**Jamshedpur:** Tata Steel on Thursday announced a total payout of ₹303.13 crore as a bonus for its staff for FY25, after a memorandum of settlement was signed with the union in Jamshedpur. For divisions at Jamshedpur, ₹152.44 crore of the total payout will be distributed among 11,446 employees, the steel maker said. The minimum and maximum bonus payable will be ₹39,004 and ₹3,92,213, respectively. **PTI**

# Aeronautical infra complete at Noida airport, says CEO

**PHASE 1.** With 1 runway & 1 terminal, the airport is set to handle 12m passengers annually

Marking a critical step towards operational readiness, the aeronautical infrastructure at the upcoming Noida International Airport is "now complete", said the airport's Chief Executive Officer Christoph Schnellmann.

Roofing work of the passenger terminal building has been completed and finishing works and technical installations are underway.

Speaking to *businessline*, Schnellmann said the Airports Authority of India (AAI) is at work, installing and commissioning equipment in the air traffic control tower.

"At the same time, a comprehensive Operational Readiness, Activation and Transition (ORAT) programme is being implemented to ensure all systems, processes, and personnel are

fully prepared for operations," he said.

"This includes trial runs, simulations, and familiarisation programmes for airlines, ground handlers, and other key stakeholders. Tests are underway on the baggage handling system, security equipment, check-in counters and boarding gates," he added.

Last month, *businessline* reported that NIA has initiated 'terminal trials', or ORAT, which is a critical phase that signals the start of

final preparations before the airport becomes fully functional. The full-fledged 'terminal trials' are focused on testing passenger processes, systems integration, and coordination among various airport partners.

Besides, Schnellmann said 'cargo terminal' is nearing completion. "Commissioning of the fuel farm and fuel hydrant system will commence shortly," he said.

"Our next major milestone is the issuance of the aerodrome licence by the

Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA)," he added.

**PHASED APPROACH**

According to industry insiders, the airport is expected to commence operations during the fourth quarter of CY25.

Initially, only domestic operations may start, followed by international flights, industry insiders said.

In its first phase of development, the airport, with one runway and one terminal, will have a capacity to handle 12 million passengers annually.

After the completion of the fourth phase, the airport will have the capacity to manage 70 million passengers per year. IndiGo is expected to be the first to start services. The airline had entered a MoU with NIA.

Many foreign carriers have also shown interest in starting operations at the airport.

# A23 Rummy parent moves HC against law banning RMG

Head Digital Works, the parent company of A23 Rummy, has challenged the new gaming law in the Karnataka High Court.

The Court will hear the plea challenges the Promotion and Regulation of Online Gaming Act, 2025, on Saturday.

The petition was mentioned on Thursday (August 28) before Justice BM Shyam Prasad, who directed that it be listed for hearing.

**SECTORS HIT**

The Act, which prohibits all forms of "online money games" along with associated advertising and banking services, was passed by the Lok Sabha on August 20, the Rajya Sabha on August 21, and signed into law by the President on August 22, completing the process in four days.

While the legislation has been welcomed by the video

# RBI to hold ₹1.5 lakh crore 6-day VRRR auction today

The Reserve Bank of India will hold ₹1.5-lakh crore six-day variable rate reverse repo (VRRR) auction on Friday, according to a central bank statement.

"On a review of the current and evolving liquidity conditions, it has been decided to conduct a variable rate reverse repo auction on Friday," the RBI said.

**NET LIQUIDITY**

The RBI conducts VRRR operations to absorb excess liquidity from the banking system and to keep short-term rates aligned with the policy repo rate.

As of Wednesday, the net liquidity surplus in the banking system was ₹1.83-lakh crore, according to the RBI's latest data.

Earlier today, the RBI accepted bids amounting to ₹49,515 crore in its one-day VRRR auction against the notified amount of ₹75,000 crore.

# Mahindra Aero bags 2nd Airbus deal to make copter fuselage

India's aerospace manufacturing portfolio is set to expand further, with Airbus Helicopters awarding a contract to Mahindra Aerostructures Private Ltd (MASPL) to manufacture the main fuselage of the H125 helicopter. The rotary wing aircraft will also be assembled in India.

ages manufactured at this site will be integrated into Airbus' global supply chain.

