Veranda's Commerce Vertical Produces 190 All-India Rankers in CA January 2026 Exams

BB Virtuals Students Sweep Top-3 in CA Final for Fourth Consecutive Time

The Commerce Vertical of Veranda Learning Solutions (BSE: 543514, NSE: VERANDA), a listed enterprise providing end-to-end education solutions, has delivered yet another outstanding performance in the Chartered Accountancy January 2026 examinations, producing 190* All-India Rank holders across CA Final, CA Intermediate, and CA Foundation.

In the results announced earlier this month by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI), students from BB Virtuals, part of Veranda's Commerce Vertical, achieved a remarkable milestone by securing three of the top ranks in the CA Final examination for the fourth successive time.
