Haryana polls 'stolen', EC colluded with BJP: Rahul

● Congress leader claims 25lakh fake entries in state poll list

New Delhi, November 5

CONGRESS LEADER RAHUL Gandhi on Wednesday cited electoral list data from Haryana to claim that 25 lakh entries were "fake" and the assembly polls last year were "stolen", as he accused the Election Commission of colluding with the BJP to make them win.

The Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha said he is questioning the Election Commission and the democratic process in the country and therefore, is doing so with 100 per cent proof.

Gandhi alleged that the Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) and the two election commissioners colluded with the BJP to ensure its victory in Haryana and claimed that "they are in partnership" with Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

'Operation Sarkar Chori' was launched to convert the landslide Congress victory into loss in Haryana, the former party president alleged.

He also alleged that CEC Gyanesh Kumar is "lying" to the people of India when he stated that house number zero is given to homeless people and

that is the reality of zero number houses.

Addressing a press conference at the Indira Bhawan here, Gandhi cited the electoral list of Haryana to claim that 25,41,144 were fake voters with multiple examples of duplicate voters, invalid addresses and bulk voters.

"Why is the Election Commission not removing duplicates? It is because if it does so, it would result in fair elections and it doesn't want fair elections," Gandhi said.

"All polls pointed to a Congress victory in Haryana. The five top exit polls said Congress is sweeping. The other thing that was surprising was that for the first time in Haryana, the postal votes were different from the result. In postal bal-

lots, Congress got 73 seats while the BJP got 17 seats," he said. Gandhi claimed that thousands of people associated with the BJP voted both in UP and Haryana both.

During the presser, Gandhi showed a picture of a woman who appears on the voter list 22 times in 10 booths in the Rai assembly constituency, and said this shows that this was a 'centralised operation'.

He claimed that the picture of the woman used for multiple entries is from Brazil.

She is one of 25 lakh such records in Haryana which is proof of a centralised operation, Gandhi said.

He alleged that there were 25,41,144 'vote chori' entries on the list which are fake in Haryana.

"One in 8 voters in Haryana are fake and despite that the Congress loses by 22,779 votes which was the difference in eight seats," Gandhi said.

"I was in shock, I simply could not believe what we found. I asked the team to cross check multiple times. I want young people, Gen Z to understand this clearly as your future is being stolen," Gandhi said.

He claimed that a plan was in motion to convert a landslide victory of the Congress into a loss in Haryana.

Gandhi also played out a video of now Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini, who two days before counting, stated that the BJP would win and "we have a system in place".

"We suspected, once we did Mahadevapura and Aland, that this is not happening in just one constituency but this is being done at the state and national level," Gandhi said. In September, Gandhi had accused CEC Kumar of protecting those who "destroyed democracy" and cited data from Karnataka Assembly constituency Aland to claim that votes of Congress supporters were being systematically deleted ahead of elections.

The Election Commission had, however, dubbed the charges as "incorrect and baseless" and asserted that no deletion of votes can happen without giving an opportunity of being heard to the affected person.

Bihar gears up for first phase of polls today

ALL ARRANGEMENTS ARE in place for the first phase of Bihar polls on Thursday in 121 constituencies with 37.5 million voters eligible to exercise their franchise across 45,341 polling stations. The first phase of poll will decide the electoral fate of 1,314 candidates.

The second phase of assembly polls will be held on November 11 and results will be announced on November 14.

The first phase of polls will decide electoral fate of several senior leaders including RJD's Tejashwi Prasad Yadav, BJP leaders Samrat Choudhary and Mangal Pandey and JD(U)'s Shrawan Kumar and Vijay Kumar Choudhary. Tej Pratap Yadav is also in the fray in the first phase. The 121 constituencies going to the polls in the first phase are spread across 18 districts. According to the Election

Commission, there are 10.72 lakh 'new electors' and 7.78 lakh voters are in the age group of 18-19 years.

Total population of these constituencies, as stated by the Election Commission, is 6.60 crore. Presiding officers have handed over Electronic Voting Machines (EVMs) to polling agents ahead of the polling day.

Central City Patna Superintendent of Police Diksha said all arrangements have been made for smooth and peaceful polling in the city.

Area domination will be done, and patrolling parties will conduct raids tonight. From morning, there will be checks at the zonal and super zonal levels. Quick Response Teams have been formed. Communication channels have been established. We expect voters to vote peacefully. Women-specific

and disability-friendly booths have been set up. CAPF and State Police have been deployed at polling stations. Boats have also been arranged for polling parties." Tejashwi Yadav, who is Mahagathbandhan's chief ministerial candidate, is in the fray from Raghapur.

He has held the seat since 2015 and faces a tough challenge from BJP's Satish Kumar Yadav, who lost in 2020 assembly elections.

Tejashwi Yadav's estranged brother, Tej Pratap Yadav, who floated a new party Janshakti Janta Dal after his exit from RJD, has fielded Prem Kumar from the seat. Jan Suraj Party, led by Prashant Kishor, has fielded Chanchal Singh and this could alter the dynamics in Raghapur. Tej Pratap Yadav is in the fray from Mahua constituency.

Bengal SIR: Over 8.4 mn forms distributed so far

AS PART OF the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls in West Bengal, more than 8.4 million enumeration forms were distributed across the state so far, an official said on Wednesday. The month-long exercise began on Tuesday and will continue till December 4.

"More than 8.4 million enumeration forms were distributed by booth-level officers (BLOs) till 4 pm on Wednesday," an official of the Election Commission said.

"Yesterday, there were no untoward incidents reported from anywhere in the state. If any resistance is reported against a BLO, we immediately instruct the district electoral officers (DEOs) to investigate," the official said.

As part of the process, 80,681 BLOs have been deployed across the 294 assembly constituencies.

Around 76.6 million enumeration forms have so far been prepared, and each voter will receive two copies, the EC official said.

According to the guidelines for the SIR process, BLO would countersign both forms. The officer would retain one filled-up form for the Election Commission and return the second with a stamped acknowledgment

ment, which may be required for future reference. The SIR is being conducted in West Bengal after a gap of 23 years.

The last such revision of voters' lists was held in the state in 2002.

Meanwhile, EC Principal Secretary SB Joshi, Deputy Secretary Abhinav Agarwal reached West Bengal as a part of their schedule to oversee the SIR rollout in Cooch Behar, Alipurduar, and Jalpaiguri districts, an official said.

"During the visit, they will evaluate the performance of BLOs and returning officers (ROs), and may interact with political leaders. Representatives from the office of the Chief

Electoral Officer (CEO) will also be present during the review process," the official told PTI.

Over 68K officers deployed in TN

AS MANY AS 68,467 booth level officers (BLOs) have been deployed for the SIR exercise in Tamil Nadu that commenced on November 4, authorities said. As part of the SIR of electoral rolls in the state, 68,467 BLOs and 7,234 BLO-supervisors have been actively deployed to facilitate the distribution and collection of enumeration forms from eligible citizens for inclusion in the draft electoral rolls.
