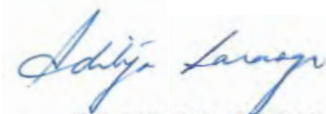

In case shares are held in Demat Form and are liable to be transferred to Demat Account of the IEPF Authority, the Company shall inform the depository by way of corporate action for transfer of shares to the Demat Account of IEPF Authority.

Please note that no claim shall lie against the Company in respect of unclaimed dividend amounts and the shares transferred in favour of the IEPF Authority pursuant to the said Rules.
