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Delhi Energy Mix Tilts to Petrol, CNG, EVs as Diesel Sales Falls 9% in FY25

Maharashtra saw a 5.3% sales increase, MP 5.5%, and Rajasthan 5.8% in 2024-25

New Delhi: Diesel consumption has been heavily influenced by a rapid shift away from diesel vehicles to petrol, CNG and electric vehicles over the past decade. Diesel sales in the capital in 2024-25 were down 9% from their peak in 2020-21, according to petroleum and natural gas ministry data. Increasing air pollution, which restricts the movement of diesel-powered vehicles as well as



factory and construction activity in the National Capital Region, has also helped drive down consumption. Neighbouring Haryana witnessed a barely 0.2% growth in diesel consumption, while Punjab and Himachal Pradesh registered a decline of 3.3% and 1.5%, respectively. In the last financial year, state oil companies rationalised in-transit freight, lowering pump prices at many locations that traditionally had higher rates due to their greater dis-

tance from fuel depots. This, in some cases, made these pumps more attractive for consumers, shifting some sales from adjoining states, said an industry executive, explaining the decline in diesel sales in Punjab. Three southern states—Andhra Pradesh (3.5%), Karnataka (3.3%) and Karnataka (0.8%)—increased a decline, while Tamil Nadu (0.3%) and Kerala (0.25%) registered marginal increases in sales. An increase in value-added tax by Karnataka, the third-largest diesel consumer in the country may have weighed on the state's sales last year, the executive said. Uttar Pradesh, the largest diesel consumer among states, witnessed a 3% increase in consumption in 2024-25, above the national average of 2%. The Maharashtra in FY2024 last year, at which drew millions of devotees from across the country for a holy dip in the Ganges, helped push up diesel consumption. LP accounts for about 1% of total national diesel consumption. Maharashtra, the second largest consumer of diesel, witnessed a 3.5% increase in sales, while Madhya Pradesh (clocked a 5.5% rise and Rajasthan 5.8%; Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand, which have large mining operations, registered 5% and 7% diesel sales growth, respectively. Gujarat's consumption growth of 1.8% was near the national average, while West Bengal's 0.6% was below the average.

Coal India, HZL Win Critical Mineral Blocks in 5th Round of Auction

New Delhi: State-owned Coal India, Oil India, NLC India and Vedanta group firm Hindustan Zinc are among the firms that have bagged critical and strategic mineral blocks under the fifth round of auction. While Coal India Ltd (CIL) has bagged a graphite and vanadium block in Chhattisgarh, Oil India Ltd emerged as a preferred bidder for potash and halite mine in Rajasthan. Another potash and halite mine in the desert state was bagged by Hindustan Zinc Ltd (HZL). HZL also bagged the REE (Rare Earth Elements) block in Uttar Pradesh in this round of auction. NLC India bagged two phosphate and limestone blocks in the state of Chhattisgarh. Other companies which have bagged blocks in this round of auction are Sunflag Iron and Steel Co Ltd, Vimur Resources Pvt Ltd, RKM Mineral Development Pvt Ltd and Ramprasad Minerals and Mining Ltd. "A key milestone under 'make in India' is the first ever successful auction of a Potash block by the Government of India, marking a major step towards unlocking domestic Potash resources. The move is expected to catalyse Potash mining in the country, reduce reliance on imports, and strengthen support to the agricultural sector," the mines ministry said in a statement. This milestone also marks the first ever successful auction of a critical and strategic mineral block in Rajasthan. The fifth round of auction of critical and strategic mineral blocks which was launched on 28th January has concluded with successful auction of 24 critical blocks put on auction. It said, "The state-owned enterprise critical and strategic minerals such as graphite, phosphorus, phosphate, Rare Earth Elements (REE), cesium, and potash and halite spread across Chhattisgarh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh. To date, a total of 34 blocks have been successfully auctioned in five tranches out of 50 critical mineral blocks which were put for sale.—PTI

