Pat for NSE's e-book on SAT orders

Will come in handy for reference, says SEBI Whole-Time Member G Mahalingam

Capital market regulator SEBI will benefit the most from the e-book launched by the NSE. It is a compilation of more than 2,000 orders by the Securities Appellate Tribunal (SAT), said G 'Mahalingam, whole time member SEBI.

"The e-book will come in handy for reference while presiding over cases and passing orders. Otherwise, to find past SAT orders was a tedious task," Mahalingam said.

The NSE's e-book will be available on subscription basis and will be updated regularly. The e-book is the brainchild of VR Narasimhan, Chief of Regulations, NSE. "All the SAT orders have been compiled regulationwise, which will come in handy not only for regulators and legal professionals but even students who may otherwise find it difficult to dig through past orders," said Narasimhan.

SAT is a quasi-judicial authority for capital market related cases and has passed several landmark judgments that were upheld by the Supreme Court.
