

Mistry's ouster was followed by the appointment of Noel Tata's son Neville Tata and Tata Group veteran Bhaskar Bhat to the board of SDTT. It was expected that both the key trusts would nominate and appoint a common slate of trustees.

However, Neville's appointment to SRTT continues to be in a limbo, as trustees fail to reach consensus on the matter. At least twice now, meetings have been scheduled to discuss the matter, but the resolution remains unresolved.

# In an SUV market, a sedan races past in sales

IT SOLD 201,921 units, a steady climb from its FY25 figure of 194,871 units. The Scorpio (N and Classic) was at the ninth position with 178,800 units, a significant jump from 164,842 last year.

Despite the SUV onslaught, hatchbacks haven't surrendered—and there were three models in the top 10, all from Maruti Suzuki. The Swift secured the fifth position (185,349 units), the Wagon R at the seventh position (180,134 units), and the Baleno was at the tenth position (172,560 units).

# HDFC Bank expects robust Q4 growth

THE BOARD WOULD consider the issuance of perpetual debt instruments, and also consider recommending a dividend for FY26 and fix a record date for the same.

Meanwhile, Bandhan Bank's growth in loans and deposits is expected to be steady for the year ended March 31, with a stronger push towards retail deposits, provisional figures of the bank showed. Loans and advances rose 12.6% year-on-year to ₹1.54 lakh crore, up 6.2% from the December quarter. Total deposits



increased 10% from a year ago to ₹1.66 lakh crore and were up 6.1% sequentially. Retail term deposits grew 30.1% year-on-year to

₹73,796 crore. Overall retail deposits, including savings and current accounts, rose 17.7% to ₹1.22 lakh crore and now make up nearly 74% of total deposits, higher than last year (68.88%).

CASA deposits stood at ₹48,751 crore, taking the CASA ratio to 29.31%. Bulk deposits fell 6.9% from a year earlier, reducing their share in total deposits. The bank's liquidity coverage ratio was about 131.76% as of March 31. AU Small Finance Bank's total deposits are expected to rise

22.8% year-on-year to ₹1.5 lakh crore, and were up 10.3% from the December quarter, provisional data showed. Gross advances are seen rising 25.1% year-on-year to ₹1.36 lakh crore, while the total loan portfolio, including securitised and assigned assets, stood at ₹1.40 lakh crore, up 21.3% from a year earlier and 8% sequentially. CASA deposits increased 19.6% from a year ago to ₹43,360 crore, though the CASA ratio eased to 28.4% from 29.2% last year.

# Not many takers for Europe travel

INDUSTRY ESTIMATES SUGGEST that as much as 35% of India's outbound travellers typically route through or visit the UAE, a share now under pressure. "Roughly 35% of outbound travellers were visiting UAE that's been hit and this traffic has been diverted to countries like Vietnam, Malaysia, Bali (Indonesia), Thailand and Sri Lanka," said Rajiv Mehra, general secretary of the Federation of Associations in Indian Tourism & Hospitality (FAITH).

"There is definitely a sense of hesitation when it comes to West Asia," Gosain of IATO said. "Some travellers are either postponing plans or choosing alternate destinations." Southeast Asia and nearby destinations have seen a marked uptick in bookings and search activity, rising by roughly 15-25% in recent weeks, according to EaseMyTrip. Data from ixigo indicate even sharper increases in certain corridors, with Vietnam recording a 130% year-on-year rise in bookings, followed by Nepal at 88% and Sri Lanka at 68%.

The Philippines has emerged as an outlier. "The real standout, however, has been the Philippines, which has seen an incredible 3x increase in bookings," said Pallavi Saxena, chief marketing and revenue officer, Cleartrip. Domestic tourism is also benefiting from this reallocation of demand. EaseMyTrip estimates that bookings to destinations such as Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Kerala have risen by 15-20%. Cleartrip's data suggest even sharper spikes in niche domestic destinations.



Jaisalmer has recorded a 300% increase in bookings, while cities across the north-east, including Shillong, Itanagar and Guwahati, are seeing double-digit growth. EaseMyTrip estimates that domestic fares are up 5-10%, while short-haul international fares have increased by 20-30%.

Operators have responded by partially passing on costs while adjusting margins to remain competitive. "In most cases, it is very difficult for tour operators to absorb these increases fully," Gosain said. "So, we are seeing a partial pass-through of costs, while operators are trying to remain competitive by adjusting margins and offering flexible packages." There are, however, some mitigating factors. Mehra pointed out that moderating hotel tariffs have offset part of the airfare increase, limiting the overall impact on package prices. "Hotel tariffs which were sky high, have moderated a bit so offsetting the impact of rise in airfares," he said.
