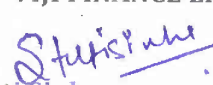

BSNL employees are traitors: Hegde

BJP leader, former Union minister and current Member of Parliament Anant Kumar Hegde, known for his loudmouth, has again courted a controversy by branding BSNL employees 'traitors' who would be fired as they refused to work. The MP from Uttara Kannada made the controversial remark on Monday at an event in Kunta. The video of what he said surfaced on Tuesday. "I had scolded them (BSNL employees) during a meeting in Karwar the other day. You are not officials, you are traitors. The government has given money, it is a service needed for the public and there is infrastructure but still they are not ready to work," Hegde said, adding, "The BSNL needs an urgent and major surgery and 85,000 employees will be retired."

He went on to say the BSNL is a blot on the country and that it will be 'finished' and re-

placed by private establishments. Soon after the video went viral, Srivatsa, National Campaign In-charge, Youth Congress tweeted: "BJP MP Anant Kumar Hegde calls BSNL employees anti-national. He announced that it will be privatised soon! Mr Hegde, your leader Modi has not allocated 4G spectrum to BSNL so that Jio benefits for Ambani, you killed BSNL. You are the actual 'Desh Drohis'."

Earlier this year, he had embarrassed BJP and PM Modi when he termed the freedom movement led by Mahatma Gandhi as a 'drama'. He declared the Constitution will be amended to remove the word 'secular' from the preamble. He later apologised. In March 2016, Hegde was booked for a hate speech in which he allegedly equated Islam with terrorism. In April 2020, Twitter placed restrictions on his official account for a controversial statement against the Tablighi Jamaat.

Six Manipur Cong MLAs resign from Assembly and party

Six Congress MLAs in Manipur have submitted their resignation from the Legislative Assembly and also quit the party on Tuesday. The six legislators who had handed over resignation letters to Speaker Yumnam Khemchand Singh the previous night, formally informed the Congress office here about leaving the party. "Six Cong MLAs of Manipur have submitted their

resignation letters to the Congress office," Hareeshwar Goshwami, General Secretary, Manipur Pradesh Congress Committee, told PTI. The six are among the eight Congress legislators who had defied a party whip on Monday and skipped the one-day session of the assembly, in which the BJP-led N Biren Singh government had comfortably won the confidence vote. Those giving up their assembly membership as

well as saying goodbye to the party included Okram Henry Singh, nephew of Congress Legislature Party leader, Okram Ibobi Singh. Other legislators are Oinam Lukhoi, Md Abdul Nasir, Paonam Brojen, Ngamthang Haokip and Ginsuanhau. Secretary of the Manipur Assembly M Ramani Devi told PTI that the speaker has accepted resignation of five of them and their assembly seats have been declared as vacant.

ACB files charge sheet in J&K Rs 250 cr loan scam

The Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) on Tuesday produced a charge sheet against three people including former chairman of Jammu and Kashmir Cooperative Bank for sanctioning a Rs 250 crore loan to a non-existent cooperative housing society two years ago. "The ACB filed a charge sheet

against Mohammad Shafi Dar, the then chairman of J&K State Cooperative Bank Limited (JKSTCB), Hilal Ahmad Mir, chairman of non-existent River Jhelum Cooperative House Building Society, Srinagar and Abdul Hamid Hajam, secretary of the non-existent River Jhelum Cooperative House Building Society, Srinagar," a spokesperson of the anti-graft body said here.

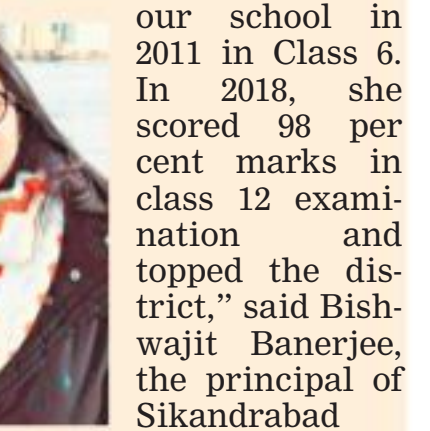
The ACB registered a case against Dar and others under various sections of prevention of corruption act for allegedly sanctioning a loan to the tune of Rs 250 crore in favour of the non-existent society for the purpose of construction of a satellite township at Shivpora locality in Srinagar by-passing the credit policy of the bank and on the basis of false and fabricated documents.

