EU tells Instagram, Facebook to change addictive features or risk fines

The EU charged Meta Platforms' Instagram and Facebook on Friday with breaching its tech rules, with regulators targeting features they say are designed to keep users hooked and demanding changes to autoplay and infinite scroll or risk fines. The European Commission's preliminary findings follow a two-year investigation under the European Union's landmark Digital Services Act.

Amazon India's Prime Day gets faster as smaller cities drive growth

Amazon India said the 10th edition of its annual Prime Day event was the company's fastest yet, with one in every two items delivered within minutes in cities served by its Amazon Now quick-commerce service. The sales event, which featured products ranging from premium electronics and beauty items to everyday essentials, also drove a more than threefold increase in same-day deliveries, extending to smaller cities. More than 70 per cent of new Prime memberships during the event came from Tier-II, III cities, showcasing the growing adoption of the service beyond India's largest urban centers. Nearly half of Prime Day orders on the service were for non-grocery items, including cameras and personal-care appliances.

Nvidia supplier to invest up to \$1.4 bn in US facility

Taiwanese chip-testing company King Yuan Electronics (KYEC) plans to invest up to \$1.4 billion to establish a facility in the United States, the supplier to chipmaker Nvidia said on Friday.

The investment is intended to support operational growth and strengthen its position in the global supply chain, the firm said. Taiwanese semiconductor and electronics companies have been expanding manufacturing in the United States since TSMC's multibillion-dollar investment in Arizona. Among them, Foxconn and Wistron are building AI server manufacturing capacity in Texas for Nvidia.

King Yuan Electronics did not say which customers the planned U.S. facility or disclose its location.

After WhatsApp, Telegram submits reply on username feature notice

After WhatsApp, messaging platform Telegram has also submitted its reply to the IT Ministry's notice on the 'username' feature, according to sources. Submissions of both WhatsApp and Telegram are currently being examined by the government, sources told PTI. The content of the responses could not be immediately ascertained, and there was no official comment from either company. The IT Ministry issued a notice to WhatsApp last Wednesday, questioning the proposed feature, as the government flagged concerns that it could materially increase online fraud, digital arrest scams, and impersonation attacks.

OpenAI rolls out ChatGPT 5.6, new models

With voice, text, image, work, and code, these models can help improve education in India, say experts

OpenAI on Friday announced the rollout of ChatGPT 5.6 for global audiences after a delay following the US government's request to initially limit the release to a group of approved users.

Along with ChatGPT, the company's flagship large language model (LLM), OpenAI also announced the launch of Sol, a new flagship model, as well as Terra, a balanced model for everyday work, and Luna, its most cost-efficient model.

"GPT-5.6 Sol sets a new standard for both intelligence and efficiency, achieving state-of-the-art results across coding, knowledge work, cy-

bersecurity, and science, while outperforming previous and competing frontier models with fewer tokens and at lower estimated cost," OpenAI said.

The release of the ChatGPT 5.6 family of LLMs comes nearly a year after OpenAI announced ChatGPT 5.0. The company had launched its first model, ChatGPT 3.5, nearly 32 months ago in November 2023. Since then, its LLMs have helped OpenAI grow into one of the most valuable technology companies worldwide.

The rollout of the Sol, Terra, and Luna models is being viewed as the natural progression, in which artificial intelligence (AI) models will become better, faster, and cheaper, said Pawan Prabhat, cofounder of Shorthills AI.

"With these changes, I think we're

moving down a path that has been fairly well-predicted. With voice capabilities improving, and more competition emerging around coding and biology tasks, we should see disruption in these industries much faster, in terms of better, faster

research, and more voice-based call centres or voice-based support. I think they will see a lot of change," Prabhat said.

The new family of models also signals a shift from a single all-purpose AI to a portfolio designed for different

needs, said Jaspreet Bindra, co-founder of AIBeyond.

"It is also interesting that they have put in voice, text, image, work, and code all in one model, unlike competitor Claude. For India, this matters because cost remains a major barrier to enterprise and mass-market AI adoption," he said.

For countries such as India, these models can also help improve education, as these newer LLMs can converse very well and help people solve various problems, Prabhat said.

"In a mobile-first country with varying levels of literacy, especially in English, voice could become the primary interface to AI, particularly for learning, commerce, public services, and customer support," Bindra said.

Vivo to hive off its manufacturing unit to Dixon Tech

Chinese mobile company Vivo plans to hive off its Noida-based manufacturing unit to its upcoming joint venture (JV) with domestic electronics manufacturing services firm Dixon Technologies and move to an asset-light business model in India, sources aware of the development told PTI.

