ANGRY TRIBALS IN VIJAYPUR GHERAO POLICE STATION, POLLING RESUMES AFTER HALT

Voting for bypolls in Madhya Pradesh's Bhopal and Vijaypur was underway under heavy security by police personnel and allegations of booth capturing at several places. Around 500 villagers from the tribal community in Vijaypur block in Vijaypur surrounded the local police station and staged a protest, alleging that they were prohibited from exercising their right to vote.



73.82 percent voting till 5 pm

Bhopal: Peaceful voting is going on at all the polling stations of Assembly Constituency No. 02-Vijaypur of Sheopur district and Assembly Constituency No. 156-Budhni of Sehore district. From 7 am to 5 pm, 75.27 percent voting has taken place in No. 02-Vijaypur and 72.37 percent in No. 156-Budhni. The average voting percentage in both the assembly constituencies from 7 am to 5 pm is 73.82.

Tribals alleged that BJP candidate Ramnivas Rawat's supporters forced them to return home without casting their votes. Polling was disrupted for half-an-hour at Kheda polling booth. Sheopur District Collector Kishor Kumar Karyal said voting at the Kheda polling booth resumed after a brief halt and the situation was under control. He said the poll was disrupted due to a conflict between two groups at the polling premises. People from two groups created a ruckus at a polling booth, following which a large number of villagers surrounded the local police station. However, the situation was brought under control and polling resumed after a brief halt, Karyal said. In another instance, villagers staged a protest on Sheopur-Morwa highway, alleging that they were not allowed to enter a polling station. MP Congress chief Bin Patwari accused the district administration and police of favouring the BJP in the bypolls and said that they have decided to lodge a complaint with the Election Commission. "People are being barred from exercising their right to vote and booths are being captured at several places in Vijaypur. Vijaypur bye-election has become an election that has

shredded the decorum of democracy. Now there is absolutely no fairness left in this election," Bin Patwari alleged. The contest in Vijaypur is between BJP's Ramnivas Rawat and Congress nominee Mukesh Malhotra. Bypolls were necessitated after Rawat, who was elected MLA from Vijaypur in November last year on the Congress symbol, resigned from the party and state Assembly. Six-time former MLA, Rawat later joined the BJP and at present, he is state forest minister in Chief Minister Mohan Yadav's Cabinet.

Madhya Pradesh Leads the Nation in Ayushman Card Creation for Senior Citizens

Deputy Chief Minister Rajendra Shukla praised the remarkable progress made in Ayushman card creation for senior citizens across Madhya Pradesh, commencing all involved officials, ASHA workers, ANMs, and community health officials. He stated that the state government is committed to reaching all eligible senior citizens with health security under this ambitious scheme. Madhya Pradesh currently leads the country in issuing Ayushman cards for senior citizens. Dr. Vignesh Bhargava, CEO of the Ayushman Bharat scheme, shared that over 2,00,000 Ayushman cards have been created for senior citizens aged 70 and above in Madhya Pradesh, compared to 1,70,167 cards in Kerala.

Dr. Bhargava added that approximately 30,000 to 35,000 Ayushman cards are being generated daily for senior citizens in Madhya Pradesh. He mentioned that the target of 34,73,325 Ayushman cards is expected to be met by January 15. An action plan has been formulated, with ASHA workers, ANMs, and CHOs con-

ducting door-to-door outreach and organizing special camps. Dr. Bhargava explained that under the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY), a new initiative has been introduced to provide accessible and high-quality healthcare services to senior citizens aged 70 and above. Launched on October 25, 2024, this scheme allows eligible senior citizens to register themselves on the National Health Authority's portal (<http://nha.gov.in/beneficiary-obs-govt>) or the Ayushman app (<http://nha.gov.in/aysm/app/details/td-com/beneficiaryapp>), enabling them to create their card from home by choosing the self-registration option.

CM Mohan Yadav gives financial aid of Rs 1 lakh to Bhujlo Bai who fought with a wolf in Chhindwara

Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav spoke to Bhujlo Bai over the phone who was injured while fighting with an attacking wolf in Chhindwara district of Madhya Pradesh and praised her courage after inquiring about her well-being. Along with this, he also announced financial aid of Rs 1 lakh along with proper medical arrangements. Recently, while grazing the crop, two women Bhujlo Bai (85) and Durgabai (55) were sleeping in a field near Khakharwara village under Amarwara range of Chhindwara. Then the wolf attacked

Bhujlo and chewed off the thumb of one of her hands. It is said that when Durga Bai heard Bhujlo Bai's screams, she rushed to rescue her. Then the wolf attacked her, causing injuries to her hand and head. The struggle between the woman and the wolf continued for half an hour. After this, Bhujlo attacked with a shovel kept nearby, this attack was so fatal that the wolf died. Both the women injured in the wolf attack have been admitted to the district hospital Chhindwara. On receiving information about this struggle, the wife of the victim, Chief Minister Dr. Mohan Yadav talked to Bhujlo Bai on the phone who

heavily faced the wolf. The Chief Minister appreciated Bhujlo Bai's courage and sanctioned one lakh rupees as an incentive. Chief Minister Yadav talked to Bhujlo Bai on the phone and asked about her well-being and took information about the treatment. Dr. Yadav directed the Collector Chhindwara for proper treatment. If required, she will be airlifted to Bhopal for treatment. The Chief Minister appreciated Bhujlo Bai's courage and sanctioned an amount of one lakh rupees as an incentive. Accused Pujari Singh Bawaria has been sent to Tamil Nadu by the Nilgiri Forest Division Tamil Nadu teams from Central Jail Narmadapuram in a case registered in Nilgiri Forest Division in connection with illegal trade of tiger hunting and its parts on 11 November, 2024 after permission of the Court of Narmadapuram with the help of STSF. The accused was being searched by the forest departments and other law enforcement agencies of other states for the last several years. Investigation is going on in the case.