**H125, A BESTSELLER**  
Airbus has also partnered with Tata Advanced Systems

Ltd (TASL) to establish a Final Assembly Line (FAL) for the H125 in Kolar, Karnataka. Slated to begin operations in 2026, the FAL will assemble up to 10 helicopters annually, with initial

production earmarked for the Indian market.

The H125, a single-engine light utility helicopter, is Airbus' best-selling civil helicopter. In 2024 alone, 125 units were sold globally.

The new contract was announced in the presence of Wouter van Wersch, Executive Vice-President International at Airbus; Jürgen Westermeier, President and MD of Airbus in India and South Asia; and Arvind Mehra, MD and CEO of MASPL.

Westermeier said, "This significant H125 work package, along with our existing H130 partnership and the under-construction H125

FAL, demonstrates our confidence in India as a critical hub for global aerospace manufacturing. We are not just building helicopters in India; we are building an entire ecosystem that will contribute to developing and maturing the rotorcraft market in India," he added.

Anand Mahindra, Chairman of the Mahindra Group, described the development as a "great news". Anish Shah, Group CEO and MD of Mahindra Group, said, "This contract strengthens our long-term partnership and reflects Mahindra Group and Airbus' role in building India's aerospace ecosystem".

# FanCode to shut e-comm arm, focus on core content business

Sports streaming platform FanCode said it has decided to wind down its e-commerce arm, FanCode Shop, to focus on its core content business.

FanCode Shop, launched in 2020, sold authentic sports merchandise like jerseys and collectibles from leading teams and brands, including six Indian Premier League (IPL) franchises. The platform will continue to operate until October.

"In June, we made the decision to wind down the merchandise business and redirect resources and all our energies towards our core content product. This will help us focus on what's growing fastest and delivering the most value to our users," the company said.

**LEGISLATION BLOW**

Backed by Dream Sports — the parent company of fantasy gaming giant Dream11 — FanCode was launched in 2019 and today claims more than 15 crore users. The platform holds

broadcast rights for Formula 1 in India as well as a five-year exclusive deal to stream LaLiga EA Sports and LaLiga Hypermotion.

The development comes as Dream Sports itself is grappling with a major hit to revenues. Following the enactment of the Promotion and Regulation of Online Gaming Act, 2025, which bans real-money gaming and its promotion, Dream11 was forced to shut down its core business.

The company has said the move wiped out about 95 per cent of its group revenue.

# चिंचोणे ग्रामस्थ बायपासच्या मागणीवर आक्रमक

मडगाव, दि. २८ : वाहतुकीच्या प्रचंड कोंडीत आणि असुरक्षित जीवनशैलीत अडकलेल्या चिंचोणे -देवसू परिसरातील ग्रामस्थांनी दीर्घकाळ रखडलेल्या राष्ट्रीय महामार्ग-६६ दांडेवाडा बायपाससाठी तातडीने कारवाई करण्याची मागणी पुन्हा एकदा जोरदारपणे केली आहे.

अलिकडेच महाराष्ट्रातील बेलापूर येथील प्रादेशिक कार्यालयाच्या मुख्य अभियंत्यांना सादर केलेल्या निवेदनात ग्रामस्थांनी विद्यमान परिस्थितीला असह्य ठरवत कायमस्वरूपी उपाययोजना करण्याचे आवाहन केले. हा बायपास रस्ता हा केवळ सोयीसाठी नसून सुरक्षित आणि सन्मानाने जगण्याचा मूलभूत अधिकार आहे, असे ग्रामस्थांनी स्पष्ट केले.

चिंचोणे गावातून जाणाऱ्या राष्ट्रीय महामार्ग-६६ चा अरुंद भाग वर्षानुवर्षे जड वाहनांच्या वाहतुकीने गुदमरला आहे. परिणामी, या परिसरात ध्वनी आणि वायू प्रदूषण वाढले असून पादचारी, शाळकरी मुले, ज्येष्ठ नागरिक यांचे जीव धोक्यात आले आहेत.

