'Gross value addition from GCCs can hit \$200 b by 2030'

EFFICIENT WORKFORCE. Indian talent is more cost-effective, says Nirmala Sitharaman

Gross value addition (GVA) from global capability centres (GCC) could touch up to \$200 billion by 2030, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said on Monday. The FM also expects a nearly five times increase in global roles within Indian GCCs.

Addressing a GCC summit organised by CII here, the FM said on average, one new GCC per week was set up in 2024. Nearly half of Fortune 500 companies had set up GCCs in India. GCCs employ nearly 2.16 million professionals in India, having grown at a CAGR of 11 per cent over the last 5 years. The figure is expected to reach 2.8 million by 2030.

"India's GCC sector contributes \$68 billion as direct gross value addition (GVA), i.e., around 1.6 per cent of the national GDP. By 2030, the gross value addition from GCCs could potentially range between \$150 billion and \$200 billion," she said.

SETUP RATE

Further, the setup rate of engineering research and development GCCs has grown

1.3 times faster than the overall GCC setup over the last 5 years, indicating a clear shift towards high-value-added work in India. She highlighted that engaging Indian talent is more cost-effective as compared to other countries. It is estimated that it costs 30-50 per cent less than the US, the UK and Australia. Over the past decade, India's GCC ecosystem has matured significantly, moving beyond execution to become centres of strategic leadership and transformation.

Many GCCs now house high-end roles, including product managers, architects, data scientists and global function heads.

A recent survey found that over 35 per cent of transformation hubs in India report a strong presence of architects, demonstrating the growing complexity and global ownership of tech mandates. "Global roles within Indian GCCs are expected to increase from 6,500 today to over 30,000 by 2030, supported by robust in-house training programmes that nurture global-ready leadership," she said.

ON TALENT POOL

She emphasised that India's unique strength lay in its immense talent pool, accounting for 28 per cent of the

global science, technology, engineering and mathematics workforce and 23 per cent of the global software engineering talent. Over 32 per cent of global GCC talent is currently based in India. In the last decade, 7 new IITs and 16 new IIITs have been opened across the country. India has among the highest proportion of female STEM graduates, at 42.7 per cent. "It is important because there is approximately 35 per cent female participation in GCC workforce," she said.

Economic Affairs Secretary Anuradha Thakur said India needs to streamline policies at national level to make the country a hub for GCCs. "Even now GCCs are focused on particular States; so we need to study what those States did earlier, whether it was Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Telangana. We know those States have specific policies both on physical infrastructure and digital infrastructure, they also have certain regulatory policy initiatives which helped GCCs there and grow further. Whether we need to disturb that or add more is something that we need to do today, perhaps a bit of both," Thakur said.

'Govt formulating comprehensive national framework for GCCs'

Youth unemployment has gone down from 17.8 per cent in 2017-18 to 10.2 per cent in 2023-24 but it's a "better decline" than the global scenario, said Labour and Employment Secretary Vandana Gurnani at the CII GCC (Global Capability Centre) Business Summit on Monday.

Focusing on the job situation in the country, Gurnani said: "I would like to begin by giving a slightly macro picture on the employment metrics because one does see a lot of narratives and discussion on that in the media. So, if we just compare ourselves with 2017-18 to say 23-24, for which we have the latest data, we have seen a very decent increase in the workforce participation rate, including for women and youth, which is where I think GCCs play a major role."

"I would like to specifically focus on youth unemployment, which has gone down from 17.8 per cent to 10.2 per cent, which is, I would say, a better decline than the global scenario," Gurnani insisted. The global youth unemployment is 13.3 per cent, she pointed out to the gathering of industry representatives, government officials and other stakeholders.

ELI SCHEME

The Labour and Employment Secretary also stated that the recently announced ₹1 lakh crore worth Employment Linked Incentive (ELI) scheme, to be rolled out from August 1, will encourage employers to engage labourers in the age of automation.

The government estimates that the ELI initiative will lead to generation of 3.5 crore jobs, including for 1.9 crore first-timers, she stated. She referred to the global experience of countries such as Singapore, Australia, Turkey and Germany to illustrate that the ELI move not only increased employment but sustained employment and also wages of the workforce.

Gurnani stated that the ELI could unfold partnerships with the States and at the international level to provide a pool of right talent.

