The Indian theme park market is projected to reach ₹1,865 crores in 2024. This growth is part of a broader trend in the amusement industry, which is expected to grow at a rate of 15%, potentially reaching ₹25,000 crores in the near future

- Influx of international brands: Global theme park chains are recognizing India's potential, bringing new attractions and boosting the industry's profile




Wastewater Management In India



- The India Water and Wastewater Treatment Technology Market size is estimated at INR 8,364 crore (USD 1.02 billion) in 2024 and is expected to reach ₹ 14,013 crore (USD 1.71 billion) by 2029, growing at a CAGR of 10.78% during the forecast period (2024-2029)
- India, along with China, Indonesia, Nigeria, and the United States, is expected to lead the world's urban population surge by 2050, increasing the need for municipal water treatment
- The Indian government aims to provide 100% of its population with safe and adequate drinking water within premises by 2024 or 2025, which will boost the demand for municipal water treatment plants
- By 2030, India's water demand is expected to exceed supply by two times, indicating severe
 water scarcity and increasing the need for water treatment systems. Major end-user
 industries for anaerobic biological treatment include municipal wastewater treatment, food
 and beverage manufacturing, chemical effluent, and agricultural waste
- The Council on Energy, Environment, and Water (CEEW), in association with the 2030 Water Resources Group, is working to improve wastewater management in India and increase private investments in wastewater treatment plants. The urban sewage capacity in India has grown significantly in recent years, driving the demand for innovative water treatment technologies








Consolidated Q2 FY25 Revenue Breakup




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
Segment-wise Revenue Break-up




Consolidated H1 FY25 Revenue Breakup




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
Segment-wise Revenue Break-up

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



Annual Revenue Breakup












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Working Capital (Rs. Crore) - Bar Chart Working Capital (Days) - Line Chart


