Pakistan evacuates 150,000 people after flood warning from India

LAHORE : (AGENCY)

Pakistan evacuated at least 150,000 people in areas along three rivers in its agricultural heartland under threat of flooding after neighbouring India warned it plans to release excess water from a dam, officials said on Tuesday. The two countries have been ravaged by intense rain and flooding in recent weeks. The release of excess water threatens to further inundate part of Pakistan's Punjab province, which serves as the country's breadbasket and accounts for a large part of its food supply. Pakistani officials said they received a surprise warning from India on Monday that it intends to release water from the rapidly filling Madhopur Dam, on its side of Punjab province. India routinely releases water from its dams when they get too full, with the excess flowing into Pakistan. An Indian government source said they had



not mentioned a specific dam but the intense rain led them to share a second warning with Pakistan through diplomatic channels. Asked if more warnings could be issued as rain continues, he said it was possible. New Delhi had said on Sunday that it warned Pakistan that large volumes of water would

flow into its waterways due to the heavy rainfall. Three rivers - Ravi, Sutlej and Chenab - flow into Pakistan from Indian territory. Those rivers are seeing medium to high flooding, Pakistan's National Disaster Management Authority said on Tuesday. Mazhar Hussain, a Pakistani disaster management official,

said India will release a controlled amount of water from dams in the coming days. Hundreds of villages situated on the embankment of the three rivers have been evacuated, he said. Pakistan's northwest has been hammered by intense floods, accounting for half of the 799 people killed this monsoon season.

Asked if more warnings could be issued as rain continues, he said it was possible. New Delhi had said on Sunday that it warned Pakistan that large volumes of water would flow into its waterways due to the heavy rainfall.

The northern region of Gilgit Baltistan has suffered accelerated glacial melting, while the southern city of Karachi was partly submerged last week. Now the worst of the flooding is threatening the eastern province of Punjab, home to half of Pakistan's 240 million people. The province produces the majority of Pakistan's staple crops and the areas along the three rivers boast large tracts of fertile agricultural lands. The warning from India on Sunday.

2 police officers killed, another shot in rural Australian town

Two police officers were killed and another seriously wounded in a shooting Tuesday at a property in a rural part of Australia. The gunman remained at large as police scoured a vast remote area. The shooting occurred in mid-morning when 10 armed police officers tried to execute a search warrant at a property in Porepunkah, a town of just over 1,000 people in Victoria state 320 kilometres northeast of Melbourne. The suspect killed a 59-year-old detective and a 35-year-old senior constable, Victoria's Chief Commissioner of Police Mike Bush told reporters at a news conference in the nearby city of Wangaratta. The officers "were met by the offender and they were murdered in cold blood," Bush said. The man fled alone, on foot and heavily armed into surrounding forest where hundreds of officers were still searching for him, the police chief said. Bush would not divulge what the

warrant related to and wouldn't confirm the man's name or believed motivations. Officers were also seeking the man's wife and two children, whose whereabouts were unknown. Another detective was shot and was undergoing surgery Tuesday night, Bush said. The man's injuries were not life threatening. Police urged residents to stay indoors and told the public not to travel to the area. Public buildings and the nearby airfield were closed. The local school of

just over 100 students was in lockdown for hours before students were allowed to go home. As darkness fell, the massive manhunt continued. Television reports showed helicopters and police dogs in the area. Porepunkah, known for its vineyards and scenic vistas, is a gateway to Victoria's alpine tourist region. Members of Victoria's police union were struck by a "shocking and eerie feeling of dread," said Police Association Victoria Secretary.

Trump threatens additional tariffs for countries with digital taxes

President Donald Trump on Tuesday threatened to impose "substantial additional tariffs" on the exports of countries to the US that impose digital taxes and regulations to "harm American technology companies." He also warned of imposing restrictions on the exports of US technology and chip unless these measures are repealed. "I put all Countries with Digital Taxes, Legislation, Rules, or Regulations, on notice that unless these discriminatory actions are removed, I, as President of the United States, will

impose substantial additional Tariffs on that Country's Exports to the U.S.A., and institute Export restrictions on our Highly Protected Technology and Chips," Trump said in a statement on Truth Social. The US President declared that "Digital Taxes, Digital Services Legislation, and Digital Markets Regulations" unfairly target American technology companies while giving a "complete pass" to China's largest tech firms. "They are designed to harm, or discriminate against, American Technology," Trump stated, emphasising that such policies "must end.

