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Meta to face formal inquiry over child safety

National Commission for Protection of Child Rights summons India head after finding response 'inadequate'

The National Commission for Protection of Child Rights (NCPCR) has decided to institute a formal inquiry into alleged lapses in Meta India's policies on child safety and the platform's lack of action on child sexual abuse material (CSAM), according to sources.

The decision to institute a formal inquiry was taken after NCPCR found Meta's response on the issue inadequate. The company's India head, Arun Srinivas, has also been summoned by the child rights body on Thursday.

An email sent to Metaseekings response did not elicit a

response until the time of going to press.

In July this year, Meta's video-and-image-sharing platform Instagram came under the government's scrutiny after reports emerged that the platform was allowing advertise-

ments promoting CSAM.

Following the reports, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology summoned Meta India executives and sought their response on the issue.

In response, Metasaid it had

removed 160,000 accounts for hosting and sharing "suspicious off-platform links in coordination with other signals indicating child exploitation activity".

Overall, Meta, which has WhatsApp, Facebook, Insta-

gram, and Threads under its umbrella, said it had automatically removed more than 4 million suspicious accounts from Facebook and Instagram, in addition to 36 million pieces of content containing child exploitation.

Earlier this year, Instagram updated its policies around content shown to children and said all users below the age of 18 would be able to view only content similar to what they would likely see in an age-appropriate movie. All users under 18 will be placed in this category going forward, and they will not be able to change the settings without a parent's permission, Meta had said in a blog post announcing the changes.

"Just like you might see some suggestive content or hear some strong language in a movie rated for ages 13+, teens may occasionally see something like that on Instagram, but we're going to keep doing all we can to keep those instances as rare as possible. We recognise no system is perfect, and we're committed to improving over time," Meta had said.

Teenagers will not be able to follow accounts that regularly share content inappropriate for those under 18. Even if the name or bio of such accounts suggests that the content within them is inappropriate for teenagers, Meta will restrict children from viewing them, the platform had then said.

India's protein consumption set to treble by 2070: Report

Dairy-related consumption expected to raise emissions levels

India's average annual per capita protein consumption, of which dairy forms a significant part, is projected to more than triple from 9.5 kg in 2025 to 30 kg by 2070, pushing protein-related emissions to more than seven times the estimated climate-safe threshold, according to a report released on Tuesday by Asia Research and Engagement (ARE) in partnership with the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (Ficci).

The report indicates that the increase in protein consumption will be driven by population growth, rising incomes, urbanisation, public nutrition programmes and shifting dietary preferences.

However, despite rising pro-

tein consumption, India remains protein insecure and faces dietary inequality, the report added.

The report's business-as-usual (BAU) model projects that India's annual protein-related emissions could reach 1.92 gigatonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent (Gt CO₂e) by

2070, more than seven times the estimated climate-safe threshold of 0.25 Gt CO₂e.

"Largely, two things will need to happen. One is significant improvement on the production side, and the second is on the demand side," said Rituj Sahu, director of Protein Transition and Sustainable Food Systems (India) at ARE.

The report's combined approach, involving gains in production efficiency across dairy, poultry and seafood systems alongside diversification of the protein base, could reduce annual emissions to 0.30 Gt CO₂e by 2070. While still above the climate-safe threshold, this would represent a substantial reduction in the gap.

"We have this deep legacy of plant-based foods, especially legumes and pulses,"

Sahu said.

According to the report, traditional sources such as dairy and pulses are projected to remain the main sources of protein through 2070, while eggs, poultry and seafood are likely to grow from smaller bases. Red meat is expected to remain a relatively small component of the country's protein basket.

The country imports nearly 90 per cent of its processed plant-protein isolates, according to the report, highlighting both a supply-chain vulnerability and an opportunity to expand domestic processing and value addition.

Talking about the cost of the transition, Sahu said producers, retailers, consumers, governments and civil society organisations would have to share the costs.

Eiffel Tower shut for a day after strike over women staff during BAPS visit

The Eiffel Tower was closed for a day on Monday after its staff went on strike over female employees being "moved away" for a visit by a Hindu religious group, according to the iconic Paris monument's management and staff.

The incident that triggered the strike took place on Saturday during a visit by around 100 people associated with BAPS (Bochasanwasi Akshar Purushottam) Swaminarayan Sanstha, *Euronews* reported.

When asked about the controversy, External Affairs Ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said a media briefing in New Delhi: "We are aware of the opening of a temple by the BAPS Sanstha in the Paris area. As to the particular issue pertaining to the Tower, this is a matter purely between the entities concerned."

BAPS HINDU TEMPLE IN PARIS HAS ISSUED AN APOLOGY AND SAID IT UNDERSTOOD THE CONCERNS RAISED OVER THE INCIDENT

In a statement issued by the GGT trade union, the staff condemned "workplace instructions that led to female employees being sidelined, replaced and rendered invisible on the basis of their gender". The tower opened as usual on Tuesday, after the operating company, Societe d'Exploitation de la tour Eiffel, acknowledged that limited "interactions with women" had been requested by a BAPS delegation, and that the "conditions should not have been accepted". The BAPS Hindu temple in Paris has issued an apology and said it understood the concerns raised over the incident, adding that they took them "very seriously".

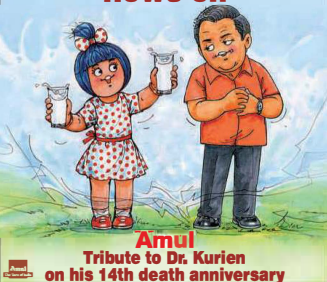

Delhi HC to hear ANI's appeal against ChatGPT on Sept 14

Asian News International (ANI) has approached the Delhi High Court against a single-judge decision that declined to grant it interim protection in its copyright infringement case against OpenAI, the firm behind ChatGPT.

The appeal came up before a division bench by Justice V Kamalwar Rao on Tuesday. However, the bench did not assemble. The matter will now be taken upon September 14. ANI had sued OpenAI alleging that its news reports and other original content were being used by the AI company for commercial purposes without permission.