She called for increased GCC engagement with existing government schemes

other than that of ELI. She urged the GCCs to also leverage the government initiative of the National Career Services Portal, a comprehensive platform with partnerships across major firms offering job matching services to find talent.

LABOUR CODES

She said the implementation of the four labour codes had shifted to the States as the Centre is still to do that. Highlighting ongoing collaboration with the State governments to drive these reforms, Gurnani said that many States had allowed women to work at night, especially in the IT sector.

"The Central government has begun formulating a comprehensive national framework for GCCs to enhance their growth and expand their base," said KK Singh, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology.

Singh highlighted India's evolution from a cost-arbitrage destination to an innovation-driven economy powered by emerging technologies. He was of the view that GCCs play a vital role in India's economic landscape by creating high-value jobs, fostering skill development,

and facilitating knowledge transfer.

DIGITAL INDIA

Anuradha Thakur, Secretary of the Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, pointed to strong physical and digital infrastructure, strategic interventions through the Digital India initiative, streamlined approval processes, large talent strength and a robust regulatory environment built over the past decade.

Thakur pointed to the country's large annual output of STEM graduates, a diverse workforce with significant female participation, and a young median age.

Sanjay Bahadur, Member (Income Tax), Central Board of Direct Taxes, reaffirmed the government's commitment to addressing industry concerns, particularly regarding transfer pricing, dispute resolution mechanisms, and the appellate process.

He emphasised the Ministry's recognition of GCCs as key business enablers and expressed readiness to explore special regimes and accelerate resolution timelines. The CII proposed a draft National GCC Policy to position India as a global GCC hub.

Govt probes ₹4,000-cr non-BIS steel trade; Japan, Korea, China under lens

The Steel Ministry has been apprised of irregularities in quality in steel shipments coming in from select markets, including Japan and South Korea, apart from China.

At a recent Ministry-level meeting, a report flagged a sharp increase in applications for bringing in non-BIS-certified steel. Incidentally, rejections at the Ministry-level have also gone up, with one in every four applications being turned down.

Many intermediaries were making minor changes in declarations to bypass quality norms. These were mostly not true, it was found.

The ₹4,000 crore non-BIS steel import business (as per industry estimates) is now under detailed review, with the Ministry set to tighten scrutiny on incoming consignments and approvals, including sourcing country norms (from where the steel is sourced). "Higher imports were registered from Japan and Korea, which are not devoid of quality concerns," it was mentioned during a review meeting, a Ministry official said.

COMMITTEE FINDINGS

Meeting participants pointed out "minor" variations in chemical composition or



product measurements to categorise offerings as a new segment, thereby seeking permission for "cheaper or substandard" metal imports.

"It was also observed that imports were being carried out with minor alteration in steel grades to bypass BIS standard requirements," an observation by the technical committee noted.

In FY24, there were 23,301 applications (for import of non-BIS steel), of which 18,120 were cleared. The rejection rate stood at 22 per cent, with 5,181 applications being rejected. On the other hand, the applications shot up to 15,645 in the first six months of FY25, when the influx from China and imports hit, steel prices were cheaper than prices in the domestic market, nearly 34 per cent up on an annual basis, with there being 11,805 clearances. This meant that there were 25 per cent rejections (or 3,840 applications were shot down), indicating that there was heightened vigilance on such shipments.

Larger steel players in India had raised objections to such cheaper imports skew-

ing domestic market dynamics, post which quality control and traceability norms were upped on imports.

In the country, steel intermediaries or importers apply on the SIMS portal seeking import permission for non-BIS grades, where all details like chemical properties, type and other information are provided. Applications are required to be submitted for six months' intended quantity, post which a call is taken.

RELAXATION

However, the Ministry, earlier this month, relaxed quality control in part. Relaxations were on the condition that if the steel products were loaded/shipped on or before July 15, 2025, intermediaries need not follow norms on sourcing of steel. This was done as a temporary relief to MSMEs for pre-placed orders.

The BIS outlined 151 standards covering 1,376 steel grades under the Steel Ministry's Quality Control Orders. Typically, in India, once a steel standard is formulated by the Bureau of Indian Standards and incorporated, adherence has to be made to these norms. In case formulation of new standards and incorporation into QCO has not yet been done, import has to be done by obtaining NoC from the Ministry of Steel.