UP topper, studying in US, dies in accident after 'harassment'

A 20-year-old woman, on a visit home from the US where she studied, died in Bulandshahr in a road accident, which her family alleged happened because two motorcycle-borne men were following her two-wheeler and harassing her, officials said Tuesday. The daughter of a tea shop owner, Sudiksha Bhati died Monday morning near Aurangabad when she was riding pillion on a motorcycle with her younger brother, a minor, they said. The two were en route to their maternal uncle's home in Bulandshahr's Khanpur area from their house at Deri Scanar village in Gautam Buddh Nagar's Dadri tehsil, the officials said.

The eldest among six siblings, Bhati had an enviable academic record. "She got admitted in



our school in 2011 in Class 6. In 2018, she scored 98 per cent marks in class 12 examination and topped the district," said Bishwajit Banerjee, the principal of Sikandrabad Vidyagyan School, Bulandshahr. She then went on to win a Rs 3.8-crore scholarship from Babson College, Massachusetts (US), and was pursuing a graduation course in entrepreneurship, he said. Her family members said she had come to India due to the coronavirus pandemic and was scheduled to go back to the US on August 20. They also alleged that while going to her maternal uncle Monday, she was being harassed by the two unidentified persons during the ride which led to the accident, prompting Bulandshahr district administration to order a probe.

Sakshi Maharaj gets death threat from Pak number

UNNAO: BJP MP Sakshi Maharaj has given a written complaint to the police claiming that he has received calls from a Pakistani number threatening to kill him in a bomb blast.

In the complaint to inspector in-charge of Sadar Kotwali, Dinesh Chandra Mishra, the MP from Unnao said that he got two phone calls from some terrorist organisation of Pakistan threatening to blow him up along with his residence.

According to the letter, the caller claimed that Kashmir would soon become a part of Pakistan and he also used foul language for the Ram Temple groundbreaking ceremony at Ayodhya.

The caller said that he and his mujahideens were keeping an eye on him round the clock, the MP said in the letter, adding that he also advised Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat and Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath.

DGCA to audit airports that witness heavy rains

The DGCA has barred the operation of wide-body aircraft at Kozhikode airport this monsoon "out of abundant caution", a senior official said, adding that the aviation regulator will conduct a special audit of airports that receive heavy rains.

The decision was taken four days after a narrow-body B737 aircraft of Air India Express with 190 people on board overshot the runway and crashed at the Kozhikode airport amid downpour.

Asked about the duration of the ban, the DGCA official said, "No date has been fixed. We will wait for the monsoon to get over."

Wide-body aircraft like B747 and A350 have a bigger fuel tank and can therefore travel longer distances, as against narrow-body

aircraft like B737 and A320. A wide-body aircraft also needs a longer runway length to take off or land. The table top runway 10 of the Kozhikode airport is approximately 2,700 metres long. Wide-body aircraft operations were permitted at this airport since 2019.

The senior official of the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) said, "The special audit will be done at airports like Mumbai and Chennai that are affected by heavy rains annually." The Airports Authority of India (AAI) manages more than 100 airports in the country, including the one in Kozhikode. However, major airports like Delhi, Mumbai, Bengaluru and Hyderabad are managed by private companies.

Air India Express to get \$50 mn insurance claim



CHENNAI: The Air India Express plane that crashed at Kozhikode airport on Friday evening was owned by the airline and was not a leased one, said an airline official.

Out of its total fleet of 25 Boeing 737-800 NG aircraft (16 post crash) and the balance eight were taken on lease.

A senior insurance industry official told IANS that the entire claim amount will be paid to the airline if it is an owned aircraft.

If there is any loan taken on the plane then the financier will also have a financial interest in the crashed craft.

All the owned aircraft of Air India Express underwent refurbishment of the cabin involving a change of seats, carpets and curtains.

Fire at A'bad Covid hospital: Case against administrator

AHMEDABAD: Days after eight coronavirus patients died in a fire at a private hospital here, the police has registered a case of alleged negligence against its main administrator, an official said.

