BHARAT BANDH AGAINST SC SUB-QUOTA VERDICT

Protesters halt goods train, effects seen in areas dominated by tribals in state

BLOCKING THE railway tracks, protesters on Wednesday derailed a goods train at the Wadhwan town of Surendranagar district during the day-long Bharat Bandh call given by a few Dalit and Adivasi groups against the recent Supreme Court judgment allowing sub-classification of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes for reservation.

The protests evoked mixed reactions across Gujarat with effects of bandh clearly visible in some parts, especially the areas dominated by tribal communities including districts like Chhota Udepur, Narmada, Surendranagar, Sabarkantha, and Anand where markets in rural and semi-urban areas remained closed. Protest rallies and sit-ins were organised in Vadodra and Ahmedabad also.

Soon after the protesters mocked the goods train in Wadhwan taluka, a team from Surendranagar police station reached the site to disperse the crowd. A group of women occupied the railway track and led a train from the level crossing in the Ganpatifasar area. Due to the protest, a goods train travelling from Surendranagar to Botad had to be halted near a station in Wadhwan. DSP Vishwanajsinh Jadesja said...

to hold demonstrations amid tight police presence.

Several protesters were detained in Patan district while trying to force the bandh, officials said. The impact of the bandh call was seen in the towns of Idar and Vijaynagar in the Sabarkantha district where markets, schools and colleges remained closed, with the authorities ordering heavy police deployment to maintain law and order.

Shouting slogans, SC/ST organisations took out protest rallies in Vadodra. In the Anaravdi locality of Ahmedabad city members of the Dalit community observed a sit-in and blocked a road.

Twenty-one organisations across the country have called for a Bharat Bandh on Wednesday against the recent ruling by the Supreme Court on quota. The organisations have said that it will harm the basic principles of reservation.

On August 14, the top court had held that the existing constitutionally empowered to make sub-classifications within the SCs (Scheduled Castes), which is said to form "a socially heterogeneous class" for granting reservation for the purpose of social, educational and economically more backward among them.

The apex court, however, made it clear that states have to make the sub-classification based on "quantifiable and demonstrable data" of backwardness and representation in government jobs and not on "whims" and as a matter of political expediency.

VINCHHYIA TALUKA PANCHAYAT ELECTION

Cong nominees withdraw, BJP takes control of panchayat

THE BJP on Tuesday seized control of Rajkot district's Vinchhya taluka panchayat, which falls in the Jasdan Assembly constituency of Water Resources Minister Kanwarji Bavalya, as Congress candidates withdrew from the election to the posts of president and vice-president, giving a walkover to the BJP nominees.

Three weeks around three weeks after a group of Congress rebels and BJP members pushed a no-confidence motion against Congress' incumbent president Parvin Gabu and vice-president Geeta Desliwala on August 1, bringing an end to the Congress reign in the taluka panchayat.

After the general board of the panchayat passed the no-confidence motion in the election to the posts of president and vice-president were warranted.

A special meeting of the general board was convened on Tuesday to elect new office-bearers of the panchayat. Backed by eight Congress rebels, BJP's Neeta Gadhadra and Bhupat Rojarsara filed their nomination for the posts of president and vice-president, respectively. Congress fielded Nikhil Gohil and Dilwala, respectively, for the twin posts.

Gohil was among the four rebels who had crossed-voted during the August 1 meeting of the no-confidence motion. While Deliwala had skipped the meeting, Akash Okadia, Meena Jadav and Kalpana Vasava had crossed-voted.

Gabu told The Indian Express, "We had wood back the four rebels, promising that they would be made president and vice-president. Accordingly, Congress gave mandate to Gohil to contest the poll of president while Deliwala was given ticket to contest for the post of vice-president. But by withdrawing his nomination papers at the last moment, Gohil betrayed us at the second time this month."

declared winners uncontested," he said, adding 12 members attended the meeting on Tuesday.

This is for the first time that the BJP has managed to win power in the history of Vinchhya taluka panchayat.

Congress had won 14 out of 18 seats in the general board of Vinchhya taluka panchayat in the general election in 2021. However, four of its members defected to the BJP around 10 months ago. As four more supported the August 1 no-confidence motion, the Congress strength was reduced to six.

Bavalya told mediapersons, "Today, eight Congress members supported (Gadhadra and Rojarsara) as the new president and vice-president, respectively. Soon, there will be a change of guard in Jasdan taluka panchayat as well because the majority of Congress members are supporting BJP."

Jasdan and Vinchhya taluka panchayats, both part of Jasdan Assembly constituency, have been Congress bastions with Bavalya. Then with Congress, used to call these two talukas as Congress bastions.

Bavalya had won from Jasdan for four consecutive times between 1995 and 2007. He won it for the sixth time in 2017. However, he defected to the BJP in 2018 and has been making desperate attempts to swing the two panchayats to the BJP's way.

Lawyer says 'beaten up by inspector' in Surat, probe ordered

THE SURAT Police on Wednesday started a probe into a complaint filed by a lawyer, who alleged that he was beaten up by second inspector H J Solanki of Dindoli police station when he was returning home.

The police said the incident took place late Saturday when lawyer Abhinav Naik was leaving his office at Madhuran Arcade in Surat's Dindoli area.

Advocate Deepak Kokas, who is Naik's senior, said, "As Naik was about to start his car, a Dindoli police patroling vehicle reached the spot. Solanki came out of the car, asked Naik what he was doing so late at the parking lot of the arcade. Solanki then kicked him while they had a heated exchange of words." Naik then called up his friends and reached the Dindoli police station to file a complaint, Kokas added.