Indian team in US to resume trade talks

The Indian negotiating team for the India-US bilateral trade agreement (BTA) is in Washington DC for week-long talks with US officials after the previous round, which ended early this month, failed to lead to an interim deal, sources said.

This round will be crucial as it could determine if an interim pact will be possible by August 1, which is the new deadline for the imposition of reciprocal tariffs fixed by US President Donald Trump.

The initial deadline for reaching a deal to avoid reciprocal tariffs lapsed on July 9.

"We are negotiating with the US for a full BTA, for which the deadline is September 2025. But we would also want an interim pact, which would be a limited deal, before August 1, to avoid reciprocal tariffs. Let us see how things progress," a source tracking the matter said.

TARIFF LETTERS

About two dozen countries have received tariff letters from Trump, specifying the rates that will be levied on them from August 1 in case they do not get into a deal with the US. These rates are mostly in line with the reciprocal tariffs, but in some

cases they are higher. India is yet to receive such a letter.

Trump recently said that those countries that do not get a letter may have a blanket 15-20 per cent tariff imposed on their goods from August 1 in the absence of a deal.

On April 2, Trump announced reciprocal tariffs for most trade partners with which the US had a trade deficit. The tariff rate was fixed at 26 per cent for India.

This tariff was then suspended for a 90-day period, till July 9, except a base tariff of 10 per cent, to give time to countries to work out trade deals with the US.

US' DEMAND

The US and the US have been negotiating for some time, the two sides were not able to agree on a mini-deal before July 9. US demand for liberal market access across sectors, including sensitive areas like agriculture and dairy, are amongst the key reasons for delay, sources said.

Moreover, Washington is also keen to provide increased market access to India by lowering duties in the areas of its interest, including labour intensive products. India also wants a roll back of the 50 per cent tariffs on steel and aluminium and 25 per cent on the auto sector imposed by Trump.

WPI now in negative zone with June print at (-)0.1%

Wholesale inflation based on the Wholesale Price Index (WPI) turned into deflation after a gap of 19 months, with the headline number recorded at negative 0.13 per cent in June, government data on Monday said.

"Negative rate of inflation in June is primarily due to decrease in prices of food articles, mineral oils, manufacture of basic metals, crude petroleum & natural gas etc," a statement issued by the Commerce & Industry Ministry said. WPI-based inflation was 0.39 per cent in May. It was 3.43 per cent in June last year.

FOOD INFLATION

As per data, food articles saw a deflation of 3.75 per cent in June, as against a deflation of 1.56 per cent in May, with vegetables seeing a sharp drop. Deflation in vegetables was 22.65 per cent in June, com-

pared to 21.62 per cent in May. In the case of manufactured products, inflation was at 1.97 per cent, compared to 2.04 per cent in May. Fuel and power saw a deflation of 2.65 per cent in June, compared to a deflation of 2.27 per cent in May.

The Reserve Bank of India mainly takes into account retail inflation while formulating the monetary policy. The RBI last month cut benchmark policy interest rates by 0.5 per cent to 5.5 per cent, amid easing inflation.

Commenting on WPI

data, Rahul Agrawal, Senior Economist at ICRA, said that deflation was largely led by prices of food items, which declined by 0.3 per cent after witnessing an inflation of 1.7 per cent in the previous month, amid softer prints for fruits and vegetables, pulses, cereals, spices and edible oils. Among the non-food items, the deflation in fuel and power also widened between these months, exerting downward pressure on the headline print.

Notably, the core WPI (non-food manufactured

items) inflation inched up marginally to 1 per cent in June from 0.9 per cent in May, while remaining subdued. The seasonal sequential uptick in food prices has been relatively modest in July so far, which is expected to keep food print in the deflationary zone, unless there is an unusual surge in such prices in the remaining part of the month, especially for vegetables.

OIL PRICES EASE

Besides, international crude oil prices have also eased somewhat in the ongoing month from the peak seen in June, amid cooling tensions in West Asia, while remaining in the deflationary territory on a y-o-y basis. Further, the USD/INR pair also remained range-bound so far.

Hemant Jain, President, PHDCCI, said that softening of WPI inflation is expected to reduce operational costs for companies, boost domestic demand and support economic growth.
