Tribal daughter is...

There is no party whip or penalty for cross-voting. Of course, there was a contest, but Sinha, a BJP rebel-turned-detractor of PM Modi, was hardly in a position to pose a serious challenge. Conceding defeat, Sinha congratulated Murmu and said that every Indian hopes that she functions as the "custodian of the Constitution" without fear or favour. PM Modi and BJP president J P Nadda visited Murmu's residence to congratulate her. After graduating at a time when Adivasi women hardly went to college, Murmu started life as a government clerk before resigning to become a school teacher. A few years later, she joined active politics and was twice elected to the State Assembly, serving as a minister in the BJD-BJP government under Navin Patnaik. Between 2015 and 2021, she was the Governor of Jharkhand. According to our correspondent in Ahmedabad, two tribal MLAs of the Bharatiya Tribal Party, currently in a pre-poll alliance with the Aam Aadmi Party, one NCP legislator Kandhal Jadeja and one Congress MLA cast their vote for the NDA nominee. Rairangpur, Murmu's hometown in Odisha, erupted in celebrations as the trend became clear. The naming of a tribal nominee was a political masterstroke: it caught the opposition off guard and brought on board non-aligned parties, such as Patnaik's Biju Janata Dal and Jagannohan Reddy's YSR Congress. Apart from the optics, the symbolism and the political message to the tribal community in Gujarat and elsewhere – which will Assembly elections in due course – go far beyond the presidential vote count.

Sonia Gandhi to...

He condemned ED for lying that her interrogation was stopped on her request. The ED excused her on Friday since its officials are busy in some court cases. Youth Congress workers took to the streets, set a vehicle in Bengaluru on fire and stopped trains in protest against the ED action. In reply to a question, Jairam said the protests will continue on Friday at all district headquarters in the country. Senior party leaders, including Rajasthan CM Ashok Gehlot, Shashi Tharoor, Sachin Pilot and Pawan Khera, were detained for protesting in the national capital.

MEA: Keeping watch...

China has been ramping up border infrastructure in several sensitive locations including along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in eastern Ladakh where the Chinese PLA has been locked in an over two-year standoff with the Indian Army. In October last year, Bhutan and China signed an agreement on a "three-step roadmap" to expedite negotiations to resolve their festering boundary dispute. Bhutan shares an over 400-km-long border with China and the two countries have held over 24 rounds of boundary talks in a bid to resolve the dispute. The two countries also held 10 rounds of negotiations at the 'Expert Group' level. The Doklam tri-junction is considered important from the point of view of India's security interests. The India-China standoff in the Doklam plateau in 2017 even triggered fears of a war between the two nuclear-armed neighbours. Bhutan said the area belonged to it and India supported the Bhutanese claim. India had strongly opposed the construction of the road at the Doklam tri-junction as it would have impacted its overall security interests. The India-China face-off was resolved following several rounds of talks

Only colourful sanitisers...

In the district, the Excise and Food and Drugs teams checked medical shop and took preventive action on its sale. The teams remained active till late night on Wednesday. Assistant Commissioner Excise Kurmi said that under the direction of Collector Bhopal, the action against sanitizers would continue continuously.

Abortion can't be...

Noting that after the 2021 amendment, the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act uses the word "partner" instead of "husband" in the explanation to Section 3, the court said that this shows the legislative intent to cover "unmarried woman" under the Act. It said allowing the petitioner to suffer an unwanted pregnancy will be contrary to the object and spirit of the legislation and going against the Parliamentary intent. It held that the distinction between a married and an unmarried woman has no nexus to the object sought to be achieved by arliament. The bench observed that the Parliamentary intent is not to confine the benefits to situations arising out of matrimonial relationships. It noted that a widow or a divorcee woman is allowed to terminate pregnancy in the 20-24 weeks term. The High Court had refused termination of the pregnancy since it would amount to virtual killing of the fetus and the abortion law does not permit it after 20 weeks of a pregnancy arising out of a consensual relationship. It suggested that the woman can give away the child in adoption. It also held that the pregnancy arising out of a consensual relationship is clearly not covered under the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Rules, 2003. The woman had sought termination of pregnancy arising out of a consensual relationship since the man refused to marry and she was not in a position to raise the child.

College students hold...

One of the boys is heard calling up the next couple for kissing. Sources say that students belonged to a reputed college and the video had shocked the traditional coastal district and it has also raised concern across the state worrying parents. The police are also verifying whether the students had consumed drugs while holding the lip-lock competition.

Kerala engineering students...