The First Information Report (FIR) states that hospital had no fire alarm system, no fire audit had been done, and the staff had no training in fire-fighting.

The fire broke out at the ICU ward of Shrey Hospital in the wee hours of August 6. On Monday, an FIR under IPC section 304 (A) (causing death by negligent or rash act) was registered against the hospital's main administrator Bharat Mahant (57).

He has not been arrested yet, said Assistant Commissioner of Police L B Zala. Shrey Hospital was one of the 60 odd private hospitals authorised by the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation to treat coronavirus patients.

As per the FIR, the fire started in the fourth-floor ICU ward around 3 am due to a short circuit. While some of the patients died due to burn injuries, others died due to suffocation, it said.

There had been no fire safety audit of the hospital prior to the incident which amounted to "grave negligence" on the accused's part, the FIR said.

India's single-day Covid count more than US, Brazil in past 7 days: WHO data



For the past seven days, India's single-day count of Covid-19 cases has been more than that of the US and Brazil, the two worst-hit nations in terms of infections, according to an analysis of WHO data.

India, the third worst-hit nation in terms of infections, has also accounted for over 23 per cent of the cases and more than 15 per cent of the deaths reported worldwide between August 4-10, the data shows. India recorded 4,11,379 Covid-19 cases and 6,251 deaths due to the disease in a span of seven days till August 10, while the US which is at the number one spot in terms of both cases and deaths, registered 3,69,575 infections and 7,232 deaths during the same period. Brazil reported 3,04,535 cases and 6,914 fatalities during this period. Recording over 60,000 cases daily for four days on the trot, the single day rise in infections dipped to over 52,000, taking India's Covid-19 tally to 22.68 lakh on Tuesday, according to the Union health ministry data updated at 8 am.

Gajadhar Sonar, a resident of Belgarh village of Koderma left home 20 years ago after a quarrel with his wife and was living in Jharia Liloripathra of Dhanbad district on an assumed name, Satyanarayan. However, with the spread of Covid-19, when Gajadhar Sonar had a cold and fever, his neighbours enquired about his family members. The neighbours suspected him to be

Covid-19 positive. When Gajadhar did not reveal details about his family members, his neighbours informed the police.

During interrogation by the police, Gajadhar gave out the details and Dhanbad police contacted their Koderma counterparts after which Gajadhar's wife Aneeta Devi and son Chandrashekhar Kumar reached Dhanbad district on Monday. The couple finally met after 20 years and Gajadhar's wife took him back to his home in Koderma.

New Zealand is no more coronavirus-free

WELLINGTON: New Zealand Prime Minister Jacinda Ardern on Tuesday said authorities have found four cases of the coronavirus in one Auckland household from an unknown source, the first reported cases of local transmission in the country in 102 days.

Ardern said Auckland, the nation's largest city, will be moved to Alert Level 3 from midday Wednesday through midnight Friday, meaning that people will be asked to stay at home, while bars and many other businesses will be closed.

THOUSANDS IN HK BUY 'APPLE DAILY' TO SUPPORT PRESS FREEDOM

Long queues of people bought up copies of the Apple Daily paper at Hong Kong newsstands on Tuesday to support a free press in the semi-autonomous Chinese territory.

The public support came one day after police arrested the publisher of the pro-democracy paper and raided its premises in the most significant enforcement yet of Hong Kong's new national security law.

At least 200 police descended on the headquarters of Next Digital, which publishes the Apple Daily, and carted away boxes of what they said was evidence a few hours later.

In a display of solidarity for Jimmy Lai, people in the city rushed to buy Tuesday's Apple Daily, with the newspaper saying it had upped its print run to 550,000 from its normal circulation of 70,000

Earlier, owner Jimmy Lai, his two sons and others from the company were detained under the national security law. An aide to Lai said they were suspected of collusion with a foreign power, which the law criminalizes. Police did not release details.

In a display of solidarity for Lai, people in the city rushed to buy Tuesday's Apple Daily, with the newspaper

saying it had upped its print run to 550,000 from its normal circulation of 70,000.

One restaurant owner bought 50 copies at a news stand in the commercial district of Mong Kok and said he planned to give them away for free.

"Since the government doesn't allow Apple Daily to survive, then we as

Hong Kongers have to save it ourselves," the man, who gave his surname as Ng, told AFP, as dozens of people lined up around the city from the early hours.

