SUB: Intimation under Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015

Dear Sir/ Madam,

Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Para A (sub-para 20) of Part A of Schedule III of the SEBI Listing Regulations and in continuation to our earlier intimation given vide letter no. VTL:SCY:SEPT:2024-25 dated 26-Sept., 2024, this is to inform you that the Punjab Pollution Control Board (PPCB) vide its letter no. PPCB/SEE/ZO-2/LDH/2024/50 dated 3rd January, 2025 (received on 9th January, 2025) has imposed an Environment Compensation of Rs. 13,20,000/-, for the period 01.07.2024 to 13.08.2024, on 'Vardhman Spg. & Gen. Mills' (one of the manufacturing units of the Company at Ludhiana) based on the 'Polluter Pays' Principle without any specific statute. This is to bring to your notice that the abovesaid compensation has been imposed in respect of dyeing operations at the said Unit in the matter inter alia relating to non-submission of PERT Chart for installation and commissioning of ZLD in compliance with the provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974.

This is to clarify that the Company had applied for renewal of 'Consent to Operate' with PPCB on 30th June, 2024 but the same was arbitrarily returned back without affording an Opportunity for Hearing to the Company. Subsequently, the Company had re-submitted its Application for 'Consent to Operate' twice after taking required steps but the same was again returned back to the Company. Against this action of PPCB, the Company has filed an appeal before the Appropriate Authority which is pending adjudication. In the meantime, the Company has again submitted its Application for 'Consent to Operate' alongwith PERT Chart outlining the timelines for installation of ZLD on 25th Dec., 2024 and the same is still pending with PPCB. This is further to inform that the Effluent Treatment Plant (ETP) of the Company operates consistently within the parameters prescribed by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MOEF&CC) and PPCB.

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We would further like to inform you that the Company has already initiated steps to take appropriate action with respect to the abovesaid letter of the PPCB. As such, we do not apprehend any material impact on financial, operation or other activities of the Company.

Kindly take the same on record.
