Details of change in the status/ development in relation to proceedings of material litigation

Sr. No.	Particulars	Details
1.	Brief details of litigation	<p>The Company had challenged the demand notice of Rs. 290.17 Cr, issued by the Department of Telecommunications towards One-Time Spectrum Charge (OTSC). The Company retained 1.25 MHz (out of an alleged excess of 2.5 MHz) in Mumbai by paying under protest pro-rate OTSC and surrendered the balance alleged excess spectrum in Mumbai and Maharashtra in 2013. Bombay High Court granted interim protection to the Company and stayed the demand.</p> <p>Hon'ble Bombay High Court vide orders dated September 18, 2024, allowed the Company to withdraw the aforesaid petition and to approach TDSAT while extending the interim protection for four (4) weeks from the date of the order. The Petition was withdrawn and filed with TDSAT, and which Petition is pending.</p>
2.	The details of any change in the status and/ or any development in relation to such proceedings	<p>Hon'ble TDSAT vide orders dated April 28, 2025 uploaded on TDSAT website on May 03, 2025.at 01:07 PM, has adjourned the matter sine die while granting the liberty to counsels for both parties to mention the matter, on further direction/decision in the pending appeals on the similar matter before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.</p> <p>TDSAT had noted the joint submissions of the parties that the judgment delivered by TDSAT dated February 4, 2019 in TP No. 26 of 2019 which was in favour of RCOM is applicable on the facts of the present case and that Union of India had filed Civil Appeals No. 6548 and 6549 of 2019 against the aforesaid judgment, which are now pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.</p> <p>The Company shall take the next steps in compliance with the aforesaid orders.</p>
