

Over 600,000 incidents of fraud have been reported in the ongoing financial year till September

ndians have lost ₹485 crore to frauds on the Unified Payments Interface (UPI) across 632,000 reported incidents during the ongoing financial year (2024-25/FY25) until September, according to data from the Ministry of Finance

Since 2022-23, UPI-related frauds have accounted for a cumulative loss of ₹2.145 crore across 27 million reported incidents. In 2023-24 (F2V4) alone, 1.34 million fraud cases were reported, amounting to losses of ₹1,087 crore. The rise in UPI-related frauds coincides with the growth in the number of users and the total transactions processed on the real-time payments system. However, the share of UPI-related fraud-lent transactions is minuscule when compared to the cumulative volume and value of transactions processed by the real-time payments system. In the ongoing financial year (FY25), until September, UPI recorded 85.6 billion transactions amounting to ₹122 trillion. In FY24, it pro-

essed 131 12 billion transactions with a value of around ₹200 trillion

At present, India has a base of over 400 million unique users who use UPI for real-

400 million unique users who are time payments. The increase in UPI-related frauds follows a similar trajectory to the rise in bank frauds. The number of bank frauds has more than trebled to \$2,563, amounting to \$2,716/46 crore in FY24, compared to 2021-22, when 8,752 frauds were reported, amounting to \$2,700 frauds were reported, amounting to \$2,000 frauds were reported.



Future of television is smart and networked

The smart TV market has been stagnant. Is Dor the disruption it needs?

Centre spent ₹3,623 crore on crop residue mgmt since 2018: Environment minister

Since 2018, the Centre has spent ₹3,623.45 crore Since 2018, the centre has spent 3,6,23/3 crore on crop residue management in Delh; Punjab, Haryana, and Uttar Pradesh, with 11,681.45 crore allocated to Punjab, the highest among the states, Union Minister of State for Environment, Forest and Climate Change Kirti Vardhan Singh said in the Lok Sabha.

The funds have been used to subsidise crop in the founds have been used to subsidise crop.

The funds have been used to subsidise crop residue management machinery and set up custom hiring centres (CHCs) to curb stubble burning and promote sustainable practices, the minister told the Lower House on Monday. Over 3 lakth machines have been distributed, including 4,500 balers and rakes for collecting paddy straw for ex-aftu utilisation, he said. After Punjah, Haryanar received RJ09317 crore, UP was allocated 7765.67 crore, NCT of Delhi 8,605 crore, and Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) gad 883.58 crore. In 2018, the Ministry of Agriculture &

Agricultural Research (UCAN) got 88.55 crore. In 2018, the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare launched a scheme aimed at supporting the purchase of crop residue man-agement machinery and establishment of CHCs in NCT of Delhi, Punjah, Haryana, and UP for in-situ management of paddy straw. To manage crop residues directly in the fields, the government has allocated crop residue management (ICRM) machinery, essential for effectively handling paddy straw, it has also introduced high-yield, short-duration paddy varieties as substitutes for PUSN-44.

The government has mandated the use of Super Straw Management Systems with combine harvesters, which chop and everly spread the straw across the fields, climinating the need for burning. Additionally, the use of biodecomposers developed by IARI is encouraged to naturally decompose paddy straw, converting it into a valuable fertiliser.

India's transport future balances fossil fuels and clean tech

Fossil fuels will continue to play an important role in India's transportation sector, even as alternative fuel technologies see multifold growth. A study titled Road map for Indian Transition in the Transport Sector, released by TERI — The Finergy and Resources Institute, concludes that fossil fuel demand for transportation even in the

cludes that fossil fuel demand for transportation, even in the most ambitious decarbonisa-tion scenario, will begin to decline after 2050-51 and fall below FY31 tevels by FY71. The study says that natural gas will dominate fossil gueld demand, gradually replacing petroleum products. In the highly ambitious decarbonisa-tion scenario fossil fuel

In the highly ambittous decarbonisation scenario, fossil fuel demand is projected to reach between 188 and 206 million tonnes of oil equivalent (Mtoc) by Fy71, with natural gas accounting for 99 to 187 Mose accounting for 99 to 187 Mose accounting for 99 to 187 Mose mitted to achieving net-zero emissions by 2070.


