NSE conducts live trading from disaster recovery site

The National Stock Exchange (NSE) on Wednesday said it had successfully completed a two-day live trading session from its disaster recovery (DR) site for a fifth successive time. The live trading was conducted on January 9-10, 2017, NSE said in a circular. A disaster recovery (DR) site is necessary for all critical institutions like exchanges so that operations can be done seamlessly and smoothly if any extraneous event affects the functioning of the main trading centre in Mumbai. NSE said it is in compliance with the recommendations of the technical advisory **Committee of markets** regulator Sebi on Business Continuity Policy (BCP) and DR site for stock exchanges and Depositories. The DR site of NSE is located far away from its primary site and is in a different seismic zone. PTI