"The government is suppressing freedom of the press," said Michael Hung, who bought two copies for 10 Hong Kong dollars (\$1.25) apiece.

The newsstand operator said he had sold 200 of his allotment of about 300 papers by late morning. On at typical day, he sells about 100 copies.

The arrests, along with that of democracy activist Agnes Chow on Monday night, have stoked fears that authorities are using the new law to suppress dissent and free speech.

Royal secrets are out

Prince Harry's 'thrown under the bus' feeling

Britain's Prince Harry felt he was "thrown under the bus" to protect the royal family ahead of his exit as frontline royalty with wife Meghan Markle, claims a new unofficial biography of the couple released here on Tuesday.

'Finding Freedom: Harry and Meghan and the Making of a Modern Royal Family' by royal reporters Omid Scobie and Carolyn Durand comes packed with a series of revelations based on interviews with around 100 people, including friends and aides, who are said to be close to Harry and Meghan - the Duke and Duchess of Sussex.

The couple themselves had earlier issued a state-

ment to clarify that they were not interviewed for the book and had no involvement.

The book claims Prince Harry was upset by the very public aspect of a falling out with his older brother Prince William, after he asked him not to rush things with Meghan - who was his girlfriend at the time.

"Harry was upset that it was playing out so publicly and that so much of the information being reported was wrong," the authors quote a source as saying.

"There had been moments where he felt people working with his brother had put things out there to make William look good, even if it meant throwing Harry under the

bus. It was a confusing time, and his head was all over the place - he didn't know who or what to believe, and he and William weren't talking enough either, which made everything a lot worse," the book claims.

Some of the other subjects covered in the book focus on Harry's "complicated" relationship with his father, Prince Charles, and his concern for the heir to the British throne when he tested positive for coronavirus earlier this year.

The book also details aspects of actress-turned-royal Meghan Markle's training in everything from curtsying to surviving kidnapping attempts to prepare her for life in the royal family.

SECRET SERVICE WHISKS OFF PREZ TRUMP AFTER SHOOTING NEAR WH

US President Donald Trump was abruptly escorted by a US Secret Service agent out of a live press briefing on coronavirus as a precautionary measure, after a shooting incident outside the White House.

"White House seems to be very well under control. I would like to thank the Secret Service for doing their - always quick and very effective work but there was an actual shooting and somebody has been taken to the hospital," Trump told reporters as he resumed the press briefing.

"I don't know the condition of the person. It seems that the person was shot by Secret Service. So we will see



what happens," Trump said.

The incident happened soon after Trump started speaking inside the James Brady press briefing room of the White House.

As he was making his

opening statement and talking about NASDAQ and economy, a top secret service agent reached out to him and requested him to leave the

briefing room. The secret service was seen saying something into his ears, after which the President, calm and composed, walked out of the briefing room.

Trump later told the reporters that he was taken to the Oval Office.

"The investigation into a USSS officer involved shooting is ongoing. A male subject and a USSS officer were both transported to a local hospital. At no time during this incident was the White House complex breached or were any protectees in danger," the Secret Service said in another tweet.

Trump praised Secret Service for their professionalism. Responding to a question, Trump said that he was not rattled.

Belarus oppn leader flees the country

The top opposition candidate in Belarus' presidential vote who refused to concede her defeat has fled the country amid a massive police crackdown on protests, Lithuania's foreign minister said Tuesday.

Linas Linkevicius' said on Twitter that Sviatlana Tsikhanouskaya is now "safe" in Lithuania.

Tsikhanouskaya previously dismissed the official results of Sunday's election showing authoritarian President Alexander Lukashenko winning a sixth term by a land-

slide.

On Monday, a protester died amid the clashes in Minsk and scores were injured as police used tear gas, flash-bang grenades and rubber bullets to disperse the demonstrators.

Interior Ministry spokesman Alexander Lastovsky said the victim intend-

ed to throw an explosive device, but it blew up in his hand and killed him.

Lukashenko, who has led the ex-Soviet nation of 9.5 million with an iron fist since 1994, derided the opposition as "sheep" manipulated by foreign masters and vowed to continue the tough crackdown on protests