US issues draft notice detailing plans to impose additional 25% tariff on India

WASHINGTON : (AGENCY)

The US Customs and Border Protection (CBP) has issued a draft notice on the implementation of additional duties on products imported from India, following the announcement by President Donald Trump to increase tariffs on Indian goods to 50 per cent. According to the notice, the additional tariffs are being imposed to give effect to the President's Executive Order 14329 of August 6, 2025, titled "Addressing Threats to the United States by the Government of the Russian Federation." The order specified a new rate of duty on imports of articles that are products of India. The draft notice, scheduled to be published on August 27, 2025, states that the Secretary of Homeland Security has determined it necessary to modify the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTSUS) in line with the executive order. The CBP further clarified that the new duties will come into effect on August 27, 2025. From 12:01 am eastern daylight time on that day, the higher tariffs will apply to all products of India that are either entered for consumption in the United States or withdrawn from warehouses



for consumption. "Remember, while India is our friend, we have, over the years, done relatively little business with them because their Tariffs are far too high, among the highest in the World, and they have the most strenuous and obnoxious non-monetary Trade Barriers of any Country," Trump said in a post on Truth Social. Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday remained firm ahead of the 50 per cent US tariffs on Indian goods, effective August 27, saying his government will find a way out regardless of the economic pressure by Washington. "No matter how much pressure comes, we will keep increasing our strength to withstand it. Today, the Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan is getting a lot of energy from Gujarat and behind this are two decades of hard work...," PM Modi said while speaking at a public address in Ahmedabad on Monday. Nepali Hindu women observe Teej, sharing pain and anxiety

Nepali Hindu women are observing the festival of Teej, sharing pain and anxiety through songs along with a fast and praying for a prosperous life and perpetual luck. Hundreds of fasting Hindu women on Tuesday thronged the Pashupatinath Temple in Kathmandu, paying obeisance to Lord Shiva, following the age-old tradition. "For the Teej, we took a bath and started fasting past midnight; before that, we ate only those foods considered sacred. Today, on the day of Teej, all fasting Hindu women refrain from eating or drinking anything, not even water, in observance of the long life of their husbands, a tradition that has continued for ages. As per the scriptures, Goddess Parvati also kept a similar kind of fast. Following our religious scripture, which mentions the fasting by Goddess Parvati and our grandmothers, mothers have been following this tradition, which we have continued," Bhima Subedi, a fasting Nepali Hindu devotee, said. Women on this third day of dark half of the lunar month that falls in the Nepali month of Bhadra



observe fasting and wish for a prosperous life while observing the festival. Soon after performing rituals at the temple, hundreds of fasting Nepali women gathered in the outer square, singing and dancing. Through the songs, women share their pain and sorrow about the hardships they have faced, accompanied by a blend of melody. "We have kept fasting after bath and only having the foods that are considered pure. The fast will continue throughout the day, tomorrow morning we will break the fast," Parvati Pant, another fasting devotee, told ANI. "Throughout the day we sing and dance, sisters scattered all across gather at one place, we would feast and share sorrows and pain with each other," Pant

added. The "Teej" festival is also celebrated as 'Haritalika', Hindu Nepalese women offer prayers and worship at Pashupatinath Temple and other temples of Lord Shiva in other parts of the country. According to the 'Skanda Puran' (a religious scripture of the Hindus), this festival got the name 'Haritalika Teej' as it was on this very day in the 'Satya Yug' (golden epoch of truth) that the daughter of the Himalayas, Parvati, was hidden by her maids because of her refusal to marry Lord Vishnu. day before 'Teej' on the night of the second day of the fortnight in the month of Bhadru, women enjoy a variety of delicious dishes known as 'Dar' at their parental home where they are especially invited for

Pregnancy has become nightmare for many women in Nigeria's conflict-hit north

Aisha Muhammed was in the third trimester of her pregnancy when she had the convulsions and high blood pressure of eclampsia, a leading cause of maternal death. Her village's only health clinic had no doctor, and the only medical help was 40 kilometres away in one of the world's most dangerous places. More women die giving birth in Nigeria than anywhere else in the world, according to the World Health Organisation. But Muhammed managed to reach the city of Maiduguri and have a caesarean section the next day, delivering twins in April. "Even though children are a source of joy, if I will have to go through the same ordeal again, I am afraid of getting pregnant," she said, fighting back tears. The odds are stacked against pregnant women in Nigeria's northeast like never before. The deadly Boko Haram militant group is making a resurgence. And hundreds of millions of dollars in foreign aid from the United States, once



Nigeria's biggest donor, have disappeared under the Trump administration this year. Roads are closed by fighting. Many doctors and other health workers, as well as aid organisations, have fled. In an attempt to make up for the lack of US funding, Nigeria has released an emergency USD 200 million for its health budget. At least one in every 100 women dies giving birth in Africa's most populous country, which faces chronic underfunding for health systems that cater to 220 million people. "If you count five people away, you know a woman who has probably had an issue with maternal morbidity or mor-

tality," said Jumoke Olatunji, a cofounder of the Lagos-based Alabiamo Maternal and Child Wellbeing Foundation. Maternal morbidity refers to the health problems caused to the mothers who survive. The Associated Press visited Borno state, one of the areas most threatened by the Boko Haram insurgency. Its militants have fought a 14-year conflict seeking to impose Islamic law and are best known for its mass kidnappings of schoolchildren. Now, despite the efforts of Nigeria's military, Boko Haram has been carrying out more assaults, attacking almost daily in the region.

Health workers say it is increasingly difficult to recruit doctors and others, especially outside of the relatively safe state capital, Maiduguri. "There have been times when there were (advertisements) but nobody is willing," said Dr. Fanya Fwachabe, Borno state sexual and reproductive health manager at the International Rescue Committee, one of the last international aid agencies still operating in the region.