धरंज्या दारातच ट्रक, बस आणि कॅन्टेनरच्या रांगा लागत असल्याने येथील कुटुंबीयांचे दैनंदिन जीवन विकळीत झाले आहे. गावातील घरे आता सुरक्षित राहिली नाहीत. वाहतूक कोंडीमुळे मुलांना शाळेत पाठवतानाही भीती वाटते, असे स्थानिक रहिवाशांनी निवेदनात नमूद केले.

राष्ट्रीय महामार्ग प्राधिकरणाने चिंचोणे च्या



गावातून जाणाऱ्या रस्त्याचे उन्नतीकरण करण्याचा प्रस्ताव दिला असला तरी, स्थानिक ग्रामस्थ व पंचायतीने याला तीव्र विरोध दर्शविला आहे.

हा प्रस्ताव गावाचे मूळ स्वरूप बिघडवेल आणि सुरक्षितता व प्रदूषणाच्या समस्या कायम राहतील, असा ग्रामस्थांचा इशारा आहे. त्याऐवजी दांडेवाडा बायपास आवश्यक असल्यास स्टिल्टवर उभारणे हाच एकमेव

व्यवहार्य आणि दीर्घकालीन उपाय असल्याचा ठाम आग्रह ग्रामस्थांनी धरला आहे.

या संदर्भातील बैठकीत अधिकाऱ्यांनी पंचायत शिष्टमंडळाला आश्वासन दिले की, जर गोवा सरकारने औपचारिकपणे शिफारस केली तर बायपास प्रस्तावावर सकारात्मक विचार केला जाईल. मुख्यमंत्री डॉ. प्रमोद सावंत यांनी स्वतः या मागणीची नोंद घेत राज्य शासन या प्रश्नाचा गंभीरपणे विचार करेल असे सांगितले

आहे. यासोबतच आवश्यक नो ऑब्जेक्शन प्रमाणपत्र कम्प्युनिटिडिझकडून आधीच मिळाल्याचे अधिकाऱ्यांनी स्पष्ट केले आहे. हा रस्ता केवळ सोयीसाठी नाही; तो सुरक्षितपणे आणि शांततेने जगण्याच्या आपल्या अधिकाराबाबत आहे. पंचायत शेवटपर्यंत ग्रामस्थांच्या पाठीशी उभी राहील, असे सरपंच फ्रँक व्हिएगस यांनी ठामपणे सांगितले.

## म्हापसा चाकूहल्ल्याप्रकरणी चार जणाना अटक

म्हापसा, दि. २८ : म्हापसा येथे दोन खाजगी पे-पार्किंग कर्मचाऱ्यांवर झालेल्या जीवघेण्या चाकू हल्ल्याप्रकरणी पोलिसांनी चार जणांना अटक केली असून आणखी एकाचा शोध सुरू आहे. अटक केलेल्यांत सांगोलडा येथील किशोरवयीन रूप साई (१८) आणि अनिकेत (१८) तसेच कळंगुट येथील भुवन (१८), आणि साईश (२५), यांचा समावेश आहे.

म्हापसा बाजारात बुधवारी दुपारी पार्किंग शुल्काच्या वादातून झालेल्या भांडणाने थरारक वळण घेतले. फिरकोळ वादातून सुरू झालेली बाचाबाची अखेरीस रक्तपातात बदलली आणि यात दोन पार्किंग कर्मचाऱ्यांवर चाकूहल्ला झाला. या घटनेने बाजारपेठेत मोठी खळबळ उडाली.

सुत्रांनी दिलेल्या माहितीनुसार, सांगोलडा येथील किशोरवयीन रूप साई आणि अनिकेत हे गणेशोत्सवाची खरेदी करण्यासाठी म्हापशात आले होते. त्यांनी मरोड येथे आपली गाडी उभी केली. त्यावेळी पार्किंग कर्मचारी प्रकाश तलवार आणि संदीप कुमार यांनी त्यांच्याकडे शुल्काची मागणी केली. मात्र रूप आणि अनिकेत यांनी सध्या पैसे नाहीत, नंतर देऊ असे सांगत रकम चुकती करण्यास



विलंब मागितला. यावर कर्मचाऱ्यांनी आक्षेप घेतला आणि त्यातील एका कर्मचाऱ्याने सहकान्याला मदतीसाठी बोलावले. त्यानंतर सुरू झालेली बाचाबाची काही क्षणांतच धक्कादायक मारहाणीमध्ये बदलली.

