BOOST TO NON-TAX REVENUE

CPSE dividends on track to meet FY26 target

● ₹57,800 crore collected so far

New Delhi, February 22

THE CENTRE'S DIVIDEND receipts from central public sector enterprises (CPSEs) have reached ₹57,800 crore so far this financial year. This is marginally lower than collections during the same period last year but remains broadly on track to meet the full-year budget target.

In the revised estimates for FY26, the government pegged CPSE dividend receipts at ₹71,000 crore, higher than the budget estimate of ₹69,000 crore, signalling confidence in sustained profitability across key public sector undertakings.

Dividend income from CPSEs is an important component of the Centre's non-tax revenue, alongside other major sources such as surplus transfers from the Reserve Bank of India and proceeds from telecom spectrum auctions.

THE MONEY GAME

Centre's dividend receipts from CPSEs (₹ crore)



In FY25, CPSE dividend receipts climbed to a record ₹74,140 crore, comfortably exceeding the budgeted target of ₹69,000 crore. That outperformance was aided by relatively benign global crude oil and commodity prices, which supported profitability in several

state-owned energy companies. The pattern has broadly continued in FY26, with dividend payments once again dominated by energy sector enterprises.

So far, the top dividend payers of FY26 include Coal India (₹8,132 crore), Indian Oil Corporation (₹5,818 crore), Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (₹5,371 crore) and Bharat Petroleum Corporation (₹5,171 crore), underscoring the sector's

continued importance to government finances.

In addition to traditional CPSEs, investment vehicles have emerged as significant dividend contributors. The National Investment and Infrastructure Fund has paid a dividend of ₹4,013 crore to the Centre so far, while returns from the SWAMIH housing fund amounted to about ₹1,078 crore, highlighting the growing role of such platforms in augmenting non-tax receipts.

Higher dividend inflows from CPSEs, together with the record surplus transfer from the Reserve Bank of India, have helped cushion the Centre's fiscal position in recent years. Supported by an RBI dividend of Rs 2.69 lakh crore, the fiscal deficit for FY26 has been pegged at 4.4% of GDP, lower than 4.8% in FY25.

Maha brace for Budget session face-off over plane crash row

THE MAHAYUTI AND the Opposition are headed for a showdown on several issues, including the death of Deputy CM Ajit Pawar in a plane crash, mounting debt on government, and the impact of the Indo-US deal on farmers, in the Budget session of the state legislature beginning Monday.

This will be the first session in Maharashtra's legislative history in which both the assembly and legislative council won't have a Leader of Opposition (LoP). Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis is scheduled to present the state budget for the financial year FY27 on March 6, replacing Deputy CM Ajit Pawar, who was killed in a plane crash last month.

This will be the first legislative session of Pawar's wife and newly-anointed Deputy

CM Sunetra Pawar.

On Sunday, the Opposition boycotted the customary tea party hosted by Fadnis, claiming that the state government had not expressed any regret over the potential impact of the Indo-US trade deal on cotton growers and fisherfolk from Maharashtra.

The Opposition camp, however, suffered an embarrassment when leaders of the NCP (Sharadchandra Pawar) skipped the Maha Vikas Aghadi meeting, citing previous engagements.

Shiv Sena (UBT) played down the absence of the ally, attributing it to a "bit of a communication gap".

However, the timing raised eyebrows as the Uddhav Thackeray-led party has asserted its "first right" to the opposition alliance's lone winnable Rajya Sabha seat from Maharashtra in the upcoming elections.

PM unveils ₹13K-cr projects in Meerut

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi on Sunday inaugurated development projects worth around ₹12,930 crore in Meerut and said the BJP's work culture ensures the timely completion of projects once their foundation is laid.

Addressing a public meeting after flagging off the Meerut Metro and the Namoo Bharat train from Shatabdi Nagar Namoo Bharat Station, Modi said the programme showcased the governance model of the "double-engine" government.

"BJP's work culture is about toiling day and night to ensure projects are completed once their foundation is laid. Improved law and order and safer travel have now transformed the area," he said.

He said for the first time, rapid rail and metro services were launched from the same platform and called it a glimpse of the connectivity envisioned for a developed India.

"Metro for intra-city travel and modern rapid rail for cleaner, faster mobility together reflect the vision of urban transformation," Modi said.

The prime minister said projects no longer face prolonged

delays as in the past, and noted that he had the opportunity to both lay the foundation and inaugurate the services.

Recalling his metro ride earlier in the day, he said students and other passengers expressed surprise at the scale and quality of the infrastructure.

He said the region has undergone a transformation with increased women's participation in various sectors.

Taking a swipe at the Congress, Modi said metro services were operational in only five cities during its tenure, whereas the BJP-led government has expanded the facility to more than 25 cities.

"Under the Congress-Samajwadi Party regime, progress would not have been possible amid infrastructure scams," he said. He congratulated the residents of Meerut, Uttar Pradesh and Delhi on the launch of the services and recalled his long association with Meerut, noting that he had launched his campaign for the 2014, 2019 and 2024 Lok Sabha elections from the city.

He slammed the opposition, saying that there was a time when the Congress government could not finalise agreements with developed countries even if it wanted to.

Rapid rail services to reduce travel time: Yogi

UTTAR PRADESH CHIEF Minister Yogi Adityanath on Sunday lauded the Centre's push for digital and physical infrastructure, saying India's transformation under Prime Minister Narendra Modi has drawn global recognition and improved ease of living for citizens.

Addressing a gathering at the inauguration of the Namoo Bharat Rapid Rail and Meerut Metro services, Adityanath said India has built a robust digital public infrastructure covering 1.4 billion people, processing nearly 20 billion digital transactions every month.

He said more than 500 million digital health IDs have been issued under the "One Health" initiative, enabling beneficiaries to avail treatment under the Ayushman Bharat scheme.

Referring to praise from French President Emmanuel Macron, the chief minister said the world has acknowledged India's success in leveraging technology to deliver welfare

benefits to the poor, farmers and youth without discrimination. Adityanath said the prime minister's regular review of infrastructure projects has helped fast-track projects worth ₹85 lakh crore that had remained pending for decades.

Highlighting connectivity improvements, he said the travel time between Delhi and Meerut has reduced from four to five hours to around 45-50 minutes due to expressway expansion and the launch of rapid rail services.

The Namoo Bharat and metro projects would further strengthen regional connectivity, he added. Adityanath welcomed Modi to Meerut and said the new infrastructure projects would further accelerate development in western Uttar Pradesh. Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday flagged off the Meerut Metro and Namoo Bharat train from the Shatabdi Nagar station here, giving a fillip to high-speed intercity travel and swift intra-city movement.