"One can only sympathise with those who do not understand that times have changed," she added. She also told media present there that residents of the area have a different way of thinking as many of them are old timers. Engineering students from CET, who were present when the mayor visited, told scribes that this was not the first time they were faced with such a situation. They face moral policing on a regular basis whenever they are walking around in that area with a friend of the opposite sex. "We have been suffering this for a long time and therefore, we decided it was about time we reacted to it. We, of course, never expected the photographs to go viral. We were just attempting to ensure that such moral policing does not occur in future. "They should understand there is nothing wrong with a boy and girl sitting together," the students said. The residents of the area, on the other hand, said that none of them approve of the girls and boys sitting together at the bus stand starting from early morning hours to even late at night. "This is a bus shelter we built for people to wait for the bus. If they want to sit together, let them do so inside the college campus. We do not approve of their behaviour," some of the local residents told reporters. They also said that the bus shelter was built by them years ago and was in a bad state, so they decided to renovate it and as part of the renovation process, the seating arrangement was converted to three separate ones with a gap in between in view of the COVID-19 guidelines on social distancing.

Gyanvapi case: SC to wait for Varanasi judge's order

OUR BUREAU / New Delhi

The Supreme Court on Thursday put off to October first week the hearing on an appeal by Gyanvapi Mosque Committee against the Allahabad High Court order upholding the appointment of a court commissioner to survey the site.

A Bench of Justices D Y Chandrachud, Surya Kant and P S Narasimha said it would await the Varanasi district judge's decision on

the committee's objections to the maintainability of the civil suit filed by the Hindu devotees.

The bench said that it has been apprised of the fact that proceedings before the District Judge are still underway and it would be appropriate if the appeal of the mosque committee is kept pending till the outcome of the application filed under Order 7 Rule 11 questioning the maintainability of the suit.

On May 20, the top court

transferred the civil suit filed by Hindu devotees on Gyanvapi mosque from civil judge (senior division) to district judge, Varanasi saying looking at the "complexities" and "sensitivity" of the issue, it is better if a senior judicial officer having an experience of over 25-30 years handles this case.

The mosque is in the news since after discovery of a Shivalinga there and the Hindus pressing for offering prayers to the Shivalinga.

Girl arrested for writing 'anti-national' poem gets bail

GUWAHATI: A college student in Assam, Barshashree Buragohain, who was arrested and jailed for writing a poem allegedly in support of the banned outfit United Liberation Front of Asom-Independent (ULFA-I), was granted bail on Thursday by the Gauhati high court.

She was arrested on May 18, and later sent to judicial custody. The 19-year-old was booked under the stringent Unlawful Activities (Preventions) Act. The poem written by Barshashree had no direct reference to the terror outfit, however, the FIR against her mentioned that the poem was an implicit endorsement of the ULFA-I, a banned military organisation, and pointed towards a larger "criminal conspiracy" and "intent to wage war against the Indian government".

Gold smuggling case: ED moves SC seeking transfer of trial

AGENCIES New Delhi

The Enforcement Directorate has approached the Supreme Court seeking transfer of the trial in the gold smuggling case from Kerala to Karnataka saying that a "free and fair trial" of the case is not possible in the state.

ED alleged in its plea that there is a close nexus between the accused and top officials and functionaries of the Kerala government.

Recently, the key accused in the case, Swapna Suresh, appeared before the Kochi unit of the Enforcement Directorate after being summoned by the probe agency in view of her recent statement before a magistrate court here under section 164 of the CrPC.

PLEAS ON HATE SPEECH SC asks home secy to collate info from states and UTs

NEW DELHI

The Supreme Court Thursday asked the Secretary of the Union Home Ministry to collate information from states and Union Territories (UTs) regarding the compliance of directions given earlier by the apex court regarding preventive, corrective, and remedial measures to curb untoward situations, like mob violence and hate speech.

The top court, which was hearing a batch of petitions concerning hate speech and rumour-mongering, said the secretary may collate necessary information by corresponding directly with the secretary of the home department of respective states and UTs within three weeks and compile it state-wise. A bench headed by Justice A M Khanwilkar referred to some previous judgments delivered by the apex court in 2018 and said they specifically provide for a structure and the follow-up action to be taken and the collation of information would reflect how the states and UTs have complied with these directions. "It is not adversarial," the

bench, also comprising Justices A S Oka and J B Pardiwala, orally said.

"The Secretary, Home Department, may collate necessary information by corresponding directly with the Secretary, Home Department, of the respective states/UTs within three weeks and compile the information..." the bench said, adding the state-wise information be placed before it within six weeks.

It observed that the information essentially would be in respect of the status of compliances by the respective states and UTs regarding the directions or observations in these earlier decisions of the apex court to provide for preventive, corrective, and remedial measures for "arresting the untoward situations" which occur and are referred to in the petitions before it.

"Considering the nature of the issue involved and in the backdrop of the general directions issued by this court...we request the Secretary, Home Department, Government of India, to collate necessary information from the respective states/UTs," the top court said.