झालेल्या हाणामारीत रूप आणि अनिकेतवर हल्ला झाला. जीव वाचवण्यासाठी तेथून पळ काढत अनिकेतने बोडगेश्वर मंदिराजवळील एका निवासस्थानी आश्रय घेतला. यावेळी त्याने कळंगुट येथील मित्रांना फोन करून घटनेची माहिती दिली.

काही मिनिटांतच कळंगुटमधील तरुणांचा गट घटनास्थळी दाखल झाला. त्यानंतर दोन्ही गटांमध्ये

मोठ्या प्रमाणावर मारामारी झाली. या झटापटीत प्रकाश तलवार आणि संदीप कुमार यांना धारदार शस्त्राने भोसकण्यात आले. यामध्ये तलवार गंभीर जखमी झाले असून त्यांची प्रकृती चिंताजनक असल्याचे वृत्त आहे.

हल्ल्यानंतर आरोपी घटनास्थळावरून पसार झाले. पोलिसांनी तत्काळ सर्च ऑपरेशन हाती घेतले आणि आतापर्यंत चार जणाना अटक केली आहे. पुढील तपास सुरू असून सीसीटीव्ही फुटेजची कसून तपासणी केली जात आहे.

या प्रकरणी आरोपींवर कलम ३५२, १०९, ३५१(३) व कलम ३(५) अंतर्गत गुन्हा नोंदविण्यात आला आहे.

## राजस्थानचा कुख्यात गुंड विष्णू बिश्रोईला गोव्यात अटक

पणजी, दि. २८ : गोवा पोलिसांनी पंजाब पोलिसांना हवा असलेला आणि फाजिल्का जिल्ह्यातील हाय-प्रोफाइल खुनासह अनेक गंभीर गुन्हांमध्ये 'वॉन्टेड' असलेला राजस्थानचा कुख्यात गुंड विष्णू बिश्रोई (३२) याला गोव्यातून ताब्यात घेतले आहे.

पंजाब पोलिसांनी उत्तर गोवा पोलिस अधीक्षकांना बिश्रोई गोव्यात लपल्याची माहिती दिल्यानंतर ही कारवाई करण्यात आली. त्यानुसार एसपी राहुल गुसा यांच्या नेतृत्वाखाली आणि डीआयजी रंज वर्या शर्मा यांच्या देखरेखीखाली २० सदस्यांचे विशेष पथक तयार करण्यात आले.

बिश्रोई हा जोधपूर जिल्ह्यातील खुडाला, सुरता नगर येथील रहिवासी असून, त्याच्यावर पंजाबमध्ये नोंदवलेल्या दोन स्वतंत्र प्रकरणांमध्ये गुन्हे दाखल आहेत. एक गुन्हा राज्य गुन्हे पोलिस स्टेशन, एसएस नगर येथे तर दुसरा सिटी-१ पोलिस स्टेशन, अबोहर (फाजिल्का जिल्हा) येथे नोंदवलेला आहे.

गुप्तचर यंत्रणेच्या मदतीने केलेल्या समन्वित कारवाईत बिश्रोई अजुना पोलिस स्टेशन हद्दीतील एका हॉटेलमध्ये सहा साथीदारांसह लपून बसलेला आढळला. यावरून म्हापसा पीआय निखिल पालेकर आणि हणजूण पीआय स्वप्निल नाईक यांच्या नेतृत्वाखाली छापा टाकण्यात आला.

या कारवाईत बिश्रोईला अटक करून

त्याला पुढील चौकशीसाठी पंजाब राज्य गुन्हे पोलिसांच्या ताब्यात सोपवण्यात आले. दरम्यान, त्याच्यासोबत सापडलेल्या सहा जणांना खबरदारीचा उपाय म्हणून ताब्यात घेण्यात आले. तपासानंतर या सहा जणांचा गुन्हात धेट सहभाग नसल्याचे स्पष्ट झाले.

