No. 28/11-12, Shivaji Niketan, CTS No. 458A, Tejas Housing Society, Near Mantri Park, Behind Dhondiba Sutar Bus Stand, Kothrud, Pune 411038, which was commenced at 4.00 p.m. and concluded at 5.35 p.m., have;

1. Considered, approved and taken on record the Audited Standalone and Consolidated Financial Results of the Company for the half year and year ended on March 31, 2026, along with the Audit Report (Unmodified Opinion) and declaration by the Company for the Audit Report with Unmodified Opinion.
2. Considered, approved and taken on record the Audited Standalone and Consolidated Financial Statements of the Company for the Financial Year ended on March 31, 2026, in accordance with the Companies Act, 2013.
3. The completion of the transaction is subject to satisfaction of certain conditions precedent in accordance with the Transaction Documents. Consequently, upon the completion of the acquisition of 7200 equity shares, Omnibridge will become a subsidiary of the Company. Upon completion of the said acquisition, the Company will provide further intimation in this regard.
