Country going through challenges but Constitution has kept it united: Pawar

STRESSING ON the need to spread the work and contribution of Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar among the new generation, NCP (SP) chief Sharad Pawar on Wednesday said there were few wrong things happening in the country but the Indian Constitution has kept the country united.

"Whenever the name of Babasaheb Ambedkar comes up, then a discussion on Indian Constitution also takes place. It is true that the country remains united due to the Constitution drafted under the leadership of Ambedkar. There are some challenges now as some wrong things are happening. It should be admitted that contribution of Constitution is immense in keeping the country united," Pawar said while inaugurating the Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Social Research Centre set up by a group of socially active leaders including Jaideo Gaikwad.

He said if we analyse the situation in the country, then we would realise there is unrest and instability in neighbouring coun-

tries Pakistan, Nepal, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka. "However, the situation in India is not like as that in our neighbouring country which is only because of Ambedkar. His contribution cannot be forgotten," said Pawar.

The NCP (SP) chief said the situation in the country is different now and it raises concern. "I have been in Parliament for long. Those in Parliament express their respective opinion on the issues. The decisions in the Parliament are taken after

dialogue with everyone irrespective of the political party. Now it seems that those in power don't take decisions after holding dialogue with others. I doubt that whether they believe in dialogue," he said, adding one day those in power all of a sudden declare that a new Parliament building will be constructed and there is no discussion or dialogue on it.

He said the centre being set up in Pune will hopefully spread the contribution of Ambedkar

among new generation. "It is important that such initiative has been taken up. It should emerge as centre for discussion and deliberation on the Constitution and its importance. Ambedkar spent most of his life in Maharashtra. So, his work should be spread here as well. Those who already spread the message of Ambedkar should be encouraged," said Pawar.

The NCP (SP) chief said the contribution of Ambedkar equally hold immense importance in agriculture and power sector. "To tackle hunger, Ambedkar realised the need of dams for making water available for irrigation. His perspective was nation building and to remove poverty, the need of electricity was given importance by Ambedkar," he said.

Earlier in the day, Pawar said, "Kashmiris have always stood firmly with India, despite attempts by neighbouring countries to create unrest and violence. The people of Kashmir have consistently proved themselves an integral part of the nation, and their contribution in the service of the country is immense. Supporting these efforts, organizations like Sarhad have

played a vital role in strengthening the bond. Sarhad has shown that the entire nation stands united with Kashmir."

After inauguration of the 'Vijay Dhar Amphitheatre' established on the premises of Sarhad Global School and Junior College at Gujarwadi, Pawar said, "Pune has always shown India a new path — whether in education, industry, IT, or culture. Lokmanya Tilak initiated the movement to bring people together from this very city. Today, when Kashmir has faced long years of turmoil that disrupted education, it is people like Vijay Dhar and institutions like Sarhad that took responsibility and worked with dedication. Kashmir is India's crown jewel, and no matter how much unrest is attempted, it will always remain an integral part of our country."

The event was attended by former Union Home Minister Sushilkumar Shinde, Vijay Dhar along with his wife Kiran Dhar and daughter Kanika Dhar, Sarhad founder Sanjay Nahar, Principal Sushma Nahar, Sant Singh Mokha, trustee Shailesh Wadekar, Dr Shailesh Pagaria and architect Imran Shaikh, Vasant More and several dignitaries.

Research integrity and a redundant syllabus among reasons for SPPU's slide in NIRF ranking, says ex-VC

IN ADDITION to dwindling faculty numbers, research integrity, redundant syllabus, a lack of international faculty and student diversity, and inadequate 'data management' are reasons for Savitribai Phule Pune University's (SPPU) drop in National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) this year, said former Vice-Chancellor of the university Nitin Karmalkar. SPPU's rank slid to 91 in the 'Overall' rankings this year as compared to the 37 rank it achieved last year.

Post discussion on the drop in rankings organised by the Progressive Education Society on Wednesday, Karmalkar shared data from the Research Integrity Risk Index (RII), developed by Lokman Meho at the American University of Beirut. SPPU was ranked in the 'Red Flag' category, signalling extreme anomalies and systemic integrity risks. This means a higher than acceptable number of research papers are either re-

tracted or published in journals delisted by Scopus or Web of Science.

In his speech at the event Karmalkar talked about updating the syllabus and said, "We must think about how redundant has the syllabus become. Many times we see that the intake is 20 but there are not even 2 students. This means that the syllabus is outdated and there is no demand in the market. Such subjects should be analysed and checked if it is possible to shut them. It should also be kept in mind that it is very easy to shut but it is also a question of the professor's livelihood. So what alternative can be provided (must be thought about)."

He added that steps must be taken to increase the 'Perception' metric of the university that had fallen. "Another area we are lacking in is perception, maybe not just from today but even during or before my time. Just like emeritus professors, we have a category called distinguished professors. Just their presence on our campus has a lot of indirect benefits," said Karmalkar.

SPPU holds event for Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil's birth anniversary

THE BIRTH anniversary of social reformer and educationist Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil was observed with reverence and enthusiasm at Potdar Sankul, Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU).
