IMD STANDS BY FORECAST

Skymet casts doubt over IMD monsoon onset announcement

New Delhi, May 30

PRIVATE WEATHER FORECASTER Skymet on Monday questioned the India Meteorological Department's (IMD) announcement that the south-west monsoon arrived in Kerala on Sunday, three days ahead of the "normal" date.

"Declaring monsoon based on single day observations amounts to gross violation of standards, never attempted in the past," Skymet said. Going by what it called "specified objective criteria" for forecasting monsoon arrival, the agency said, "Monsoon does not seem to be kicking up soon over Kerala and Peninsular India."

An IMD official, however, told FE that the department had "complied with all parameters to predict the onset of monsoon. 'We don't want to react to statements made by any private agencies,' he said.

Earlier, Skymet had forecast monsoon reaching the Kerala coast on May 26 while IMD's initial forecast was May 27. On Friday, the official weather agency said monsoon would arrive in the Indian sub-continent "in the next two to three days". On Sunday, it confirmed the onset.

IMD and Skymet had such spats in the past too. For instance, in 2013, both dif-



ferred on whether the showers over north India during mid-June that year were monsoon rain. IMD said it was indeed monsoon, Skymet asserted it was pre-monsoon freak shower.

Skymet said: "Onset of monsoon has specified objective criteria comprising of rainfall, winds and outgoing long wave radiations (OLR). If after May 10, 60% of the available 14 stations, viz Minicoy, Amini Divi, Trivandrum, Punalur, Kollam, Alappuzha, Kottayam, Kochi, Thrissur, Kozhikode, Thalassery, Kannur, Kudulu, and Mangalore report rainfall of 2.5mm or more for 2 consecutive days, the onset over Kerala is declared on the 2nd day, provided the winds and OLR criteria also remains in concurrence."

Customs duty cuts on industry inputs to cost govt ₹15k cr in FY23

THE RECENT REDUCTION in import duties on select raw material for plastics, metals and steel industries will cost the exchequer about ₹15,000 crore in the current financial year on a net basis, after adjusting for the revenue gain from the hike in export duties on some steel products, a senior finance ministry official said on Monday.

On May 21, the government scrapped the 5% import duty on coke and semi-coke. A 2.5% basic customs duty (BCD) on PCI coal and coking coal was also scrapped, and the BCD on naphtha reduced to 1% from 2.5%. The duty on ferro-nickel was cut to zero and that on methyloxirane (propylene oxide), an input for plastics, to just 2.5%.

It also imposed an export duty of 45% on iron ore pellet, and of 15% on select pig iron, flat-rolled products of iron or non-alloyed steel, bars and rods

and various flat-rolled products of stainless steel. Similarly, the export duty on iron ores and concentrates was raised from 30% to 50%. All these changes were effective from May 22.

On May 21, the government had also cut excise duty on petrol by ₹8/litre to ₹19.1/litre and that on diesel by ₹6/litre to ₹15.8/litre, a move that would cost the exchequer ₹1 trillion annually, or roughly ₹85,000 crore in the remainder of FY23.

"While excise and customs duty collections will be impacted in FY23 due to the duty cuts, likely higher goods and services tax receipts will help cover to some extent the shortfall in other indirect taxes," the official said.

Despite the revenue loss of about ₹1 trillion on account of excise and customs duty cuts in FY23, analysts say the Centre's net tax receipts are expected to exceed the budget estimate for this year by ₹1-1.3 trillion as the Budget has adopted a conservative estimate.