Bayview Submits Layout of International Film City Project to YEIDA

Lucknow: Bollywood film producer Dinesh Kapoor's company Bayview Projects LLP on Tuesday submitted the layout of the International Film City to the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA), an official statement issued here said. YEIDA will now review the plan, and after necessary approvals, for final construction work to begin. The International Film City is planned to be developed over 1,000 acres along the Yamuna Expressway at Sector-21 in Greater Noida. The first phase will kick off on 230 acres of land with an estimated investment of Rs 1,500 crore, the statement said. OSD (Officer in special duty) to Yamuna Authority (YEIDA) Shalendra Bhatia said Kapoor, who has taken the responsibility of building the film city, submitted the complete layout of the project on behalf of his company. Now, the authority will review and examine the entire layout, after which they will give the necessary approval to start work, he said. CEO, YEIDA, Arun Vener Singh made it clear that the construction will fully follow the agreement, and no changes will be accepted without approval. Separate NOCs (no objection certificates) will be required for approvals like parking, landscaping, and gardening, he said. Bayview Projects LLP selected as the highest bidder by offering 10 per cent of gross revenue share, was issued the Letter of Award last year. On June 27, 2024, YEIDA and the concessionaire representative Kapoor signed the concession agreement. The site right of way was transferred to the concessionaire on February 27, 2025. The master plan of the film city was approved on January 30, 2025. The project will be completed in three phases over the next five years. In the first phase, construction will take place on 230 acres, and in future, expansion will happen on the remaining 770 acres in phases 2 and 3, the statement said.

The Statement has been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind AS") as prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and in terms of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.
3. The Company is engaged in the business of sales of automotive tyres, tubes and flaps. The Company sells tyres of its own brand "Goodyear". The Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM), Managing Director, performs a detailed review of the operating results, thereby makes decisions about the allocation of resources among the various functions. The operating results of each of the functions are not considered individually by the CODM, the functions do not meet the requirements of Ind AS 108 for classification as an operating segment, hence there is only one operating segment namely, "Automotive tyres, tubes & flaps".
4. The Board of Directors has recommended a dividend of Rs 23.90 per equity share of Rs.10 each for the Financial Year ended March 31, 2025, aggregating to Rs. 5,513 lakhs, subject to approval of Members at the ensuing Annual General Meeting. The register of members and share transfer books will remain closed from July 19, 2025 to July 25, 2025 (both days inclusive).
5. While performing physical verification in November 2024, the Company identified certain shortages in the finished goods inventory aggregating to value of Rs 452 lakhs which was accounted for as loss in the Statement of Profit and Loss in the quarter ended December 31, 2024. As reported in public domain in February 2025, the Company had appointed Ernst & Young LLP to conduct a fact-finding review in the matter. The review is ongoing and the final report is awaited. As a proactive step, the Company has identified key areas for strengthening controls and is implementing them. The Company will take all necessary steps after evaluating the final report.
Pending completion of review, management is of the view that on conclusion, the review will not have any further material impact on the financial statement as at March 31, 2025, as all known impact has already been accounted for and further no material discrepancy has been noted in the physical verification performed on March 31, 2025.
6. The figures of last quarter of current and previous year are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures up to the third quarter of the financial year which are subject to limited review.
7. This Statement has been reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on May 27, 2025. The financials results for the year/quarter ended March 31, 2025 have also been subjected to audit/review by the Statutory Auditors of the Company.

हाई कोर्ट ने बिजली निगम में हुई पदोन्नति पर लगाई रोक

चंडीगढ़, 27 मई (जनसत्ता)।

पंजाब-हरियाणा हाई कोर्ट ने हरियाणा विद्युत प्रसारण निगम लिमिटेड में कनिष्ठ लेखाकार को राहत देते हुए वर्ष 2012 और 2014 में हुई गलत पदोन्नति को रद्द कर दिया है। अदालत ने याचिकाकर्ता को वरिष्ठता के आधार पर पदोन्नत करने और दोषी अधिकारियों के खिलाफ विभागीय कार्रवाई करने के आदेश दिए हैं।