Flood situation deteriorates in Assam

GUWAHATI: The flood situation in Assam marginally deteriorated on Thursday with over 17,200 people reeling under the deluge across four districts, an official bulletin said. Cachar is the worst hit district with over 12,600 people suffering, followed by Morigaon where more than 3,500 persons are affected and Tamulpur with nearly 900 people still under waters, according to the daily flood report of the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA). Till Wednesday, over 16,400 people were affected in the deluge across four districts.

Kiren Rijiju: No need to amend anti-defection law as of now

AGENCIES New Delhi

The provisions of the anti-defection law have stood the test of time and several judicial scrutinies and thus there is no need to amend it as of now, Law Minister Kiren Rijiju informed Rajya Sabha on Thursday.

Responding to a question on whether the anti-defection law in its present form is adequate to stop induced defections, the minister in a written reply said, "Since, the provisions of the Tenth Schedule (popularly called the anti-defection law) have stood the test of time and several judicial scrutinies, there does not appear to be any need for carrying out any amendments as of now." In response to another query on whether there have been different interpretations of the anti-defection law by the courts, Rijiju said a seven-member constitutional bench of the Supreme Court, in the Ki-



hoto Hollohon Vs Zachilhu case had upheld the entire provisions of the Tenth Schedule of the Constitution, except paragraph seven relating to the judiciary of the decisions of Speaker or chairpersons of the legislatures.

"Although, some courts have examined the provisions in the past, no specific directions have been given for amendments," he said.

The Tenth Schedule of the Constitution provides for the prevention of defection of the elected and nominated members from their political party and contains stringent provisions for curbing the men-

ace of switching over of legislators.

The recent political developments in Maharashtra and Goa have brought the focus back on the law. The Uddhav Thackeray-led MVA government in Maharashtra collapsed on June 29 following a rebellion by Shiv Sena's Eknath Shinde and most of the party MLAs.

No consensus on amending the anti-defection law was reached at a meeting of presiding officers here last week chaired by Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla, who said constitution experts, legal scholars and other stakeholders will be consulted on the matter.

There were two divergent views among the members of a committee constituted to examine the law, with the majority in favour of giving more power to the Chair, while the minority view was the power should be with the president of the political party.

African swine fever case detected in Bareilly

BAREILLY: An African swine fever case was reported here, after which a premiere livestock research institute in the region urged the authorities to issue an alert.

Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI) Joint Director Dr P Singh on Thursday said after Mizoram, Tripura and Assam, a case of African swine flu has now been reported in Bareilly.

Singh said a pig of Anil Kumar, a resident of Bhadsar Dandiya village in Nawabganj tehsil here, died from the disease.

A few days ago, Kumar's pig had high fever and stopped eating and drinking, said Singh. Kumar later sent a sample of the dead pig for testing, which confirmed the disease, Singh added.

Will go ahead with Singapore visit, says Kejriwal

NEW DELHI

After Delhi Lieutenant Governor VK Saxena denied permission for Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal's Singapore visit to attend the World Cities Summit, the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) convener said he differs with the former's advice and would go ahead with the visit.

In his letter to the LG, Kejriwal said the World Cities Summit is not just a mayor's conference. It is a conference of mayors, city leaders, knowledge experts etc. and the Singapore government has chosen to invite the Chief Minister of Delhi.

He said it is a matter of great pride that the Delhi model of governance especially the work done in education, health and power

sector is being discussed and recognised the world over.

"Singapore government has invited me to present the Delhi model before the city leaders from the whole world. It is a matter of great pride for every patriotic Indian. All of us should celebrate it and do our best to facilitate this visit," said the Chief Minister.

Kejriwal said human life is not compartmentalised into the subjects mentioned in the three Lists of the Constitution. If the visit of each Constitutional authority in our country were to be decided on the basis of what subjects fall within the jurisdiction of that authority, it would create a funny situation and a practical logjam, noted the Delhi Chief Minister.

60 pilots, 150 cabin crew failed breath analyzer test

NEW DELHI: A total of 60 pilots and 150 cabin crew members tested positive following the breath analyzer (BA) test in the last two and a half years. Breath Analyzer tests are conducted to ensure aviation safety is not compromised due to the consumption of alcohol by pilots and cabin crews.

During the period from January 1, 2020 to June 30, 2022, as per the provision of Civil Aviation Require-

ments (CAR) Section-5, Series-F, Part-III, no license has been cancelled. However, a total of 210 pilots and crew members have been suspended.

According to a Parliamentary reply on Thursday, there is a systematic safety oversight process in place

for monitoring the compliance of Rules and Civil Aviation Requirements by the airlines. "This is a continuing process and includes surveillance, spot checks and regulatory audits embodied in Annual Surveillance Plan (ASP) of DGCA.
