The woman, Suman Vishwakarma, was a resident of Pipalia Pende Khan. She reached the top floor of the three-floor building of the Indira Gandhi Girls' Hostel and climbed up the tree to pluck blackberries. Unfortunately she slipped and fell down from the tree. The woman sustained severe injuries.

Janpad Panchayat CEO suicide case

Two BJP leaders held for abetment

Police on Wednesday arrested two local BJP leaders for allegedly abetting the suicide of the chief executive officer (CEO) of a janpad panchayat in Khargone district, an official said.

Rajesh Baheti, 54, the CEO of Bhikangaon janpad panchayat in Khargone district, committed suicide by hanging himself at his official residence on June 27,

police said.

The two, Dhannalal Khatwase and Dulichand Banke (an office-bearer of the janpad), were arrested on the basis of evidence and facts gathered in investigation so far, including a purported suicide note, Khargone Superintendent of Police (SP) Shailendra Singh Chouhan told reporters here.

On the basis of the suicide note and the statements of the deceased's family members, a case under

the IPC section 306 (abetment of suicide) was registered against Khatwase and Banke, he said and added that both allegedly used to pressure Baheti for government work.

Further investigation was underway, he said. Khatwase is the husband of janpad president Rekha Bai, while Banke is janpad (a sub-district administrative unit) vice-president.

Both are associated with the Khargone unit of the BJP, party sources said.

District BJP president Rajendra Rathore could not be contacted for comments on the issue despite repeated attempts.

However, district BJP media in-charge Prakash Bhavsar told PTI that senior leaders of the party will be apprised about the police action against Khatwase and Banke.

"The party will take suitable action against them," he said.

When contacted, state BJP secretary Rajneesh

Agrawal said only local leadership can talk about those arrested in the suicide case.

"I don't know them or their association with the party. But the law will take its own course and the party doesn't protect such persons," Agrawal said.

Meanwhile, Congress MLA from Bhikangaon Jhuma Solanki submitted a memorandum to the SP demanding an unbiased probe and action in the case.

Return of officers removed post-govt change looks difficult

BHOPAL: The officers transferred after the change of government may find it difficult to return. For the first time, after returning to power, the BJP is lifting the ban on transfers on Thursday. One clause in the transfer policy has worried the ministers. According to the new transfer policy, the proposal for shifting of the officers and the officials, who have been transferred between March 23 last year and June 30 this year, should be sent to the Chief Minister through Coordination.

190 investors duped of Rs 2.3 cr on lure of high returns in stocks

Police bust two gangs; arrest three crooks in Bhopal and two, including a woman in Hoshangabad

The Bhopal cyber cell busted two gangs that duped investors in the name of high returns in the stock market. While one gang operated from Baghsewania in Bhopal, the other was running the illegal activity from Hoshangabad district. Police have arrested five persons of the two gangs.

The Bhopal-based accused minted over Rs 2 crore duping 130 people promising them high return by investing their money in stock market. They targeted people all across the country. The fraudsters would take as low as Rs 10,000 from the investors promising then hefty return.

Similarly, the woman and her accomplices operating in Hoshangabad had collect-



ed Rs 30 lakh through their illicit business, cheating around 60 people.

Police said the Baghsewania-based accused Narendra Patel had learnt the nitty-gritty of the stock market from Youtube. Patel would choose his target and then access their data. He would call them and offer heavy returns

WOMAN LED THE HOSHANGABAD RACKET

Police have arrested a woman and a man who using similar modus operandi had allegedly duped over 60 people. The woman so far has made over Rs 30 lakh from her victims. The woman Mamta Mehra and her partner Salman Mansuri would run a call centre in Hoshangabad district from where they would call their targets. Mamta had earlier worked with a cyber crook Abhishek Gaur but later she left him and started working with Mansuri. She had managed a list of potential targets from her former partner Gaur crime. The woman would call the people and allure them promising good returns in the stock market. The duo would tell them to invest in the market and would take money in the name of Demat account and other formalities. Later, they would tell them that they have suffered a loss in trading. Also they would stop receiving calls from their victims. A Bhopal based man lodged a complaint with the cyber cell stating that a fake firm Swastika SNC had duped him of Rs 10,000. He said there is no such firm registered with the concerned board and then a case was registered. Police arrested Mamta and Salman from Hoshangabad.

On June 23, police received a complaint from a Bhopal-based person and an investigation was launched. Three persons Narendra Patel, Deepak Patel and Rajkumar Patel were arrested in connection with the fraud.

Patel ran Apex broking firm and he had a staff of 7 females and 18 males. • SI BK Garg said the accused would

ask for minimum charges of Rs 10,000 in the name of processing and training fee and then would take at least Rs 10,000. SI said that police have received information about 130 victims from their bank transactions but the figure is likely to increase. Also the amount is also likely to go above Rs 2 crore, said the cop.

Providing relief to devotees and a chance to visit Khajrana Ganesh, it was decided to keep the temple doors open till 10 pm from Wednesday. Since the lockdown was lifted, the temple was kept open from 9 am to 8 pm with restrictions of 4 to 5 people allowed inside the temple at any given point of time. The number of people allowed inside the temple has also been increased to 6 now.

To enter the temple, it is now compulsory to bring a certificate of having a vaccine or to show a message that the person has registered and is waiting for the slot of vaccination. Devotees will be allowed to enter the temple premises only after showing either of these.

Now, every day from morning till night, about 5,000-5,500 come to the temple for darshan. The largest crowd gathers on Wednesdays.

To follow the corona guidelines at the temple, only 6 devotees are being given entry at any given point of time. Apart from this, devotees are checked to see if they are wearing their masks properly when entering the temple premises. The number of devotees is also increasing in other temples, including Ranjit Hanuman Temple, Annapurna Temple and Bijasan Temple.

Dipesh Vyas, priest of Ranjit Hanuman temple, said, "Earlier, only 200-250 devotees used to come, but now 500 to 550 and, sometimes, 600 devotees have been visiting daily for a darshan." Here, the largest crowd is seen on Saturdays and Tuesdays. Ranjit Hanuman temple will also open for an hour more on these particular days due to the large crowds. Further, the number of devotees is also rising in Annapurna and Bijasan temples compared to earlier times.
