MPSC row: BJP says govt ready for talks, accuses Raut of 'political theatrics'

Mumbai, Sept 8 (UNI) : Maharashtra Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) chief spokesperson Navnath Ban on Tuesday said the government is ready to hold discussions with Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC) aspirants as many times as necessary, but will not allow Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Sanjay Raut to exploit the students' issues for political purposes.

Ban accused Raut of repeatedly questioning the "credibility of autonomous institutions", including the Election Commission, the Supreme Court and the MPSC, while portraying himself as the "only right person".

"Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis has been continuously discussing the concerns of MPSC students. If necessary, we will hold discussions with students ten times. But we will not allow your political theatrics to continue in Maharashtra," Ban said.

He alleged that Raut has been attempting to discredit constitutional and autonomous institutions for political gains after being unable to rebuild his political base.

Referring to Prime Minister Narendra Modi's remarks on "dimaagi Naxalism", Ban said the term is not meant for students but for those allegedly attempting to create disorder in the country.

Maharashtra emerges as major tourism hub, attracts nearly 45 lakh foreign tourists

Mumbai, Sep 8 (UNI) : Maharashtra is steadily strengthening its position on the global tourism map, attracting visitors with its scenic coastline, historic forts, heritage sites, religious destinations and rich natural beauty.

Nearly 44.97 lakh foreign tourists visited the state in 2025, placing Maharashtra second in the country in terms of foreign tourist arrivals.According to Tourism Ministry data, Maharashtra ranks sixth nationally in overall tourist visits and second in foreign tourist arrivals. Mumbai's metropolitan appeal, the Ajanta-Ellora heritage sites, forts in the Sahyadri ranges, Konkan's beaches, religious destinations and tourist attractions in western Maharashtra have contributed significantly to the growth of the state's tourism sector.

The state has also witnessed a steady rise in domestic tourism. In 2021, Maharashtra recorded around 4.36 crore domestic tourist visits, with the sector gaining further momentum in subsequent years.The year 2025 also saw the opening of the highest number of hotels in the state, resulting in the addition of nearly 10,000 new rooms. The expansion of accommodation facilities is expected to further support the growing inflow

of tourists.

Maharashtra Tourism Development Corporation has been conducting media campaigns to promote the state's diverse destinations.

The state's new tourism policy has also been designed to be more inclusive and is aimed at encouraging both domestic and international tourism.

Additional Chief Secretary of the Maharashtra Tourism Department Sanjay Khandare said the state has enormous tourism potential and that promotional campaigns and the new comprehensive tourism policy are helping increase tourist arrivals.

Destinations such as Lonavala, Mahabaleshwar and the Konkan coastline continue to attract large numbers of visitors. Maharashtra's wildlife tourism is also gaining popularity, with the Tadoba-Andhari, Melghat and Navegaon-Nagzira tiger reserves emerging as major attractions for tourists from India and abroad.

With its combination of heritage, nature, spirituality, wildlife and modern urban experiences, Maharashtra is increasingly establishing itself as a preferred destination for international as well as domestic travellers.

Bombay HC declines to quash defamation proceedings against Rahul Gandhi

Mumbai, Sep 8 (UNI) The Bombay High Court has refused to interfere with criminal defamation proceedings initiated against senior Congress leader Rahul Gandhi over alleged derogatory remarks concerning Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP).

The complaint was instituted by a local BJP functionary, who alleged that Gandhi's remarks describing the Prime Minister as "Choro Ke Sardar" and "Commander-in-Chief" were defamatory and intended to tarnish the reputation of the Prime Minister as well as members of the ruling party.

Seeking quashing of the complaint, Gandhi's legal team argued that the alleged statements did not specifically name the BJP or refer to any clearly identifiable class of persons. Consequently, it was contended that the complainant could not claim to be an aggrieved person competent to maintain criminal defamation proceedings.

The complainant and the prosecution opposed the plea, submitting that the remarks were directed against a definite and identifiable group and that an individual belonging to such a group could legitimately approach the court if he claimed to have been defamed.

Uddhav Thackeray unleashes attack on State & central governance over festival noise, MPSC crises & political defections

Mumbai, Sep 8 (UNI) : Launching a broadside against the ruling establishment, Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray came down heavily on the Maharashtra and central governments over a gamut of burning issues, ranging from the escalating noise pollution during festive celebrations and controversial dahi-handi practices to systemic administrative failures in MPSC exams and political manoeuvring.

Addressing a comprehensive press conference here, he questioned the shifting core of public celebrations, demanding stricter, uniform state policies rather than fragmented approaches.

Expressing deep concern over the commercialization and deafening chaos creeping into traditional celebrations like Ganeshotsav and Dahi-Handi, Thackeray drew a sharp contrast with Lokmanya Tilak's original vision of community building. He questioned the necessity of high-decibel DJs and vulgar performances, asking whether such trends should be misconstrued as Hindutva.The UBT Sena chief challenged Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, who also holds Home portfolio, to establish uniform decibel regulations across all municipal jurisdictions-such as Mumbai, Pune, Nagpur and

Panvel-instead of leaving enforcement to ad-hoc local decisions. He emphasized that dialogue with Ganeshotsav committees is crucial to curbing excess before resorting to punitive measures.Slamming the administration over recurring paper leaks and exam corruption, Thackeray threw his weight behind protesting MPSC aspirants. In a biting rebuke comparing political defections to student struggles, he remarked: "When MLAs defect, they fly off to Surat or Guwahati. So where are students supposed to go when their exam papers leak?"

He warned that crushing the futures of earnest youth striving for

public service threatens the very foundation of the state, criticizing the ruling coalition for prioritizing party splits and horse-trading over governance.

Addressing the protracted legal battle over the Shiv Sena party name and 'Bow and Arrow' symbol, Thackeray clarified that requests to freeze the symbol were aimed entirely at preventing its misappropriation while awaiting a judicial verdict. He criticized the sluggish pace of court proceedings and questioned the Election Commission's oversight on fast-tracked actions against specific municipal corporators, alleging targeted and one-sided political pressure.

development achievements and realities.

He said the younger generation would not be misled by repeated claims that the country's progress was fabricated. The Prime Minister's emphasis on youth was central to the Vadodara programme, which was billed as a major outreach to Gen Z and students. The integration of the youth interaction with the infrastructure launch was intended to present development and India's future economic prospects as interconnected themes. Modi has repeatedly positioned young Indians as key drivers of the country's ambition to become a developed economy, while stressing the need for modern infrastructure, manufacturing capacity and employment opportunities.The projects unveiled in Vadodara formed part of the Centre's broader push to expand multimodal connectivity and improve the efficiency of freight and passenger movement. Dedicated freight infrastructure is particularly significant for an economy seeking to expand manufacturing and exports, as quicker movement of raw materials and finished products can reduce logistics costs and improve the competitiveness of Indian industry.