ज्योति सैनी और एक अन्य कनिष्ठ लेखाकार ने हाई कोर्ट में याचिका दायर कर कहा था कि वे अकाउंट्स संवर्ग (केडर) में कनिष्ठ लेखाकार के पद पर कार्यरत हैं और विभागीय परीक्षा भी उत्तीर्ण कर चुके हैं। बावजूद इसके, विभाग ने नियमों को दरकिनारा कर यूडीसी और एलडीसी संवर्ग के कर्मचारियों को पदोन्नत कर दिया। यह फैसला नियमों के खिलाफ था क्योंकि यूडीसी और एलडीसी अकाउंट्स संवर्ग का हिस्सा नहीं थे। मुख्य न्यायाधीश संजीव प्रकाश और न्यायमूर्ति मीनाक्षी आड़, मेहता को खंडपीठ ने स्पष्ट कर दिया कि पदोन्नति संबंधित संवर्ग में ही हो सकती है। अकाउंट्स संवर्ग की पदोन्नति केवल लेखाकार, कनिष्ठ लेखाकार और लेखाकार लिपिक तक सीमित रहेंगे। यूडीसी/एलडीसी मिनिस्ट्रियल संवर्ग के कर्मचारी हैं, उन्हें पदोन्नति का हक नहीं था।

इंतजार खत्म : सामान्य पात्रता परीक्षा का पंजीकरण आज से

हरियाणा में इस बार 31 लाख आवेदन आने की संभावना

चंडीगढ़, 27 मई (जनसत्ता)।

हरियाणा के लाखों युवाओं का सामान्य पात्रता परीक्षा (सीईटी) को लेकर इंतजार खत्म हो गया है। हरियाणा कर्मचारी चयन आयोग ने सीईटी के अधिसूचना जारी कर दी है। युवा 28 मई से पंजीकरण के लिए आवेदन कर सकेंगे।

हरियाणा में पिछले तीन साल से सीईटी के आयोजन को लेकर अटकलें चल रही हैं। हालांकि सरकार ने सीईटी की शुरुआत करते समय इसे हर साल आयोजित करने को कहा था लेकिन यह तीन साल से अटका हुआ था। मुख्यमंत्री स्वयं कई बार सीईटी के आयोजन को लेकर दावे कर चुके थे। लंबे इंतजार के बाद आयोग ने मंगलवार को सीईटी का कार्यक्रम जारी कर दिया है, लेकिन सीईटी की परीक्षा कब होगी इसके बारे में अभी भी कुछ नहीं बताया गया है। बुधवार से शुरू होने वाले

सोलह जून तक पूरी होगी प्रक्रिया, बाद में जारी होगी परीक्षा की तिथि। परीक्षा 100 अंक की होगी। कुल एक घंटा 45 मिनट का समय दिया जाएगा।

पंजीकरण का अंतिम तिथि 14 जून है। 16 जून शाम छह बजे तक उम्मीदवार अपना शुल्क जमा करा सकते हैं। अधिसूचना में स्पष्ट किया गया है कि परीक्षा 100 अंक की होगी। इसके लिए कुल एक घंटा 45 मिनट का समय दिया जाएगा।

प्रदेश में ग्रुप सी और डी में भर्ती के लिए सीईटी की अनिवार्यता है। तीन साल से सीईटी की परीक्षा नहीं होने के कारण युवा सरकारी नौकरियों से वंचित हैं। सरकार का अनुमान है कि 31 लाख युवा यह परीक्षा दे सकते हैं।

आयोग ने सीईटी कार्यक्रम ऐसे मौके पर जारी किया है जब मुख्यमंत्री नायब सिंह सैनी हरियाणा में 7,596 पदों पर सरकारी

भर्ती का एलान कर चुके हैं। यह भर्ती हरियाणा कर्मचारी चयन आयोग के जरिए ग्रुप डी के पदों के लिए होगी, जिसका जल्द ही विज्ञापन जारी होगा। इसमें पहली बार वंचित अनुसूचित जाति (डीएससी) और अन्य अनुसूचित जाति (ओएससी) वर्ग को आरक्षण दिया जाएगा।

सरकार के मुताबिक कुल पदों में से 1,209 पद इन्हीं दो जातियों के लिए आरक्षित रहेंगे। इनके चयन में सीईटी के स्कोर का भी इस्तेमाल किया जाएगा। ग्रुप-डी भर्ती में वंचित अनुसूचित जातियों के लिए 605 पद और अन्य अनुसूचित जातियों के लिए 604 पद आरक्षित किए गए हैं।