The government on Wednesday approved Vivo Mobile India's application to form a joint venture with Dixon Technologies.

The approval came after about 18 months of signing a pact between the two companies. "Vivo's Noida manufacturing unit will become part of the JV and gradually the mobile company will move to an asset-light business model," a source aware of the development said. Email

query sent to Vivo and Dixon in this regard did not elicit any immediate reply.

Dixon Technologies will hold a 51 per cent stake in the proposed JV and Vivo Mobile India Private Limited (VMI) will hold 49 per cent stake.

The JV company will carry on the business as an original equipment manufacturer of electronic devices, including smartphones, in India.

The disclosure made by Dixon Technologies on the JV has already mentioned that the proposed entity will "undertake part of VMI's OEM orders of smartphones in India" and can also engage in the OEM business of various electronic products of other brands. Vivo is estimated to have sold 3.5 crore handsets in 2025, while Dixon's mobile phone production volume was around 3.2 crore units.

Zostel's fresh plea against Oyo dismissed

The Delhi High Court (HC) has dismissed a fresh application filed by backpacker hostel chain Zostel in its long-running legal dispute with Oyo parent Oravel Stays (PRISM), after the company chose to not press the plea. The matter was heard by a two-judge bench of Justices Nitin Wadudeo Sambre and Amit Sharma on July 8.

In its application, Zostel had sought interim protection

to preserve its claimed 7 per cent stake (or equivalent value) in Oyo, asking that the company either ring-fence those shares or provide equivalent security before proceeding with its initial public offering (IPO).

Simultaneously, the HC also listed the main appeal for hearing on August 12. "Oyo accepted the binding effect of the court's order dated March 14, 2022, reaffirming that it shall transfer 7 per cent

equity in Oyo (or the equivalent value thereof) to Zostel upon Zostel succeeding in the pending appeal. The division bench has listed the appeal for hearing on August 12, 2026. The proceedings mark a significant reaffirmation of Zostel's continuing rights, which are now set for adjudication on merits," Zostel said in its statement.

Oravel and Zostel are locked in a legal dispute over a

failed acquisition attempt. While Zostel alleges that the other party did not complete the deal, Oravel maintains that the term sheet it signed was non-binding and primarily exploratory in nature.

This comes two days after Zostel approached the Securities and Exchange Board of India, alleging that Oyo had made incomplete, misleading and selective disclosures in its updated draft red herring prospectus. Zostel sought corrective disclosures before the IPO.

Google refused interim relief in adword case

The Delhi High Court on Friday declined to grant interim relief to Google India in its appeal against a judgment that held the company liable for trademark infringement arising from the use of its Google Ads platform in a dispute with sanitaryware manufacturer Hindware.

A division Bench comprising Justice V Kamswar Rao and Justice Manmeet Pritam Singh Arora directed the

parties to file their written submissions and listed the matter on July 24 for final disposal.

Senior advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi, appearing for Google, submitted that the matter "cries out" for notice and interim protection.

He said the issue involved in the case is that when you use someone's trademark simply as a trigger for search, will that amount to per se infringement? He said that admittedly, there is no finding of confusion in the single judge ruling.

Singhvi added that two division Bench decisions of the high court have said that when you use someone's trade name as a trigger, and there is no confusion, there cannot be any per se infringement.

A single judge Bench, in the judgment pronounced on May 22, had directed Google LLC and Google India to jointly pay ₹30 lakh as nominal damages to Hindware Limited.

It was held that Google cannot be permitted to shrug off responsibility by making avail-

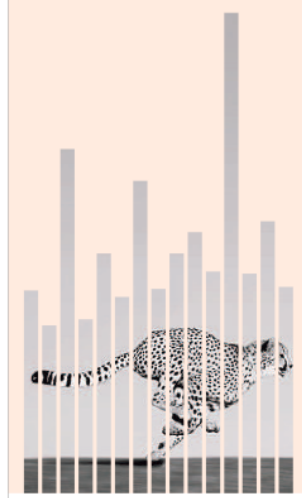
able a tool that leads to infringement, and then turning around to claim that the said tool was not mandatory.

Hindware had filed two suits after discovering that competitors Grohe and Cera had purchased "Hindware" and related keyword combinations on Google's advertising platform, causing sponsored links for rival brands to appear for term searches like "Hindware Sanitaryware", "Hindware Sanitary" and "Hindware Sanitary Ware India."