पोलिसांच्या माहितीनुसार, बिश्रोईचे गुन्हेगारी नेटवर्क व्यापक असून त्याच्या हालचालींचा तपास सुरू आहे. सुत्रांचे म्हणणे आहे की या टोळीने उत्तर आणि दक्षिण गोव्यात आपले तळ उभारले आहे. दिल्ली व पंजाबमधील काही मोठे बांधकाम व्यावसायिक जे गोव्यात गुंतवणूक करतात, त्यांना हे रॅकेट लक्ष्य करत असल्याची माहिती पमोर आली आहे. एका बरिष्ठ पोलिस अधिकाऱ्याने नाव न

सांगण्याच्या अटीवर सांगितले की, या अटकेमुळे केवळ हिमलगाचे टोक उघड झाले आहे. या गुंडांचे राजकीय पार्टीचे असण्याची शक्यता आहे.

गेल्या वर्षी मुंबईत राहणाऱ्या काँग्रेसचे नेते बाबा सिद्धीकी यांच्यावर झालेल्या गोळीबार प्रकरणात तुरुंगात असलेला लोरेन्स बिश्रोईचे नाव पुढे आले होते. लोरेन्सवर खून, खंडणी यांसह दोन डझनपेक्षा अधिक गुन्हे दाखल आहेत. तुरुंगात असूनही त्याने आपले सिडिकेट चालवले असल्याचा संशय आहे. भरतपूर तुरुंगातूनही काही पोलिस व तुरुंग कर्मचाऱ्यांच्या मदतीने त्याने कारवाया केल्याचे वृत्त आहे. गोव्यातील विष्णू बिश्रोईची अटक ही त्याच नेटवर्कशी संबंधित असल्याचा पोलिसांचा अंदाज आहे.

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## मडगावात जीआयएस मालमत्ता सर्वेक्षण वेगाने सुरू

मडगाव, दि. २८ : मडगाव नगरपरिषद (एमएमसी) आणि गोवा राज्य नागरी विकास संस्था (जीएसएडीए) यांच्या संयुक्त विद्यमाने शहरात जीआयएस-आधारित मालमत्ता कर मूल्यांकन सर्वेक्षणाला गती देण्यात आली आहे. कर संकलनात पारदर्शकता आणि अचूकता आणण्याच्या उद्देशाने सुरू असलेल्या या उपक्रमामुळे मात्र अनेक

रहिवाशांमध्ये - विशेषतः फातोर्ड भागात संभ्रम आणि अस्वस्थता निर्माण झाली आहे.

या सर्वेक्षणाची जबाबदारी कोल्ब्रो गुप प्रा. लि. यांच्याकडे सोपवण्यात आली असून, त्यामार्फत मालमत्तेची मोजणी, छायाचित्रण, मालकी तपासणी आणि नोंदींचे अद्ययावतीकरण केले जात आहे. ११ ऑक्टोबर २०२४ रोजी एमएमसीकडून प्रसिद्ध सूचनेत नागरिकांना स्पष्ट करण्यात आले की, सर्वेक्षक घराघरांत जाऊन सर्व माहिती गोळा करतील. त्यासाठी फॉर्म डी, सर्वेक्षण योजना, युटिलिटी बिले, ट्रेड लायसन्स, मालकी हक्काची कागदपत्रे, ओळखपत्रे तसेच बांधकाम परवानग्या तयार ठेवाव्या लागतील.

सूचनेवर माजी मुख्य अधिकारी मॅल्विन वाझ यांच्या स्वाक्षरी असून त्यात नागरिकांच्या सहकार्याचे विशेष महत्त्व अधोरेखित करण्यात आले आहे. सूचनेत नमूद केले आहे:

जर आवश्यक कागदपत्रे उपलब्ध करून दिली नाहीत तर संबंधित मालमत्तेचे मूल्यांकन उपलब्ध माहितीच्या आधारे केले जाईल. त्यामुळे विसंगती टाळण्यासाठी अचूक तपशील देणे अत्यावश्यक आहे.

तथापि, प्रत्यक्ष सर्वेक्षणाच्या अंमलबजावणीत अनेक रहिवाशांमध्ये संभ्रमाचे वातावरण दिसून येत आहे.