इस बीच मुख्यमंत्री नायब सिंह सैनी ने सोशल मीडिया 'एक्ज' पर कहा कि यह परीक्षा प्रदेश के लाखों युवाओं के लिए रोजगार का सुनहरा अवसर लेकर आ रही है। हमारी सरकार बिना खर्ची, बिना पर्ची की नीति पर पूरी निष्ठा से काम कर रही है।

पंजाब में फिर बढ़ सकती हैं कलेक्टर दरें


चंडीगढ़, 27 मई (ब्यूरो)।

पंजाब सरकार की ओर से कलेक्टर दरों में फिर से वृद्धि करने की तैयारी है। पंजाब के वित्त मंत्री हरपाल सिंह चीमा ने कहा कि उन्होंने संबंधित जिलों के उपायुक्तों से संपत्ति के पंजीकरण के लिए कलेक्टर की कीमतें बढ़ाने के लिए प्रस्ताव भेजने के लिए कहा है।

सूत्रों ने कहा कि सरकार इस साल भी दरों को पांच फीसद से बढ़ाकर 50 फीसद कर सकती है क्योंकि संपत्ति की बाजार दर और कलेक्टर की कीमतों के बीच 50-60 फीसद की अंतराल है।

बाजार की कीमतें कलेक्टर की दरों से बहुत अधिक हैं। चीमा ने कहा कि संपत्ति के कलेक्टरों और बाजार की कीमतों में अंतर के कारण, भ्रष्ट प्रथाएं पनपती हैं। हम इस सब को सुव्यवस्थित करने की कोशिश कर रहे हैं। जल्द ही, एक संशोधन होगा। हमने अतीत में तीन-चार बार संशोधन किए हैं।

चीमा ने कहा कि सरकार भ्रष्टाचार को समाप्त करने की कोशिश कर रही है और हम कलेक्टर की कीमतों को बढ़ाकर इस पर लगाम लगाने की कोशिश कर रहे हैं। चीमा ने कहा कि अब यह स्पष्ट नहीं है कि कीमतें कितनी बढ़ेंगी। यह डीसीएस की रपट पर निर्भर है।

कर्ज व घाटे के कारण पहले शहर छोड़ा, अब सपरिवार दुनिया

चंडीगढ़/पंचकूला, 27 मई (जनसत्ता)।

परिवार के लोगों ने बताया कि प्रवीन मित्तल को जब बैंक ने भगोड़ा घोषित किया

तो वे परेशान रहे लगे। यह भी बताया जा रहा कि उनको कर्ज न चुकाने पर धमकियां मिल रही थीं।

मृतक परिवार मूल रूप से हिसार का रहने वाला था और कुछ वर्षों से देहरादून में टूर एंड ट्रेवल का काम करते थे, लेकिन वहां भी उन्हें घाटा हुआ। हाल ही में वे वापस पंचकूला के मनसा देवी कॉम्प्लेक्स में किराए के मकान में रहने लगे थे और टैक्सी चलाकर गुजारा कर रहे थे। उनके बच्चों का दाखिला चंडीगढ़ के सरकारी स्कूल में



हुआ था। पुलिस को घटनास्थल से एक सुरसाइड नोट भी मिला है। बताया जाता है कि मित्तल परिवार के सदस्यों प्रवीन मित्तल,

पत्नी रीना, मां विमला, पिता देशराज, जुड़वा बेटे हिमशिखा, दलिया (11) और बेटा हार्दिक (14) पंचकूला के सेक्टर-5 में सोमवार की रात आयोजित बागेश्वर धाम धीरे-धीरे शास्त्री की कथा सुनने के लिए आया हुआ था। कथा समाप्त होने के बाद वापस जाते हुए उन्होंने आत्महत्या का कदम उठाया।

प्रवीन के ससुर रakesh गुप्ता के अनुसार देहरादून चले जाने के बाद मित्तल परिवार को उनसे संपर्क नहीं था।
