53 candidates ineligible, AMC cancels act to hire fire officers

BRENDANABHI AHMEDABAD, AUGUST 22 THE AHMEDABAD Municipal Corporation (AMC) on Thursday said that it has cancelled the advertisement it had issued in June for the recruitment of 53 fire officers (FO) and two deputy FOs, as no suitable candidate has been found.

The notification stated, "During the recruitment process, since no candidate was found to have suitable eligibility or experience, the recruitment advertisement has been cancelled."

The top four posts of the Ahmedabad Fire and Emergency Services (AFES) have been vacant for years. The post of CPO has remained vacant since the last time CPO, MF Dastot, retired on January 31.

2021. While additional CPO Rajesh Bhatt was made the charge CPO for one year (February 2021 to February 2022), deputy CPO Jayesh Nudala had held the post as charge since March 2022. The post of additional CPO has remained vacant since the end of February 2022 when Rajesh Bhatt retired. Deputy CPO, Kishan Mistry has retained the additional charge of the post since March 2022.

Of the four posts of deputy CPOs, while two have been filled by Khadia and Mistry, the rest have been vacant for over a decade. Notably, seven of the eight posts of CPO in major cities of Gujarat have been vacant for years.

Police crack down on landlords not sharing info on migrant labourers, 55 cases filed this month

A crackdown under the shop and house owners not intimating about renting out their premises to labourers migrating from outside and within Gujarat, Rajkot police have registered over 55 cases in August so far. On Wednesday, seven cases were registered at Rajkot's B Division police station after a team of the Special Operations Group (SOG) raided multiple premises on Sant Kabir Road.

The police or local magistrates have been issuing notices on owners making it mandatory for the owners/managers to furnish details of rent agreement, identity and address proof of tenants. "But compliance level is low in areas where jewellery manufacturing units are located. We had made the jewellery manufacturers and labour contractors aware about the need to share rent agreement details, after which they started doing it. But of late, things have stopped, saying they need more time. Therefore, we have started taking action against them for the past two months. In August, as much as 55 cases have been registered so far against the violation of the police commissioner's recent notification," Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime) Parthrajinh Gadi told The Indian Express.

SMC-RUN SCHOOL

46 children given leaving certificates in 7 months, principal suspended

EXPRESS NEWS SERVICE SURAT, AUGUST 22 THE PRINCIPAL of a city-run school has been suspended and a show-cause notice was issued to two resource coordinators at Surat after the Surat Municipal Corporation (SMC) found that 46 students below Class 8 were allegedly given leaving certificates between January to July this year.

A probe committee has also been set up to submit a report to SMC's administrative officer, Mehul Patel. The matter came to light when a parent approached SMC's member Swati Sengupta complaining that his two children, studying at Surat Municipal Corporation run school number 318 at Palanpur Canal Road, were frequently given leaving certificates by principal Vijay Zangrukiya because

of irregular attendance. The parent filed a complaint with the Urban Resource Coordinator URC (Kanshi Patel and Chater Resource Coordinator (CRC) Sonal Patel "not reporting the matter" to the municipal school board. 'COMMITMENT FOR LIFE'

VADODARA BJP corporator Ashish Joshi, who has been demanding exemplary compensation from the VMC for the Harni Boat tragedy victims that claimed the lives of 12 students and two teachers on January 18, has been keeping in touch with the families of the victims. On Raksha Bandhan, Joshi, a corporator of Municipal Ward 15, where most of the victims reside, visited the homes of deceased students Roshni Shinde and Alishta Kothari. Roshni's mother Sarika and Alishta's mother Adeeba tied rakhis to Joshi. "It was the first Raksha Bandhan after the tragedy and the younger brothers of both girls were inconsolable as they were missing them. I visited their homes to assure them that I will not stop fighting for them until justice is given. By having their mothers tie me rakhis, I have made a commitment for life," he said.

THUMPING WELCOME

ON THE first day of the three day Mousam Session of the Gujarat Legislative Assembly, newly-elected BJP MLAs Arjun Modhwadia and C J Chavla were given a thumping welcome by their party legislators as they entered the House at 10 a.m. on the right side of the Chair. Both Modhwadia and Chavla, former Congress legislators, won by-election from Porbandar and Vijapur constituencies respectively. After the simultaneous Lok Sabha and by-elections, the Congress which had won 17 seats in 2022 assembly polls, was reduced to 12 MLAs in the House - with the total strength of 182 - with the BJP having 161 legislators.

Two Bangladeshi minors rescued, trafficker arrested

Ahmedabad: The Crime Branch of Ahmedabad Police Thursday arrested a man accused of luring the families of minor girls in Bangladesh with the prospect of a job, trafficking them to India and then thrusting them into sex trade in Gujarat. The Crime Branch arrested 26-year-old Sagar Milan Mandal, a citizen of North 24 Parganas in West Bengal from a rented apartment in the Vastra area. The police also found two minor girls in the house.

Upon probing the girls' identities and speaking to their mothers in Bangladesh, the officials learnt that Mandal and his Bangladesh accomplice, Mohammed Arif Abdulhann Manil, approached the families of the minors about two-and-a-half-months ago offering jobs for their daughters in Ahmedabad. The accused trafficker said he took the girls to India after which they were brought to the resident apartment. Sagar Milan allegedly raped one of the minors. The girls were then allegedly pushed into sex trade through which the accused was profiting.
