Shah said, "Assam cannot be led by people who visit Pakistan frequently."

The Assam CM and the BJP have been attacking the Deputy Leader of Congress in Lok Sabha over his wife's alleged connection with Pakistan's spy agency ISI.

Sarma had claimed that Gogoi's British wife Elizabeth Colburn had travelled 19 times between India and Pak-

istan.

Only 117 claims, objections received from political parties in Bihar: ECI

Despite repeated allegations of "vote theft" and "voter list manipulation" from the opposition parties, the Election Commission of India (ECI) on Friday revealed that only 117 claims and objections were received from political parties during the period from August 1-29.

This contrasts sharply with the nearly 2.12,000 claims and objections submitted directly by electors.

The ECI's latest bulletin, dated August 29, shows that out of 117 claims and objections submitted by political parties, a significant majority (108) came from the Communist Party of India (Marxist-Leninist) (Liberation) alone.

The Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) filed nine objections, while all six recognised national parties, including the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), Aam Aadmi Party (AAP), Bahujan Samaj Party (BSP), Communist Party

of India (Marxist), Indian National Congress (INC), and the National People's Party, filed a total of zero claims and objections.

This data was released amid ongoing criticism from opposition parties like the Congress and RJD, who have alleged that the SIR process is a "conspiracy" to steal votes and disenfranchise eligible citizens.

The period for filing claims and objections is set to end on September 1, with just three days left for submissions.

The ECI stated that generic complaints, without the prescribed forms, are not counted as valid claims or objections.

The bulletin also provided additional data, noting that the Election Registration Officer (ERO) received zero claims from any person other than electors of a specific Assembly Constituency, as per Section 2(g) of the Representation of the People Act, 1950.

Does Centre want border wall like US? Top court on illegal immigrants

The Supreme Court on Friday asked the Centre whether it wanted to build a border wall like in the US to prevent illegal immigrants from entering the country.

The top court outlined the "same legacy of cultural and linguistic heritage" shared by Bengali and Punjabi speaking Indians with the neighbouring countries, and speaking the same language but divided by borders.

A bench of Justices Surya Kant, Joymalaya Bagchi, and Vipul M Pancholi went on to ask the Centre to apprise it about the standard operating procedures (SOP) adopted by the governments in deporting illegal migrants, especially to Bangladesh.

The top court also implored the Gujarat government as a party in the matter.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, objected to the petition filed by the West Bengal



Migrant Welfare Board alleging detention of Bengali-speaking migrant workers on suspicion of being Bangladeshi nationals and said no aggrieved parties were present before the court.

"This court should not entertain petitions filed by these organisations and associations, which may be supported by some state governments. There are no aggrieved parties before the court. We know how some state governments thrive on illegal immigrants. Demographic changes have become a serious issue," he said.

The bench told Mehta that

those aggrieved were perhaps unable to reach the top court for want of resources.

Mehta, referring to advocate Prashant Bhushan, appearing for the petitioner board and other NGOs, said such "public spirited persons" must help them in approaching the court besides helping people in the US, where the issue of illegal immigration was big.

Justice Bagchi subsequently asked Mehta, "Do you want to build a border wall like in America to prevent illegal immigrants from entering India?" Mehta replied, "Certainly not, but there are no individual complainants.

Mizoram Assembly adopts bill banning begging in state

The Zoram People's Movement (ZPM) government in Mizoram adopted a bill in the Legislative Assembly to prohibit begging in the state while the opposition Mizo National Front (MNF) opposed the bill.

Mizoram Social Welfare Minister Lalrinpuui moving the bill -- Mizoram Prohibition of Beggary Bill, 2025 -- in the house said that the objective of the bill is not only to ban begging, but also to assist and rehabilitate beggars by providing sustainable livelihood options and support.

"Begging is increasing in Mizoram. However, the number of beggars currently is not much and the state has some beggars due to the social structure of the state. Besides involvement of churches and NGOs to prevent begging, the state government has already implemented welfare schemes for the benefit of the hapless poor people and beggars," the Minister told the house.

Nitish's fin sops for employment

The Nitish government on Friday approved the flagship scheme, 'Mukhyamantri Mahila Rojgar Yojana', to empower women through financial assistance and make them Atmanirbhar.

The decision was taken at a cabinet meeting chaired by Chief Minister Nitish Kumar, where the proposal was okayed.

Under the scheme, one woman from each family in Bihar will be eligible to receive an initial financial assistance of Rs 10,000 as the first instalment to begin employment of her choice.

The process of receiving applications from interested women will begin soon, and the transfer of funds directly into beneficiaries' bank ac-



counts will start from September. After six months of starting the employment activity, an assessment will be conducted, and depending on the progress, beneficiaries may receive additional financial assistance of up to Rs 2 lakh.

To support women entrepreneurs, the government will also develop haat bazaars across villages, towns, and cities for the sale of their products.

Class 9 student gives birth in school toilet

A 17-year-old class 9 student of a government-run residential school gave birth to a baby boy in the school's toilet, police said on Friday. The incident occurred at around 2 pm on August 27 at a school in Shahapur taluk of the district.

The matter came to light after the girl's classmates, who reportedly saw her in labour, alerted the school administration, police said.

According to the FIR, the girl-aged 17 years and seven months-was full-term pregnant and had been "sexually assaulted" by an unidentified person about nine months ago.

Initially, the girl, said to be under "immense stress," refused to reveal details of the incident or the person involved. She only told authorities that she developed stomach pain while in the washroom and delivered the baby there.
