

130 flights delayed, 4 diverted as dense fog envelops Delhi

Mumbai, 27 December

Dense fog on Wednesday morning caused disruptions to flight operations at Delhi airport and led to the delay of 130 flights between 6 am to 12:30 pm, according to flight-tradar24.com.

At least four flights were diverted from the Delhi airport to Jaipur airport on Wednesday, airport sources said. Delhi airport handles around 1,200 flights every day. Passengers at the airport faced similar disruptions on Monday due to dense fog conditions.

As many as 333 flights were delayed and eight were diverted to nearby airports such as Jaipur or Ahmedabad on the same day.

To prepare for fog-related disruption, GMR group-led Delhi International Airport Limited (DIAL) said it has set up temporary help desks at the T3 forecourt and deployed additional manpower from terminal operations teams.

The terminal operations staff has been provided with high-visibility jackets, public address systems and radio transmission sets for better coordination and communication. The staff deployed at critical positions will facilitate passenger movement and provide updated information.

Apart from these, arrangements for meals for passengers, in the form of meal boxes or food coupons at the food outlets, have been made.

DIAL said it has facilitated the development and operations of a well-coordinated process between food outlets and airlines.

“Three concessionaires have been tasked with the responsibility of providing meals to passengers at the boarding gates or at the outlet. Airlines and food outlets coordinate for 100 per cent availability of food for passengers. (The airline would have to give one-hour advance notice to the F&B team for exact requirements),” it mentioned.

Aviation Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia had earlier this month told Rajya Sabha that in order to prepare for the onset of the fog period, the number of inspections and special audits were increased over the last two years to enhance various facilities at airports and in the area of air navigation services, *Business Standard*

reported on Monday. “As a result, despite an increase in flights by about 20 per cent, flight cancellations, which were 0.09 per cent during 2021-2022 of total flight movements, reduced to 0.05 per cent of total flight movements in 2022-2023,” he stated.

Scindia had told Rajya Sabha that before the onset of the fog season, the airlines had been instructed to bring changes in their flight schedules in such a way that CAT-II and CAT-III non-compliant aircraft would not be operating during this period.

CAT-II and CAT-III refer to different categories of Instrument Landing System (ILS) approaches, which are used to guide aircraft during their descent and landing in low-visibility conditions.

A CAT-II-compliant aircraft can land on the runway with visibility as low as 300 metres.

Rahul's east-to-west yatra from Jan 14

Manipur-Mumbai march will cover 6,200 km across 14 states

Congress leader Rahul Gandhi will embark on a 67-day east-to-west Bharat Nyaya Yatra from Manipur on January 14, the party announced on Wednesday, asserting that it would complement rather than distract from its 2024 Lok Sabha poll preparedness.

The 6,200-km yatra, which will begin almost a year after Gandhi's south-to-north walkathon, will cover 85 districts in 14 states. Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge will flag off the yatra in Imphal. It will conclude on March 20, ahead of the Lok Sabha elections.

Unlike the Bharat Jodo Yatra, where Gandhi had walked for 4,080 km from Kanyakumari to Kashmir, the former Congress chief and his associates will cover this yatra on a bus, interspersed with covering short stretches on foot. Unlike the previous yatra where eminent people joined Gandhi, he would interact with party workers and common people this time, sources said.

Congress General Secretary (communication) Jairam Ramesh said Gandhi would interact with people to understand their livelihood issues, such as price rise and unemployment, and assure them of the party

ty's commitment to deliver economic, social, and political justice. In a post on X, Ramesh said while the earlier yatra was anchored on the Preamble's pillars of "liberty, equality, and fraternity", the Bharat Nyaya Yatra is anchored in the Preamble's very first pillar of justice — social, economic, and political.

Congress General Secretary (organisation) K C Venugopal said this yatra would not impact the election preparedness of the Congress. The party will put in place a separate system in New Delhi to look

Hindutva outfit demands strict laws to regulate OTT content

The Save Culture Save Bharat Foundation, headed by former Central Information Commission Uday Mahurkar, on Wednesday demanded the setting up of an umbrella body to regulate all audio-visual content, including over-the-top (OTT) platforms and films, to monitor sexually explicit and any other content that promoted "false narratives", "love jihad" and inaccurately depicted India's history.

The outfit launched an online Swachh Cyber Bharat campaign at the national capital's Prime Ministers' Museum and Library, urging people to send in their suggestions to the government for the draft Broadcasting Services

(Regulation) Bill. The government released the draft Bill on November 10, inviting comments from the public until December 9, which was extended to January 15. The Bill will replace the Cable Television Networks (Regulation) Act, 1995.

The outfit demanded that the government treat the production of "sexually perverted and incestuous" content on all OTT platforms as "anti-national activity", which should attract harsh penal provisions, including imprisonment for 10 to 20 years with the burden of proof placed on the accused.

It asked the government to ban sexually explicit content completely, "as in Dubai" and the United Arab Emirates (UAE), bring in a law of ethics and adequate changes in the

draft Broadcasting Services (Regulation) Bill. The outfit also suggested that the government amend the Information Technology Act to classify all such content as pornography, which people should only be able to access by punching in their Aadhaar details or their fingerprints.

The association released a "white paper", documenting the "misdemeanours" of OTT content available on leading platforms. Apart from Mahurkar, Supreme Court advocate Monika Arora, Hindu Dharma Acharya Sabhas representatives, and others are associated with the effort. Mahurkar said the foundation's campaign has received support from RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat, Swami Ramdev and Sri Sri Ravi Shankar.

Refined petroleum product exports rise 32% in Nov: PPAC

Export of refined petroleum product imports grew 32.1 per cent in November to 5.6 million metric tonnes (mmt), up from 4.3 mmt in the year-ago month, latest data released by the Petroleum Planning and Analysis Cell (PPAC) showed.

Value-wise, exports stood at \$4.3 billion in November, up from \$3.8 billion a year back.

Exports in the April-November period also rose, rising 2.7 per cent to 40.8 mmt. This was due to a rise in the outbound shipment of vacuum gas oil (VGO), motor-spirit (MS), and aviation turbine fuel (ATF), the PPAC said.

Petroleum exports have been consistently high in

2023 primarily as a result of import volumes of crude oil remaining consistent throughout 2023. However, crude oil imports reduced 2.3 per cent in November to 18.6 mmt, down from 19 mmt. The net import bill for oil & gas for November was \$11.5 billion as compared to a net import bill of \$12.3 billion a year ago.

Russia remained the single-largest supplier of crude oil for the 14th straight month as of November, estimates made by London-based commodity data analytics provider Vortexa, which tracks ship movements to estimate imports, show.

While the share of crude oil originating in Russia has reduced in recent months, the continuing discounts on Russian crude have helped stabilise volumes.