फातोर्डतील रहिवासी पीटर फर्नांडिस यांनी विता व्यक्त करताना सांगितले : काही लोक अचानक आमच्या घरी आले आणि कागदपत्रांची मागणी केली. त्यांची खरी ओळख काय याबद्दल गोंधळ निर्माण झाला. परिषदेकडून आधीच सर्वेक्षकांची नावे व माहिती देण्यात आली असती तर आम्हाला विश्वास वाटला असता.

दुसरे रहिवासी रमेश नाईक म्हणाले : सर्वेक्षणाला आमचा पाठिंबा आहे; परंतु सर्वेक्षक कोण आहेत आणि त्यांची अधिकृत ओळख काय याची खात्री मिळणे गरजेचे आहे. योग्य जागरूकता मोहिमेमुळेच ही प्रक्रिया सुरळीत पार पडेल.

मडगाव नगरपरिषदेचे अध्यक्ष दामोदर शिरोडकर यांनी संयम व सहकार्याचे आवाहन केले. ते म्हणाले : रेकार्ड अद्ययावत केल्यामुळे केवळ कर संकलनच पारदर्शक होणार नाही, तर पायाभूत सुविधा आणि शहर विकासासाठी अचूक नियोजन कणही शक्य होईल. हा उपक्रम शेवटी मडगावकरांच्या हिताचाच आहे. नागरिकांचा विश्वास संपादन करण्यासाठी सर्व अधिकृत सर्वेक्षकांची नावे व संपर्क तपशील लवकरच सार्वजनिकरित्या जाहीर करण्यात येतील, असे एमएमसीकडून स्पष्ट करण्यात आले आहे.

# Rain, flash floods take lives, disrupt relief in India

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** Raging waters swallowed roads and bridges, swept away buildings and cut off villages in parts of India on Thursday as the rain gods refused to relent, leaving many stranded and rescuers scrambling to reach them.

From Himachal Pradesh in the north to Kerala in the south, rains caused water levels of rivers and dams to rise and inundate residential areas and agricultural fields.

Kashmir, however, breathed easy as a let-up in rain after two days eased the flood threat.

In Himachal Pradesh, flash floods in the Ravi river washed away several government buildings in the remote Bada Bangal village in Kangra district, officials said.

There was no loss of life, they said.

"A primary and high school, the panchayat ghar,

an ayurvedic dispensary and a civil supplies store that housed about 70 quintals of ration were washed away in lower Bada Bangal on Tuesday. The village has been cut off from the rest of the state as two bridges were also swept away," Baijnath Sub-Divisional Magistrate Sankalp Gautam told PTI.

With the village cut off and communication a prob-

lem, the reports from the village reached authorities only on Wednesday night.

Gautam said 180 quintals of ration is being sent to the village but the roads are blocked. Essential items and medicines would be air-dropped if the need arises, he said.

The Bada Bangal village, located at an altitude of 7,800 feet, is accessible only by foot through the

high-altitude Thamsar and Kalihani passes. It remains cut off from the rest of the state for four to six months during winters.

According to the State Emergency Operation Centre, 536 roads are closed across 11 of the 12 districts in Himachal Pradesh. Reports from Chamba have not been received as the communication network in the district is snapped, it

said.

The flood threat in Kashmir eased, with the water levels in the Jhelum river and other water bodies starting to recede as the weather improved. In the past 12 hours, there has been very little rainfall in the Kashmir Valley, officials said.

The Jhelum dropped below the flood alert level at Sangam in south Kashmir's Anantnag district. Though it is still above the danger level downstream in Srinagar, the water level has started receding, they said.

The tributaries of the river are also flowing below the flood alert level.

According to the meteorological department, a spell of light to moderate rain at scattered to fairly widespread places with a possibility of moderate to heavy rain or thundershowers in a few districts of Jammu is likely from August 30 to September 1.

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## BJP demands deadline for Dharmasthala SIT probe

**PTI, BENGALURU:** Karnataka BJP on Thursday demanded that the SIT probe into allegations of multiple murders, rapes and burials in Dharmasthala over a period of the past two decades should be "time-bound".

