

Wonderla Kochi is all set to open its door exclusively for frontline workers during the Warrior's Week

A total of 10,000 COVID warriors will get free passes to the theme park

Kochi, 11th December 2020: Wonderla Holidays Ltd, India's leading amusement park, is set to open its doors to frontline workers.