The party's state President B Y Vijayendra, rejecting allegations that the BJP was trying to politicise the case, questioned the Congress government's inaction against the conspirators and those behind the smear campaign against Dharmasthala.

Responding to a question while speaking to reporters, Vijayendra said, "Tomorrow we don't have any Assembly or Lok Sabha polls or any by-election. There is no need for the BJP to politicise this issue".

"Why did the Siddaramaiah-led Congress government not initiate action against the conspirators, against people who are spreading rumors? Why

has no FIR been registered against those conspirators?" Vijayendra asked and termed "this is the issue".

Stating that the BJP never opposed the government constituting the SIT to probe the Dharmasthala case, the state BJP chief said, "But during the

course of investigation, when there was a series of false propaganda -- the Siddaramaiah government, despite being aware of the emotional connect that several crore devotees have towards Dharmasthala -- no FIR was booked against people behind it".

## Centre: States can't move SC over Prez, Gov actions on bills

**PTI, NEW DELHI:** The Centre on Thursday told the Supreme Court that state governments cannot invoke writ jurisdiction in moving the apex court against the actions of the President and the governor in dealing with the bills passed by assemblies for violation of fundamental rights.

A five-judge bench Constitution bench headed by Chief Justice BR Gavai was told by Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, that the President would like to have an opinion of the apex court on whether states can file writ petition under Article 32 of the Constitution for violation of fundamental rights.

He said the President would also like to have an opinion on the scope of Article 361 of the Constitution which says the President, or the Governor will not be answerable to any court for the exercise and performance of the powers and duties of his office or for any act done.

Mehta told the bench also comprising Justices Surya Kant, Vikram Nath, PS Narasimha and AS Chandurkar that they have debated over these questions in the reference but the President is of the opinion that she would like to have the view of

the court to know the exact legal position as issue may arise in the future.

He submitted that Article 32 petition on behalf of the state against the action of the governor and the President cannot be filed as it is not maintainable, no direction can be issued to them and thirdly the action of the governor and the President in dealing with the bills is not justiciable.

"Article 32 lies when there is violation of fundamental rights and state government in the constitutional scheme does not in itself have the fundamental right. It is a repository of functions which is to protect fundamental rights of its people," Mehta said.

The solicitor general referred to the April 8 Tamil Nadu verdict in which states were given liberty to approach the apex court directly in case timeline is not adhered by the governor in clearing the bills passed by the

assembly.

CJI Gavai said it will not say any words with regard to the two-judge verdict of April 8 but the Governor would not be justified in sitting over the bill for six months

Mehta submitted that one constitutional organ not discharging his duties, does not entitle the court to direct another constitutional organ.

The CJI said, "Yes. We know what your argument is? If this court does not decide the matter for 10 years, would it be justified for the President to issue an order?"

The hearing is underway. On August 26, the top court wondered whether the court should sit powerless if a Governor delays assent to bills indefinitely and if the constitutional functionary's independent power to withhold a bill would mean that even money bills could be blocked.

## SAMBHAL TEMPLE-MOSQUE ROW Court sets Sept 25 for hearing

**PTI, SAMBHAL (UP):** A court in Chandausi on Thursday fixed September 25 to hear the ongoing Shahi Jama Masjid-Harihar temple dispute.

The matter was listed for hearing before civil judge (senior division) Aditya Singh.

Shahi Jama Masjid advocate Shakeel Ahmed Warsi, while talking to reporters, said the hearing was scheduled today but owing to the stay by the Supreme Court, it was deferred to September 25.

Hindu side advocate Shri Shri Gopal Sharma, while talking to PTI, confirmed the development.

The Muslim side has challenged the maintainability of the case in the Allahabad High Court, but on May 19, the high court upheld the trial court's order permitting a court-mon-

itored survey and directed it to proceed with the matter.

The dispute dates back to November 19 last year, when Hindu petitioners, including advocates Hari Shankar Jain and Vishnu Shankar Jain, filed a suit in the Sambhal district court claiming the mosque was built over a pre-existing temple.

A court-ordered survey was conducted on the same day (November 19), followed by another on November 24.

The second survey on November 24 led to significant unrest in Sambhal, resulting in the death of four persons and injuries to 29 police personnel.
